

Key items from God's word to those living today

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The following items of scripture are given specifically for those people alive at this point in time, it is for those that are destined to go through the Tribulation Period and experience the wrath of God poured out upon the entire world. God's wrath in today's time is minor compared to that which will come during the Tribulation. Currently the world has turned upside down and is destined on becoming much worse. At the moment we are in the pre-Tribulation times.

This is your wake up call.

1. First, Malachi warns those to change before the wrath of God comes upon the world.

Mal 4:4 Remember ye **the law of Moses** my servant, which I commanded unto him in Horeb for all Israel, *with* the **statutes** and **judgments**. (KJV)

The "Law" is Strong Number H8451 and means everything in the first five books of the Bible, it is the Pentateuch or the Hebrew word Torah. It consists of all God's Laws, which include the "Statutes" (the Holy days of God) and "Judgements" (right rulings or righteousness).

2. Second, Jesus tells everyone to keep the Torah (Law)

Mat 5:18 For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled.

We are told nothing is removed or changed from the Torah until in the future when heaven and earth pass away. Understand neither God nor Yeshua (Jesus) lie, nor change, what is given in scripture is truth.

The following verses, again given directly from Yeshua, should remove any doubt on the above scripture.

Mat 24:34 Verily I say unto you, This generation shall not pass, till all these things be fulfilled.
Mat 24:35 Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away.

On the Last Day, which is the second resurrection and judgment day, the heavens and the earth do in fact pass away. At this future time the Torah is no longer required.

Yes those of us living at this period of time are now experiencing the wrath of God that has already started and prophesized to occur before the Tribulation starts.

3. Reading Scripture in Context

Few people read scripture in proper **context**. Most think they do, but in fact they do not. In order to read scripture in context you must ask yourself three questions regarding the scripture you have selected. First is who is speaking, second is who is it being directed to, third is what did it mean to that society at that period of time. Then in the last step, you read scripture above and below as far as needed to gain the understanding.

Examine the following scriptures spoken by Yeshua.

Mat 12:11 And he said unto them, **What man shall there be among you, that shall have one sheep, and if it fall into a pit on the sabbath day, will he not lay hold on it, and lift *it* out?**

Mat 12:12 **How much then is a man better than a sheep? Wherefore it is lawful to do well on the sabbath days.**

First who is speaking, it is Yeshua who is a Jew, second who is He speaking to, it is to fellow Jews, third what did it mean to society at that time, all the Jewish society followed the Torah and there was a police force that arrested and punished any Jew that was found in not following the Torah. So in reading these verses in proper context Yeshua is telling others how to better keep the Sabbath, He did not need to tell them to keep the Sabbath. In these verses the Pharisees were trying to trap Yeshua so they could arrest Him and punish Him. Yeshua by His actions kept the Sabbath and all the Torah. The above scriptures by Yeshua reinforce keeping the seventh day Sabbath when read in proper context.

The New Testament is written by Jews and written to Jews. It is only later after Yeshua was rejected by His own people that He sent His disciples out first to the Jews and then later to the Gentiles.

4. Walking the Same as the Original Congregations

Unfortunately all current day Churches think they are walking in the same manner as the early congregations as set up by the Apostles. **They are not !** Consider the remarks by Paul in the following scriptures.

Act 21:18 And the *day* following Paul went in with us unto James; and all the elders were present.

Act 21:19 And when he had saluted them, he declared particularly what things God had wrought **among the Gentiles** by his ministry.

Act 21:20 And when they heard *it*, they glorified the Lord, and said unto him, Thou seest, brother, how many thousands of Jews there are which believe; and **they are all zealous of the law:**

Yes the Gentiles in Paul's congregations were zealous for the Torah (Law), they learned and were walking forward in the Torah. Scripture also tells us that Paul always walked in the Torah. Today's

Churches go their own way in enmity to God, they are in no way the same as the original congregations. They in fact are law breakers or walk forward in iniquity, which means walking forward breaking God's laws, hence they are walking forward in sin.

The seven letters by Yeshua in Revelations, revealed to John, are given to the 6 main stream groups of Churches today, telling them to change in how they walk forward before it is too late.

5. Opening of Scripture in the End Time

In the book of Daniel it tells us that the books of prophecy will be opened in the end times. We are now living in the end times. The following is a prime example of scripture being opened in today's time.

Mat 24:15 When ye therefore shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, stand in the holy place, (whoso readeth, let him understand:)

Mat 24:16 Then let them which be in Judaea flee into the mountains:

Mat 24:17 Let him which is on the housetop not come down to take any thing out of his house:

Mat 24:18 Neither let him which is in the field return back to take his clothes.

Mat 24:19 And woe unto them that are with child, and to them that give suck in those days!

Mat 24:20 But pray ye that your flight be not in the winter, neither on the sabbath day:

Mat 24:21 For then shall be great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be.

Mat 24:22 And except those days should be shortened, **there should no flesh be saved:** but for the elect's sake those days shall be shortened.

Previously those living before the 1950's, the above scripture was interpreted as occurring either in 143 BC at the time of the Maccabees or in 70 AD at the time Rome destroyed the temple. Often scripture as duality in meaning. However the verse Mat 24:22 did not have any meaning to those born before roughly 1950. Those born after 1950 live in the atomic age and man now has the capability to destroy life over the entire world several times over.

The main prophecy of the above section of scriptures is for those living in today's time. As a result of Mat 24:22 now being understandable, the prophecy is now opened to everyone living in today's time. This prophecy is destined to occur at the mid point of the Tribulation period, which is fast approaching.

Now go back and look at what Yeshua says in Mat 24:20, yes we are told the Sabbath is still in effect in today's time.

6. Yeshua's role in the Old Testament

The role of Yeshua throughout the Old Testament was hidden until it was opened to us in the New Testament. The following scriptures, and there are many that tell us Yeshua had an active role throughout the Old Testament. Let us start first with 1Corinthians.

1Co 10:1 Moreover, brethren, I would not that ye should be ignorant, how that all our fathers were under the cloud, and all passed through the sea;

1Co 10:2 And were all baptized unto Moses in the cloud and in the sea;

1Co 10:3 And did all eat the same spiritual meat;

1Co 10:4 And did all drink the same spiritual drink: for they drank of that **spiritual Rock** that **followed them**: and **that Rock was Christ**.

Yes throughout the travels of the Israelites through the wilderness for 40 years, it was Yeshua that was with them as the cloud, the pillar of fire and the rock that gave them water.

The next major understanding is given in the book of John. There is difficulty in the words the translators used in giving us understanding and it will be covered. Looking at Joh 1:1 first.

Joh 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

The translation of "God" is Elohim in Hebrew and this has multiple meanings. In this scripture it should read, In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with Elohim (the Father), and the Word was Elohim (the Son). This becomes clear with many other further verses in particular examine Psa 45:7 and Heb 1:9.

Joh 1:2 The same was in the beginning with God.

Joh 1:3 **All things were made by him**; and without him was not any thing made that was made

There are other verses that tell us the same as Joh 1:3. Everything was made by the Word who is the Son or Yehsua the Christ. These are as follows;

Eph 3:9 And to make all *men* see what *is* the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in God, **who created all things by Jesus Christ**:

Heb 1:2 Hath in these last days spoken unto us by *his* Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also **he made the worlds**;

Heb 11:3 Through faith we understand that **the worlds** were framed by **the word of God**, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear.

2Pe 3:5 For this they willingly are ignorant of, that **by the word of God** the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of the water and in the water:

Psa 33:6 **By the word of the LORD** were the heavens made; and all the host of them by the

breath of his mouth.

These scriptures are very clear, the Word of God is Yeshua Mashiach (Messiah or Christ) and it is He who created All Things.

Joh 1:4 In him was life; and the life was the light of men.

Joh 1:5 And the light shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not.

Joh 1:6 There was a man sent from God, whose name *was* John.

Joh 1:7 The same came for a witness, to bear witness of the Light, that all *men* through him might believe.

Joh 1:8 He was not that Light, but *was sent* to bear witness of that Light.

Joh 1:9 *That* was the true Light, which lighteth every man that cometh into the world.

Joh 1:10 He was in the world, and the world was made by him, and the world knew him not.

Joh 1:11 He came unto his own, and his own received him not.

Joh 1:12 But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, *even* to them that believe on his name:

Joh 1:13 Which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.

Joh 1:14 And **the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us**, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.

The above scripture refers to Yeshua who is the “Word”, He was with the Father in the beginning, He was the one that made the world and made man, He is the life and the Light. He came into the world that He made, He came to His own, His own received Him not. The Word was made flesh and Lived among us, yes Yeshua Mashiach is the Word.

Even John the Baptist knew who Yeshua was and that John was born before Yeshua but that Yeshua existed before John.

Joh 1:29 The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.

Joh 1:30 This is he of whom I said, After me cometh a man which is preferred before me: **for he was before me.**

John the Baptist also knew that Yeshua was the lamb of God.

Going to Colossians it further reinforces both the place of Yeshua in the beginning and the creation of all things.

Col 1:12 Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light:

Col 1:13 Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated *us* into the kingdom of **his dear Son**:

Col 1:14 In whom we have redemption through his blood, *even* the forgiveness of sins:

Col 1:15 Who is the image of the invisible God, **the firstborn of every creature**:

Col 1:16 **For by him were all things created**, that are in heaven, and that are in earth,

visible and invisible, whether *they be* thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: **all things were created by him, and for him:**

Col 1:17 And he is before all things, and by him all things consist.

Progressing Yeshua is the only one that came down from heaven.

Joh 3:12 If I have told you earthly things, and ye believe not, how shall ye believe, if I tell you of heavenly things?

Joh 3:13 And no man hath ascended up to heaven, but he that came down from heaven, *even the Son of man which is in heaven.*

Php 2:5 Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus:

Php 2:6 Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God:

Php 2:7 **But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men:**

Php 2:8 And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.

Php 2:9 Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name:

Php 2:10 That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of *things* in heaven, and *things* in earth, and *things* under the earth;

Php 2:11 And *that* every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ *is* Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

The above Php 2:7 in most other Bibles it translated as “he emptied himself”. As seen here the KJV translates it differently. Yes Yeshua who pre-existed as the Word of God, emptied Himself and came down to earth as a man obedient to the cross.

Yeshua was sent by the Father to come down to earth.

Joh 6:33 For the bread of God is he which cometh down from heaven, and giveth life unto the world.

Joh 6:34 Then said they unto him, Lord, evermore give us this bread.

Joh 6:35 And Jesus said unto them, **I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst.**

Joh 6:38 **For I came down from heaven,** not to do mine own will, but the will of him that sent me.

Joh 6:50 This is the bread which cometh down from heaven, that a man may eat thereof, and not die.

Joh 6:51 I am the living bread which came down from heaven: if any man eat of this bread, he shall live for ever: and the bread that I will give is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world.

Joh 6:62 *What* and if ye shall see the **Son of man ascend up where he was before?**

Joh 8:23 And he said unto them, **Ye are from beneath; I am from above: ye are of this world; I am not of this world.**

Joh 8:58 Jesus said unto them, **Verily, verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, I am.**

Joh 16:27 For the Father himself loveth you, because ye have loved me, and have believed that I came out from God.

Joh 16:28 I came forth from the Father, and am come into the world: again, I leave the world, and go to the Father.

Joh 17:4 I have glorified thee on the earth: I have finished the work which thou gavest me to do.

Joh 17:5 And now, O Father, glorify thou me with thine own self with the **glory which I had with thee before the world was.**

All of the above scriptures tell us that Yeshua existed from the beginning and that all things were made by him. That He emptied Himself and came down to earth and walked among us in the flesh showing us the way and dying for our sins, overcoming death and ascending back up to heaven with the glory that He had before He descended down to earth.

Now the important verses that tell us about Yeshua's role in the Old Testament are the following.

Joh 5:37 And the Father himself, which hath sent me, hath borne witness of me. Ye have neither heard his voice at any time, nor seen his shape.

Joh 1:18 No man hath seen God at any time; the only begotten Son, which is in the bosom of the Father, he hath declared *him*.

Joh 6:46 Not that any man hath seen the Father, save he which is of God, he hath seen the Father.

1Jn 4:12 No man hath seen God at any time. If we love one another, God dwelleth in us, and his love is perfected in us.

There are four scriptures that tell us no man has seen the Father and one of the four also tells us no one has heard the Father. This means it was Yeshua Mashiach that was dealing with man, that it was Yeshua who wrote with His finger the 10 commandments on the stone tablets, it was the back of Yeshua that Moses saw, it was Yeshua that spoke with Moses it was Yeshua that gave the

Torah. Yeshua was the mediator for the Father all through the Old Testament. Yehsua was also the mediator for the Father in the New Testament.

1Ti 2:5 For *there is* one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;

This means there is no difference between the Old and New Testaments, they are all part of one complete Bible. They are all the holy word of God. The complete Bible applies equally today as it did in the past. So when Yeshua says the following scripture, it has much more meaning than what nearly all people think.

Joh 14:15 *If ye love me, keep my commandments.*

If you did not know today what the many scriptures above are telling us, that which was a secret in the Old Testament, then one must wonder how you read the Bible.

7. Repent and come back to walking forward in God's Ways

The time to the start of the Tribulation is very short. Look around and see how upside down the world has become and continues to develop. Yes 2021 will be much worse than 2020. We are presently living in the days immediately preceding the start of the worst part of the wrath of God coming upon the whole world, which will occur during the Tribulation period. Right now we are in the pre-tribulation time, the time of sorrows, the time of birth pains, currently God's wrath on the world has started with two of the three plagues, the third plague will likely start very soon. God sends three plagues on the world before the start of the Tribulation. Then during the Tribulation there are 7 more plagues, each becoming progressively worse. The Bible warns man many, many times of the coming wrath of God, the message is always the same, repent and come back to walking in the manner that God demands. He is always willing to take every one back, who from their own free will repents, accepts Yeshua Mashiach as the Son of God and as ones personal savior and walks forward obeying the Torah. Once the Tribulation period starts, all men will have made their choice, either passing or failing God's test. Once the Tribulation starts one will not be able to change the choice they made. If you make the wrong choice you lose your salvation and you experience the plagues through the Tribulation and you will die by or before the end of the Tribulation. Recognizing the signs during the Tribulation period do not help one in going forward as your choice has previously been made.

Do not have a stiff neck and do not let your ego get in the way, and do not walk in the way of the world, rather repent and walk forward in total obedience to God. The days of Noah are here. There are four actions required in returning to God, first repent, second accept Yeshua as your Messiah, third obey and follow God's laws or Torah and fourth grow in love, and in your heart as God requires one to mature as His sons and daughters. One needs to grow in the heart valuing the actions and thoughts that are the same that God himself values. Yeshua and the Apostles have identified what these are.

Don't find yourself being described by the following scriptures. Those that walk forward in compromise are those most at risk of making the incorrect decision before the Tribulation begins.

Luk 13:25 *When once the master of the house is risen up, and hath shut to the door, and ye*

begin to stand without, and to knock at the door, saying, Lord, Lord, open unto us; and he shall answer and say unto you, I know you not whence ye are:

Luk 13:26 Then shall ye begin to say, We have eaten and drunk in thy presence, and thou hast taught in our streets.

Luk 13:27 But he shall say, I tell you, **I know you not** whence ye are; depart from me, all *ye workers of iniquity*.

Those workers of iniquity are those not obeying God's Laws. If you break one Law you are guilty of breaking all. Then you walk in sin. One needs to pray and walk forward with God's help. Note that all the Laws in Leviticus 23 are still in effect. That includes the seventh day Sabbath, the Holy Days of God and the food laws as well as many more.

Remove the self imposed blinder you have placed upon yourself, let go of your preconceived ideas and really read what God's word tells us, not what others tell us. The only doctrine to follow is that of the complete Bible itself. Salvation scripture is clear.

You alone are responsible for your choice, you cannot blame anyone else. God holds you responsible. Do not walk in the way of the world.

Chose carefully on how you go forward , there is not much time left. Your eternity depends on your free will choice and decisions you make before time runs out.

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
