God's Wrath in the End Times

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God's wrath is poured out on the world in the end times. This leads up to Yeshua's (Jesus) second coming and starts in the days of sorrow. In keeping with the 10 plagues poured out on Egypt at the time of Moses, there are 7 plagues poured out in the Tribulation period, one at each trumpet announcement. The other three occur in the days of sorrow ahead of the start of the Tribulation. There are parallels between the plagues on the Egyptians at Moses time and the end day plagues or the Day of the Lord. The following first summarizes these plagues at Moses time in Egypt. Second the plagues of the end time are covered. At the end of the wrath of God poured out on the world, it then becomes the start of the Millennium.

Plagues of Egypt

First we will start with a listing of the plagues that God sent upon Egypt, through His representative Moses, these showed His might over that of the Pharaoh and his gods. Recognize that there were ten Plagues each being progressively more severe than that which followed before.

- Waters turning to blood. This included the Nile river as well as other rivers, canals, ponds and reservoirs.
 In addition even wooden buckets and stone jars were affected. The fish in the rivers died and the rivers stank. The Egyptians had to dig wells along the river in order to obtain drinking water. This lasted seven days.
- 2. Frogs would invade Egypt. The river swarms with frogs, the frogs are everywhere, in the courtyards, in the fields, in the houses, ovens and kneading bowels, bedrooms and beds. Then the frogs died and stank, and stayed only in the river when Moses asked God to remove the frogs. We do not know the length of time over which this took place however it appears to be one or two days, but we really do not know, it could have been seven days.
- 3. The dust of the land became lice. Lice were on the land and on the people. Again the time duration appears to be one or two days. possibly. Take special note, God's people were not protected from these first three plagues, but went through them the same as the Egyptians.
- 4. Swarms of Insects everywhere. These were in the houses, on the people and throughout the land. The insects ruined the entire land of Egypt. The Israelites were protected against this fourth plague, it appears the Israelites were protected against all of the rest of the plagues from this time forward. Again this plague appears to be one or two days, possibly.
- 5. Devastating illness on the livestock of Egypt. The horses, donkeys, camels, cattle and flocks of the Egyptians experienced this. The Israelite livestock were protected. The Egyptian livestocks died. It appears this was over one day, possibly.
- 6. Ashes thrown in the air become fine dust and inflict sores on men and cattle. All Egypt became infected with sores, both men and animals. It appears this lasted two days, possibly.
- 7. Heavy hail storm over the land. The hail was so strong it killed all animals and people that were not under shelters. Along with the hail was fire likely in the form of lightning and also thunder. All the plants were destroyed and the trees were broken. The flax and barley were ruined but the wheat and buckwheat had not yet come up. The thunder as well as the hail affected the Egyptians. Again Israel was protected. It appears this lasted two days, possibly.

- 8. Land overcome with locusts. The locusts ate every plant, tree and fruit as well as invaded all the houses and were over the entire land. This seems to indicate that a fair amount of time elapsed between these plagues. It is possible that at this time the trees had recovered from the hail and that the wheat and buckwheat had grown up. These plagues were progressively destroying the land and all of the food source of the Egyptians.
- 9. Darkness over three days. The darkness was so thick it could be felt and covered all of Egypt. People could not see each other, but the Israelites had light in their homes. No one could go anywhere for three days. Interesting that the Egyptians not having light in their residences means they must have run out of oil due to destruction of the olive trees, yet the Israelites had oil.
- 10. Death of all the first born males of both man and animals. At around midnight death of all first born males, both people and animals occurred. Only the Israelites who followed God's instructions of first selecting a lamb on the tenth day and setting it aside for 4 days, then killing it, painting it's blood on the lintel and door posts, then roasting it and staying inside were those that survived. If the Egyptians had on average four children and if their first born was a male, then ¼ of their population would have died that night. However the number the death of the first born would have been a significant part of the population of the Egyptians.

The ten plagues in Egypt will be duplicated in the end days, in some fashion that reasonably fits in following a general build up of severity as they progress. They need not be identical in either the sequence or the type but will follow in a recognizable manner of inflicting continued aggressive duress on people throughout the world. Those passing through the Tribulation that have God's mark on them are spared from the last seven plagues of God, similar to the Israelites in Egypt who were spared or protected over the last seven plagues. In the end days the entire world population is analogous to evil Egypt and God's sealed people are representative of the Israelites in Egypt. The cycle repeats itself, the world should not be surprised as God's word tells us of the previous history of God's people being taken out of Egypt which at the time represented sin, and God's word also tells us what is to happen in the end times which is a parallel unfolding. The end time is where God's people are taken out of the world while the Israelites are collected and remain to live in Israel for a thousand years, now being a guide to the rest of the Nations of the world, those that survive.

Days of Sorrows

The days of sorrow are told to us by Yeshua and what will come to pass, in addition many further details are given to us from Revelations. There are scriptures from other prophets that reinforce these days, but they have not been incorporated in this document.

First what did Yeshua tell us, it starts with a warning of false prophets followed by wars, famine, death, pestilence, earthquakes and persecution of God's people. Generally, a change occurs in men's hearts with selfishness and evil growing. Yeshua tells us of a progression of a bad changing world that leads up to the end of the Tribulation.

24:4 And Jesus answered and said unto them, Take heed that no man deceive you.

Mat 24:5 For many shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ; and shall deceive many.

Mat 24:6 And ye shall hear of wars and rumours of wars: see that ye be not troubled: for all *these things* must come to pass, but the end is not yet.

Mat 24:7 For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be famines, and

pestilences, and earthquakes, in divers places.

Mat 24:8 All these *are* the **beginning of sorrows**.

Mat 24:9 Then shall they deliver you up to be afflicted, and shall kill you: and ye shall be hated of all nations for my name's sake.

Mat 24:10 And then shall many be offended, and shall betray one another, and shall hate one another.

Mat 24:11 And many false prophets shall rise, and shall deceive many.

Mat 24:12 And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold.

Mat 24:13 But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved.

Mat 24:14 And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come.

The last verse above most likely refers to the two witnesses in the latter half of the Tribulation period. When they are finished the end comes.

Now starting in Revelations, we find the following occurring in the days of sorrow and continuing into and through the Tribulation,

The rider on the white horse, Rev 6:2. This occurs at the opening of the first seal. The rider has a bow and a crown and he went forth conquering and to conquer. White is righteous, the crown is a kingdom or nation, the bow is strength in war. This appears to fit the USA as keeping evil under wraps, such as Hitler, Russia, North Korea, Vietnam, Afghanistan, Iraq and Iran. This is now appears to be coming to an end as Trump is being restricted in what he is allowed to do in the world and the liberals in the world are rising up. This activity covers a time period from 1944 to 2020 or roughly 76 years. This rider is not one of the plagues of God, rather it is a check in keeping some balance on the evil in the world for a long period of time. This time has generally been prosperous, beyond what has ever occurred previously in the history of the world. As the USA loses its foundation based upon worship and following God's ways, the white horse and rider start fading away.

End Time Plagues

The Plagues at the end time are the wrath of God coming on the whole world. They are referred to throughout the Bible as the "Day of the Lord'. For background on this read the document titled "Study-day of the Lord". The Day of the Lord is not restricted to occur on "one" day, it will take place over considerable time. The end time plagues occur over many years, each being variable in length.

1. The rider on the red horse, Rev 6:4. This occurs at the opening of the second seal. The rider is given power to take peace from the world and that people will kill one another. This has been occurring basically starting with the Korean and Vietnam wars and continuing through the present time. It is not yet finished. This has been underway since 1955, so to date the period so far accumulated is 65 years. It is accelerating as there is a polarization in many many countries throughout the world between the left and the right. In addition wars are occurring in many different countries and locations over the world. The main country causing or promoting this is Russia and now being joined by others aligning themselves with Russia. These being Iran, Turkey, and China, interesting the world knows Russia and China as representing red. It fits well with the red horse and also with the spilling of blood throughout the world. This rider not only overlaps with the white horse but is becoming more dominant as time proceeds, while the action of the white horse is fading away. The red horse is the first plague of God poured out on the world.

- 2. The rider of the black horse, Rev 6:5. This occurs at the opening of the third seal. This rider had a pair of balances and speaks out a measure of wheat for a penny and three measures of barley for a penny, and not to hurt the oil or the wine. This is famine occurring throughout the world, the olive trees and grape vines are drought resistant. The change in the world environment with erratic weather patterns, rising temperatures, rising sea levels, floods and drought all herald this rider in. This is occurring or just starting in today's time and is going to turn into a major plague as time goes forward. The extent of forest fires occurring is a major indicator of this starting. The famine is just in the initial stage of beginning. This is the second plague of God poured out on the world. Man is so foolish in thinking he can have control on the environment, just like the sorceress in Egypt trying to duplicate God's wraths, showing they too had control.
- 3. The rider on a pale horse, Rev 6:8. This occurs at the opening of the fourth seal. This rider is Death and Hell followed him. He is given power to kill with war, famine and likely pestilence. He is able to kill a fourth part of the earth. Yes 25% of man will die throughout the world while this rider goes forth. This is the third plague of God poured out over the world. Up to and including this point, God's people are not protected or immune from experiencing these plagues, this is following the same paralleling that the Israelites in Egypt experienced. This is the last horse and rider and leads up to the fifth seal being opened. This is just before the start of the Tribulation period. Recognize these first three plagues overlap and the time period exponentially becomes shorter, not like the first and second horse and riders.

This now being the fifth seal opened, telling us of the martyrs under the throne in heaven being given white robes and telling them to wait a while until other martyrs join them, Rev 6:9. Then the sixth seal is opened which is accompanied with a great earthquake, the sun being black and the moon being blood colored. The stars of heaven also fall onto the earth and every mountain and island moved out of their place, Rev 6:12. The world will think the end of the earth is upon them. Right after these terrifying phenomena which heralds in the start of the Tribulation, those of God's people that He knows will go through the Tribulation and not compromise are sealed with God's mark. This means they will not experience God's continuing wrath that comes upon the world from this point forward. This means the Saints in the Philadelphia Church have been gathered and taken either to a place of refuge or alternately put to sleep at some point before the Tribulation starts. Those Christians that fall away and have compromised made their choice ahead of the start of the Tribulation and they will not be sealed, but will have to go through the Tribulation experiencing the wrath of God. For Christians the test of the Tribulation is a pass or fail test. Those that fail lose their salvation, those that pass become given the reward of Saint, whether they are killed or survive. Read your Bible carefully.

Tribulation period

Note that the Tribulation starts when the sixth seal is broken. There will be no way of missing this event as the mountains and islands are moved out of their place by an enormous earth quake.

This now brings us to the continuation of the plagues, those that now occur during the Tribulation period, being a total of 7 more and start at number four in order to complete a total of ten.

The seventh seal being opened heralds in the seven trumpets and the Golden Censer.

4. Hail, fire and blood, earthquakes, lightning and thunder, Rev 8:5-7. The first trumpet (Rev 8:7) and the first vial (Rev 16:2) go together. A third of the trees and all the green grass were burnt up. This speaks to the entire world. All people developed noisome and grievous sores except for God's marked and protected people. People will be in agony, fires will be burning rampantly throughout the world to the point only houses in towns and cities will experience fire fighting to some degree. With the thunder and the hail which in fact could be brimstone and not water based, and the earthquakes men will be

feeling as if the end has come. Along with their sores they will be completely disheartened. This is the fourth plague.

- 5. Burning mountain thrown into the sea, the sea becomes blood, Rev 8:8-9. The second trumpet sounded and the second vial poured out (Rev 16:3). The second trumpet tells of a third part of the sea becoming blood and a third part of the creatures in the sea dying and a third part of the ships being destroyed. The second vial tells us the sea became blood and every living soul in the sea died. This is the fifth plague.
- 6. Star fell on 1/3 rivers of world, Rev 8:10. The third trumpet sounded and the star called Wormwood was burning as it fell on 1/3 of the rivers and fountains of the world. The rivers were made bitter and many men died of drinking the waters. The third vial (Rev 16:4) tells us the rivers and fountains of waters became blood. This is the sixth plague.
- 7. A third of the Sun, moon and stars smitten, Rev 8:12. The fourth trumpet sounded and 1/3 of the sun, moon and stars were stricken with calamity so they were darkened and the day did not shine for 1/3 part of the time and the night likewise. The fourth vial (Rev 16:8) was poured out and the sun scorched men with fire. This is the seventh plague.

This brings us to the midpoint of the Tribulation where the abomination of desolation occurs and the three woes begin. This is also the point at which Satan is thrown down to earth. The Tribulation is 7 years long being broken in the middle with 3.5 years in each half. There are 42 months in each half and over the first half 4 plagues occurred within the Tribulation period. This means on average each plague probably lasts 10 to 11 months. From this point forward there are three plagues remaining over the next 42 months. The last plague is most severe and occurs at the end of the Tribulation and will occur quickly and will be very short in duration, the eighth plague is 5 months long and therefore the ninth plague will likely be around 37 months or three years in duration. During the entire last half of the Tribulation God's two witnesses are present and they can add to the plagues as they so wish. Right at the midpoint of the Tribulation God's people in Israel can flee to a place of refuge.

- 8. Special locusts came out from the bottomless pit, Rev 9:1. The fifth trumpet sounded and an angel with the key to the bottomless pit allows smoke and a special type of locust to fly out. They have power like scorpions which were not to hurt any green thing or any tree but only those people who did not have God's seal on them. They are allowed to do this for a period of 5 months. This is the end of the first woe. The fifth vial (Rev 16:10) resulted in darkness and pain and sores. This is the eighth plague.
- 9. Slaying 1/3 part of men with special army of horsemen, Rev 9:13-19. The sixth trumpet sounded and 4 angles were loosed, creating an army of horsemen on special horses with power of fire, brimstone and smoke. These killed 1/3 of mankind. The sixth vial (Rev 16:12) was poured out and the Euphrates river dried up and unclean spirits came out of the mouths of the dragon, the beast and the false prophet. These went out to the whole world to gather nations to come and fight against God. They were gathering armies for Armageddon. This is the ninth plague.

This brings us to the end of the Tribulation with the two witnesses being killed and the end of the two woe's. Now the rest happens quickly with Yeshua's second coming and the destroying of the armies at Armageddon, and the destruction of all of the evil people in the world. The throwing of the beast and the false

prophet into the lake of fire and chaining and locking Satan up in the bottomless pit for the thousand years. This then heralds in the Millennium.

10. Seventh trumpet, Rev 11:15. Thundering, earthquakes and great hail. The seventh vial (Rev 16:17) and the great city (Rome most likely) was divided into three parts, the cities of the nations fell, every island and mountain were not found. Stones of hail poured down and the plague was exceedingly great. This is the tenth plague as also described with many things occurring very suddenly. Note the extent of the change in the earth of Islands and mountains.

The seventh trumpet also announces Yeshua's second coming, all the world will see Him coming in the clouds in great glory and power. At this time all of the Saints that existed from the time Yeshua left the earth at His first coming up to the end of the Tribulation, will now be resurrected, both those that are dead and those that are alive.

At this time the end occurs where Yeshua comes back placing His feet on the mount of olives, all the Saints come back with Him. All the Saints have been taken out of the world, now being resurrected and are with Yeshua wherever He goes. Those people that are left are first the Israelites that survived and had their blinders taken off. They are gathered from throughout the world and brought back to Israel. Other people of various Nations throughout the world who were not evil were spared and are still live. It is these that come to Jerusalem for the Feast of Tabernacles each year. Yeshua during the Millennium rules the entire earth with a rod of iron, meaning all the Nations throughout the world that are left. The saints rule with Him.

There are similarities and differences in the plagues of Egypt and the end day plagues. The end day plagues are much more severe, they are the Day of the Lord, with the wrath of God being poured out upon the world.

The Day of the Lord occurs with ten plagues coming upon the whole world. Each plague becoming more and more severe, up until God's wrath in the last plague is poured out undiluted. At the end of this last plague the world then starts again afresh in having only righteous people. It is again a fresh start of the thousand year reign of Yeshua as the King of kings and Lord of lords, over the entire world from His throne in Jerusalem. At the start of the Millennium all of those in the Churches of today are most likely no longer alive as men. Those of God's setapart people that came through the Tribulation are resurrected as Saints. In addition all those residing alive in the place of refuge were all resurrected. Those in the Churches that did not meet the requirement of Saint were required to go through the Tribulation. Those that compromise are not given God's mark and therefore are not protected from the plagues and are likely killed through or by the end of the Tribulation. Those that do not compromise are given the status of Saint by the end of the Tribulation whether they are alive or dead.

At the start of the Millennium the Churches no longer exist, only the Torah goes forth from Jerusalem to all those throughout the world. All people are required to follow the Torah, the Israelites will be a Nation to be looked up to as God's special people, a Nation to follow in the manner of worshipping and obeying God. There are very few in the Churches of today who meet the requirement of being given the status of Saint and are spared from not having to go through the Tribulation. Most all, a very large number will need to go through the test or temptation that comes upon the whole world. In order to understand this one needs to do a very thorough and deep study of who the Saints are and what is required to be classified as one of the Saints.

The Tribulation, temptation or test fast approaches, time is fast running out. Now is the time to know how to pass through the Tribulation. If you will be passing through the Tribulation you must make the right choice before the Tribulation starts, as after it starts it is too late. One needs to know and prepare their mind as to how to pass safely through the Tribulation should that happen. Open your mind, let go of preconceived ideas, pray and study your Bible.

Table Comparison

The following table compares the plagues in Egypt and the plagues at the End Time. The markers of the breaking of the Seals and the Trumpets and Vials are indicated for the End Time plagues. These are milestone markers that we are given in the book of Revelations. This table makes for an easier comparison in order to be able to see the progression of severity and where some commonalities occur between Egypt and the End Time. Only the highlights describing the plagues are given in the table,

Not that the breaking of the fifth seal is not indicated in the table as it does not have a direct action on the plagues themselves. The breaking of the fifth seal is one of the most important prophecy verses that God has given to us for understanding of End Time events. Recognize that all scripture is given to us for a purpose, even though often we are not able to understand or recognize that purpose. The scripture of the breaking of the fifth seal is one of those scriptures. In an initial reading of this particular scripture one often thinks that this scripture is not important or really telling us anything that we need to know. We then often think "so what" and ignore it. In the End Time we are told that scripture will be opened to us, this is one of those scriptures. The scriptures of Rev 6:9-11 are of major importance for our time today. These must be combined with

1Col 15:20-23 and with 1Th 4:15-17, then the understanding will be revealed. It tells us that there is no secret resurrection ahead of the start of the Tribulation, the resurrection occurs only at the end of the Tribulation when Yeshua returns in the clouds and then after gathering all the rest of His Saints, comes down to earth on the Mount of Olives.

If you still believe that in the end times there are only 7 plagues of God rather than 10 carefully check out Rev 15:1

Comparison of Plagues – Egypt vs End time Egypt

- Waters turn to Blood, Nile and fish die and stink, also blood in rivers, ponds, pools, wood and Stone containers. Magicians did same. Wells along the river were dug for drinking water. 7 days passed.
- River bring forth frogs abundantly, frogs go into house, bedroom, beds and kneading bowls. Magicians did same. Frogs to river only and others gathered and stank.
- Dust becomes lice. Lice on man and beast. Magicians could not duplicate.
- Swarms of insects, either mosquito or some type of fly. Land corrupted. Israelites not affected.
- Very severe pestilence on cattle, horses, donkeys, camels, oxen, sheep. Occurred on the next day, then the following morning ALL the Egyptian's cattle died. Israelites not affected.
- Ashes from furnace thrown into air, dust causes boils on man and beast, just the Egyptian's affected.
- 7. All the rest of the Plague's on Pharaoh's heart, and all his people. Know there is no one like Adonai. Warning that next day a severe hail and fire will come down, it will kill every animal that is left in the field and is not brought into shelter. Hail killed every man and animal and herb and broke every tree in the field. Flax and barley destroyed, but wheat and spelt not yet germinated. Was rain, hail and thunder.
- Locusts cover ground entirely and eat everything left after the hail, all fruit, and green plant and they filled the houses as well.
 The land becomes dark. All locusts removed, blown into Red Sea.
- Thick darkness that can be felt for 3 days. They could not see each other and no one rose from his place for 3 days. Israelites had light in their dwellings.
- Death of firstborn of people and animals. Only the Egyptian's experienced this. Every Egyptian family experienced a death of a first born.

End Time

- Fiery Red Horse, take peace from the earth, people kill one another. Rider given a great sword. Second seal.
- Black horse. Pair of scales in his hand, voice saying "a quart of wheat for a denarius and three quarts of barley for a denarius and do not harm the oil and the wine. Third seal.
- Pale horse, death sat on the horse and Hell followed him. Power given to them over ¼ of the earth to kill with the sword, with hunger and with death and by the beasts of the earth. Fourth seal.

Sixth seal announces start of **Tribulation**. Great earthquake, sun becomes black, starts of heaven fall to earth, sky recedes as a scroll, every island and mountain moved out of it's place. **After sixth seal**, Adonai's people sealed

- Seventh seal, silence for 1 hr in heaven. First Trumpet, hail, fire, blood thrown to earth, 1/3 trees burned up and all green grass burned up. First Vial, foul and loathsome sores on men.
- Second Trumpet, Something like a great mountain burning with fire thrown into sea, 1/3 living creatures in sea died, 1/3 of ships destroyed. Second Vial, poured out on sea and it became blood and every living creature in the sea died.
- Third Trumpet, great burning star called wormwood from heaven fell on 1/3 rivers and springs of water, 1/3 of waters became wormwood and many men died from drinking the waters. Third Vial, rivers and springs of water became blood.
- Fourth Trumpet,1/3 of sun, moon and stars struck, 1/3 of day and the night did not shine. Three woe's announced. Fourth Vial, sun scorched men with fire and great heat.
- 8. Fifth Trumpet, star fell with key to bottomless pit, pit opened and smoke of a great furnace came out and darkened the sun and air, special locusts came out of the smoke and tormented man for five months. Fifth Vial, kingdom of the beast became full of darkness and men gnawed their tongues because of their pain.
- 9. Sixth Trumpet, four angels that are bound to the Euphrates released to kill 1/3 of mankind with an army of two hundred million sitting on special horses using fire, smoke and brimstone. These are referred to as 3 methods of destruction. Sixth Vial, Euphrates river dried up for the way of the kings of the east. Unclean spirits like grogs came out of the mouth of the dragon, the beast, and false prophet, performing signs and gathering the kings of the earth to gather for battle at Armageddon.
- 10. Seventh Trumpet, Kingdom of the world now of Adonai and Mashiach, the wrath of Adonai has come to the angry nations, judgment and reward to the Saints, those that destroy the earth are destroyed. Seventh Vial, great earthquake, great city divided into three parts, cities of the nations fell, every island fled away and the mountains were not found, heavy hailstones fell from heaven upon men. Now jumps to Rev 19 & 20 for more detail.
