

Possible End Time Scenarios

1. Introduction

At our present time we normally think in terms of how things are accomplished with our current technology and the methods that are normally available and used. When we read prophecy we do not start to consider that things might in fact be drastically different in terms of available technology as the future unfolds. This means it is possible that prophecy will likely unfold in a manner that we would never have thought possible. This document explores some of these possibilities using scripture. Understand these are possible scenarios and we do not really know the degree and how things will be affected from God's plagues.

First recognize God's word is truth, God does not lie. The Bible means what it says, it is truth.

2. Current Day

The Bible gives us information and prophecy in order to understand generally what is coming and roughly when. Those who truly know the Bible can see the convergence of many different prophecy scriptures in our time today. There is no doubt that we are currently living in the time of major prophecy being fulfilled. Today parallels the plagues in Egypt and right now we are living in the start of the second of the 10 end time plagues. The time is becoming very short for one to choose from their own free will, the way they will walk, and whether it will be in obedience according to God's requirements.

In our current time, we are in the times of sorrow that lead up to the start of the Tribulation. The first two of the three plagues of God are underway. These are peace being taken from the world and famine. The third plague is tremendous death which has not yet started but it is not far away. It will result in 25% of mankind being killed by the start of the Tribulation..

The first plague started with the entire world being turned upside down with covid-19 at the beginning of 2020. It definitely took peace from the world. Each of the first three plagues once started continue right up to the start of the Tribulation period. They overlap and join together running simultaneously. Peace being taken from the world besides disease is also wars and disaster from the results of extreme weather. Currently as we look around serious war is threatening. Peace being taken from the world will continue for a number of years as yet. It could be wars or other diseases or both.

We have reached a point where with the Biden administration and actions, the US is viewed by much of the world as suddenly being very weak. This has been reinforced by many policies and actions that have unfolded, not the least of which was the Afghanistan withdrawal. Russia, China, Iran, and North Korea in particular have been emboldened in the last two years, becoming more so lately. Russia is now threatening to invade the Ukraine in defiance to the US and NATO, even to the very real possibility of nuclear war. China is threatening to invade Taiwan and has mentioned a possibility of nuclear response. Iran is procrastinating in working on any nuclear enrichment

agreement and proceeding with its enrichment program to obtain nuclear weapons as soon as possible. Israel is ready to strike Iran at any moment. China, Iran and Russia are allies that are cooperating together and carrying out military exercises together. The world is quickly forming in two opposing factions, the US, Europe, Britain, Japan, Australia and India on one side, then on the other is Russia, China, Iran, North Korea, Pakistan, and Turkey. The major world atomic powers are against each other and tension is growing to a critical level.

Consider the following scripture from Yeshua;

Mat 24:21 For then shall be great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be.

Mat 24:22 And except those days should be shortened, there should no flesh be saved: but for the elect's sake those days shall be shortened.

Normally when reading these scriptures the context seems to be directed to the middle or end of the Tribulation. However it is possible that Mat 24:22 could refer to the times of sorrow ahead of the start of the Tribulation. It could refer to today.

The context definitely refers to either atomic war or biological weapon extinction. The most likely being atomic war, as all life, both man and animal, would be destroyed. The shortening of those days is likely a statement that tells us God will in some manner intervene to control the actions in that time, to ensure that man does not destroy all life on the face of the earth.

We do not know if that scripture applies to the times of sorrow or in the Tribulation, or both.

One prophecy that will change the balance of the two opposing camps would be Ezekiel's war if it occurs before the Tribulation starts. However more recent analysis strongly suggests that this war will occur at the end of the Tribulation. Read the document "Ezekiel's War Revisited". If Ezekiel's war does take place soon then the following would likely unfold. This war involves Russia, Turkey and Iran coming against Israel. In Ezekiel's war, these three nations are severely punished and destroyed in a major way by the hand of God, as He protects Israel. This prophecy can occur anytime up to the start of the Tribulation, even up to 7 years before. With the threat of extinction of Israel from Iran, Israel could act in attacking Iran at any moment in order to prevent atomic ballistic missiles from being obtained by Iran and used against Israel. A strike by Israel against Iran would likely trigger Ezekiel's war. The recent act by the US by suddenly lifting the Nuclear sanctions against Iran, gives Iran a major win and most likely will lead to war in the middle East. The war could, possibly being initiated by Israel. If this leads to Ezekiel's war, and with God's active hand, it is a possible scenario that would suddenly diminish the threat of nuclear war in today's time. The destruction that will be seen by Russia, Iran and Turkey, not only of its armies and war machines, but also in the destruction of its Nations (Magog) would greatly reduce the threat of nuclear war. If Ezekiel's war takes place at the end of the Tribulation then a very dangerous time of major wars, with nuclear war being threatened or occurring will likely take place in our current time and any time up to the start of the Tribulation. Prophecy about the end time is well hidden, using scripture and logic we form an understanding as best we can. We will not always be right, so always watch and adjust what we think the bible tells us with what we see in the world around us.

3. Start of the Tribulation

The announcement at the start of the Tribulation by God, is something that should be reflected upon in terms of the effects throughout the world. The following scripture describes this announcement.

Rev 6:12 And I beheld when he had opened the sixth seal, and, lo, there was a great earthquake; and the sun became black as sackcloth of hair, and the moon became as blood;

Rev 6:13 And the stars of heaven fell unto the earth, even as a fig tree casteth her untimely figs, when she is shaken of a mighty wind.

Rev 6:14 And the heaven departed as a scroll when it is rolled together; and every mountain and island were moved out of their places.

Rev 6:15 And the kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every bondman, and every free man, hid themselves in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains;

The announcement brings devastating destruction upon the entire world. We are told that there was a great earthquake, then meteorites fall on earth in a manner that figs fall off the tree in as mighty wind. Then every mountain and every island are moved out of their place. Every man hid themselves in dens and in the mountains. That earthquake is likely occurring over the entire earth.

The movement of every mountain and island is a tremendous upheaval over all the earth. Combine that with meteorites raining down on the earth. Most people will think that the end of the world has come. But that is just God announcing the start of the Tribulation.

First think of what is happening in our present day, the earth is groaning. More earthquakes all the time, volcanic eruptions, ice caps melting, erratic and violent weather. Recently even a volcano erupting beneath the sea causing a tsunami and ash to be thrown up into the atmosphere. The Tonga volcanic eruption was the same magnitude as the atomic bomb on Hiroshima.

Now think of the rearrangement or movement of every mountain and island and the effects that would occur. Such an upheaval would be a way beyond the damage caused by powerful earthquakes. The upheaval would occur over the entire face of the earth. What might we expect? There are two possibilities, first it could be local movement of the mountains and islands throughout the world, or it could be a sliding of the earth's mantle to a new position. In both cases there will likely be some major amount of large widespread damage. How much we really do not know.

It is very unlikely that the earth's mantle will slide in a sudden manner, as a major effect of this would be an enormous tsunami from the inertia of water in the ocean resisting its movement, in starting and also stopping.

However the possibility of major sudden sliding of many or all tectonic plates could occur. God knows how He will accomplish this event, man does not. An outcome of this scenario looks at the rearrangement of mountains and islands and possible effects.

It would likely affect ground subsidence, upheaval and shear movement everywhere. If so then, first in cities, most likely nearly all buildings will be damaged to some degree and the tall buildings will most likely result in falling down. The buried structures of pipe lines carrying natural gas, oil, water and sewer will likely be severely fractured. The rails and roads will most likely be generally destroyed in many locations by upheaval and twisting. The airport runways will likely be similarly be destroyed. Manufacturing and processing plants that produce both food and products will likely be destroyed along with the equipment inside them. Oil and gasoline storage tanks will

likely rupture or tear and spill their contents. Oil and gas refineries will be destroyed. Electric generating power plants will be destroyed and power lines broken, electric power will suddenly cease. Hydroelectric stations and their dams will likely break and flood areas below them along with damaging electric generators.

The destruction of meteorites raining down on the entire earth will cause enormous damage and death. The meteorites will likely result in impact damage both in the heavens around the earth and on the earth. Satellites will be destroyed, communications and GPS will disappear. The space warfare systems of Nations will likely be destroyed. In addition, on the earth fires, will occur in many places. The fracture of natural gas lines will likely start many fires in the cities. Many structures will be destroyed from the falling meteorites. Some number of people will also most likely be killed. It is very likely that cell phone and land line telephones will not be working as infrastructure would most likely be destroyed. This would also most likely occur for internet and radio. The loss of electricity affects every aspect of modern life.

The earth is shaking and the heavens are raining down upon the earth, every mountain and island are moved, and this is just the announcement by God telling the world that the Tribulation has started. It will affect all people everywhere in the world. All of this is happening before the fourth plague even starts, which is the first plague in the Tribulation. It occurs right after all people have made their choice to either take the mark of the beast or reject it.

Then the fourth plague comes fairly quickly after the start of the announcement of the Tribulation. It is described in the following scripture.

Rev 8:7 The first angel sounded, and there followed hail and fire mingled with blood, and they were cast upon the earth: and the third part of trees was burnt up, and all green grass was burnt up.

Rev 16:2 And the first went, and poured out his vial upon the earth; and there fell a noisome and grievous sore upon the men which had the mark of the beast, and *upon* them which worshipped his image.

The trumpets and the vials are the same plague described as the same effects at times, and differently at other times. Both together, adding more understanding of the effects of that plague.

With the fourth plague, now hail, fire and blood are cast upon the earth, this is the heavens again raining down upon the earth. A third part of the trees and grass are burnt up. Man experiences some of this hail with fire falling on him and burning him, causing grievous sores. This also means that the cities will experience much further burning and destruction. Imagine man trying to make repairs while this burning hail is falling on the earth.

Now reflect for a moment, with fuel storage tanks being destroyed and refineries being destroyed and the roads and rails being destroyed, in a very short period of time all petroleum driven vehicles and engines will no longer be able to be used. Likely oil producing wells in turn will be damaged. In addition there is no longer any electricity, water or natural gas being supplied to residences or factories. Earth moving equipment making repairs would quickly run out of fuel. Then repairs would need to be done by manual labor.

Without electricity, that is generated using natural gas, oil, hydro and in some cases coal, it means even if generating plants survive, the amount of electricity generated will be very little. Possibly some solar might survive. For generating stations that burn coal require diesel trucks to transport coal to the generating plants and diesel loaders and repaired roads. It is unlikely that natural gas, oil and hydro will be available. Any repairs for damaged equipment would need to be

carried out on site, replacement parts will not be able to be ordered. Metal working machines need electricity to operate, welding machines need electricity to operate, and so it goes.

Suddenly man is back to walking or the buggy and carriage drawn by horse and donkey and the use of candles for light. Will the world recover to any workable degree? Take note that the plagues of God will continue to be brought down on the world as time goes forth, one after another, and how long each plague continues is not known. The whole world will be struggling to survive. Understand that each plague is consecutively worse than the one preceding it. This process takes place over a 7 year period that starts with the announcement of the start of the Tribulation.

At the end of the fourth plague as described above as a possible scenario, it is also very likely that modern warfare, will in general no longer exist or be extremely limited and quickly be diminishing as time goes forward with more of the plagues coming.

Is all this plausible? Most likely it is, but those passing through the Tribulation will need to wait and see how it unfolds and the progressive effect on the world as the plagues keep coming down, one after another.

What is important is, whether one passes the test of God coming down upon the whole world, the test given just before the start of the Tribulation, or whether one fails the test. If you pass, then you will be sealed by God right after the Tribulation starts and before the fourth plague occurs. You will then be protected against God's further 7 plagues and you will have secured your salvation. If you fail then you will experience the full effects of the plagues and also lose your salvation and die before or by the end of the Tribulation.

4. Further Plague Destruction

Note that the plagues do not stop, but continue in a progressively more severe manner with each coming plague throughout the 7 year Tribulation period. This means that it becomes progressively harder for man to survive as time goes forth. Many will be dying along the way, over the 7 years.

From what took place previously in the times of sorrow prior to the start of the Tribulation, being disease, famine and death, will continue. Severe famine will continue to be experienced throughout the world, it started in the second plague and grew to the start of the Tribulation. Then with the earth's surface being rearranged the initial plagues would likely continue or carry over in a major way all affecting famine. Consider the fourth plague, it would amplify everything further, with 1/3 of the trees and grass burning up and food crops would also be contained within that destruction. Additionally the loss of petroleum fuel combined with road destruction will further effect the availability of food both in being grown and in distribution. Everything adds to the food famine, it is occurring in a parallel manner to the plagues that came upon Egypt. It is not only man that is affected by food shortage, also the domestic and wild animals are also severely affected.

Now add to the above with the fifth plague coming down on the world as listed as follows.

Rev 8:8 And the second angel sounded, and as it were a great mountain burning with fire was cast into the sea: and the third part of the sea became blood;

Rev 8:9 And the third part of the creatures which were in the sea, and had life, died; and the third part of the ships were destroyed.

Rev 16:3 And the second angel poured out his vial upon the sea; and it became as the blood of a dead *man*: and every living soul died in the sea.

The heavens continue to rain down destruction, a large mountain type meteorite falls in the sea, killing sea life and destroying ships. This means man's supply of food from the sea disappears adding to the food famine. In addition the third part of ships, aircraft carriers, submarines, fishing, cargo and other ships will be destroyed. Any remaining petroleum fuel must at this time be extremely scarce and in high demand for both on and off shore use. This also means air traffic will be severely limited if still existent. Note also a great tsunami will occur from the impact of the burning mountain being thrown into the sea. The tsunami will destroy coastal cities. Recognize a large world population lives in coastal cities along with most of the manufacturing and processing plants and factories, electric generating stations and water purification plants. All of these will be destroyed.

The sixth plague is directed at the fresh waters of lakes and streams, given as follows.

Rev 8:10 And the third angel sounded, and there fell a great star from heaven, burning as it were a lamp, and it fell upon the third part of the rivers, and upon the fountains of waters;

Rev 8:11 And the name of the star is called Wormwood: and the third part of the waters became wormwood; and many men died of the waters, because they were made bitter.

Rev 16:4 And the third angel poured out his vial upon the rivers and fountains of waters; and they became blood.

Rev 16:5 And I heard the angel of the waters say, Thou art righteous, O Lord, which art, and wast, and shalt be, because thou hast judged thus.

Rev 16:6 For they have shed the blood of saints and prophets, and thou hast given them blood to drink; for they are worthy.

Rev 16:7 And I heard another out of the altar say, Even so, Lord God Almighty, true and righteous *are* thy judgments.

What we learn is that fresh waters become poisonous to drink killing many men, and likely fresh water fish die as well. This further acts to increase famine and increase deaths.

Water cannot generally be pumped without electricity. It can be pumped to a very limited degree by using an ox, a horse or a donkey. This means distribution of domestic potable water will become a major problem and concern.

As time goes forward further plagues come upon the world making life more and more difficult. The entire world will be reeling in trying to survive. The world and man living on it, continues to struggle for survival as things continue to become worse and worse. Previous technology will be continually destroyed and not be able to be used or relied upon.

Transportation will become more and more difficult. Obtaining food will be a major challenge. Basic survival will dominate man's behavior. The war mongers will be struggling along with everyone else. The New World Order will quickly find itself in extreme difficulty and survival will direct its behavior as well.

Life will be changed from modern back to ancient times very quickly, with little help from technology. People will try and find the necessities of life, food, shelter, clothes and water.

Governments will be able to do very little to help, if they even continue to exist. All the infrastructure will be broken and support services to populations of Nations will vanish. Heat, water, food and any form of energy will be sparse or near nonexistent. Likely there will be little or no law and order. Any governments that come together will most likely be loosely operating. Over time small pockets of surviving people will likely come together forming a small society in a few locations.. Hospitals as we know them today will not exist. There will be a few rebuilt cities scattered throughout the world and there will be a small and diminishing population of others trying to live off the land over the entire world.

Without electricity generation very little will function. The high death toll in loss of people with knowledge to repair and run power plants will make it nearly impossible to conduct repairs, and the plants will not run without some type of fuel. Perhaps over some time, coal will be used for electric power generation in a very few locations and to some very limited degree.

This now brings the earth to the end of the sixth plague.

The seventh and eighth plagues are directed specifically acting upon man, making them suffer in pain and agony. We are not given any further information of world effects in these plagues other than their direct effect on mankind, both physical and psychological. The world will basically come to a stand still, even more than it had from the previous plagues. People will wish to die to escape but death will be withheld from them. Other direct effects on the earth itself are not occurring over these two plagues, other than severe darkness, and severe burning of man from the sun, therefore they are not covered any further in this document. However the severe heat from the sun may affect crops and food production adding to the famine.

5. The Last two Plagues

The ninth and tenth plagues give further information on effects to the world as a whole. These plagues approach the final two years of the end time of the Tribulation. Therefore these need to be continued in looking at and examining.

First the ninth plague is described by scriptures as follows.

Rev 9:13 And the sixth angel sounded, and I heard a voice from the four horns of the golden altar which is before God,

Rev 9:14 Saying to the sixth angel which had the trumpet, Loose the four angels which are bound in the great river Euphrates.

Rev 9:15 And the four angels were loosed, which were prepared for an hour, and a day, and a month, and a year, for to slay the third part of men.

Rev 9:16 And the number of the army of the horsemen *were* two hundred thousand thousand: and I heard the number of them.

Rev 9:17 And thus I saw the horses in the vision, and them that sat on them, having breastplates of fire, and of jacinth, and brimstone: and the heads of the horses *were* as the heads of lions; and out of their mouths issued fire and smoke and brimstone.

Rev 9:18 By these three was the third part of men killed, by the fire, and by the smoke, and by the brimstone, which issued out of their mouths.

Rev 9:19 For their power is in their mouth, and in their tails: for their tails *were* like unto serpents, and had heads, and with them they do hurt.

Rev 9:20 And the rest of the men which were not killed by these plagues yet repented not of the works of their hands, that they should not worship devils, and idols of gold, and silver, and brass, and stone, and of wood: which neither can see, nor hear, nor walk:

Rev 9:21 Neither repented they of their murders, nor of their sorceries, nor of their fornication, nor of their thefts.

Rev 16:12 And the sixth angel poured out his vial upon the great river Euphrates; and the water thereof was dried up, that the way of the kings of the east might be prepared.

Rev 16:13 And I saw three unclean spirits like frogs *come* out of the mouth of the dragon, and out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false prophet.

Rev 16:14 For they are the spirits of devils, working miracles, *which* go forth unto the kings of the earth and of the whole world, to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty.

Rev 16:15 Behold, I come as a thief. Blessed is he that watcheth, and keepeth his garments, lest he walk naked, and they see his shame.

Rev 16:16 And he gathered them together into a place called in the Hebrew tongue Armageddon.

There is a lot of information in these scriptures. First it is 4 angels of the LORD that control the large army of horsemen that kill 1/3 of men on the earth. This army of the four angels is 200 million in number. The horses they ride are not anything man has seen before. Rather they kill by fire, smoke and brimstone coming from their mouths with their heads having the appearance of lions and their tails are like serpents with heads and they hurt man with these tails. Just like the special locusts of the 8th plague, that were never seen before by man, so are these special horses unlike anything ever seen before. These two creatures are supernatural creations of God used to carry out His wrath upon the world. This ninth plague occurs for over one year.

The Euphrates river is dried up to allow an army from the East to come against Israel. There are three spirits of devils that go out through the earth to gather various nations and their armies together and come against Israel. These then come and converge at the plain called Armageddon.

Note that later in the Millennium with the Euphrates River dried up, it allows the remnant of God's people to be able to walk and return to Israel. Crossing the river is no longer an obstacle. Also initially the river being dried up allows horses and wagons of war to easily cross it, for the army coming from the East against Jerusalem.

The last or tenth plague follows, as described below.

Rev 11:15 And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become *the kingdoms* of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever.

Rev 11:16 And the four and twenty elders, which sat before God on their seats, fell upon their faces, and worshipped God,

Rev 11:17 Saying, We give thee thanks, O Lord God Almighty, which art, and wast, and art to come; because thou hast taken to thee thy great power, and hast reigned.

Rev 11:18 And the nations were angry, and thy wrath is come, and the time of the dead, that they should be judged, and that thou shouldest give reward unto thy servants the prophets, and to the saints, and them that fear thy name, small and great; and shouldest destroy them which

destroy the earth.

Rev 11:19 And the temple of God was opened in heaven, and there was seen in his temple the ark of his testament: and there were lightnings, and voices, and thunderings, and an earthquake, and great hail.

Rev 16:17 And the seventh angel poured out his vial into the air; and there came a great voice out of the temple of heaven, from the throne, saying, It is done.

Rev 16:18 And there were voices, and thunders, and lightnings; and there was a great earthquake, such as was not since men were upon the earth, so mighty an earthquake, *and* so great.

Rev 16:19 And the great city was divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell: and great Babylon came in remembrance before God, to give unto her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of his wrath.

Rev 16:20 And every island fled away, and the mountains were not found.

Rev 16:21 And there fell upon men a great hail out of heaven, *every stone* about the weight of a talent: and men blasphemed God because of the plague of the hail; for the plague thereof was exceeding great.

Again considerable information is given to us. First there is thunder, lightning, hail and a great earthquake larger than since men were on the earth. The great city, likely Rome, was divided into three parts. Cities in all Nations throughout the world fell, which tells us there was some rebuilding of cities over the Tribulation. Every island disappeared and every mountain disappeared as well. This is a major unfathomable change, the land has again been severely changed. Great hail from heaven reigned down, this hail had the weight of 70 lbs each and the action or destruction of this plague was exceedingly great.

There is more, with the world armies attacking Jerusalem and being destroyed and all evil people being destroyed, there is a lot of further death. In addition the devastation was vast and the earth was completely changed in geography, now no Islands or mountains are present. Throughout the plagues of God the earth was continually changed in landscape, with more and more devastation making it more and more difficult to survive.

6. Rider on a White Horse

Attached to the last or 10th plague is the second coming of Yeshua. Yeshua comes with the armies of heaven as described below.

Rev 19:13 And he *was* clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called The Word of God.

Rev 19:14 And the armies *which were* in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean.

Rev 19:15 And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

Rev 19:16 And he hath on *his* vesture and on his thigh a name written, KING OF KINGS, AND

LORD OF LORDS.

Rev 19:17 And I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the fowls that fly in the midst of heaven, Come and gather yourselves together unto the supper of the great God;

Rev 19:18 That ye may eat the flesh of kings, and the flesh of captains, and the flesh of mighty men, and the flesh of horses, and of them that sit on them, and the flesh of all *men, both* free and bond, both small and great.

Rev 19:19 And I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against him that sat on the horse, and against his army.

Rev 19:20 And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.

Rev 19:21 And the remnant were slain with the sword of him that sat upon the horse, which *sword* proceeded out of his mouth: and all the fowls were filled with their flesh.

Yeshua destroys all the armies coming against him and Jerusalem. The fowls of the air are invited by Yeshua to a feast of the dead soldiers and dead horses. Interesting Rev 19:18 tells us of dead horses. God's word is truth, therefore the army coming against Jerusalem was using horses.

That scripture is very significant as it points to a world at this time, the end of the Tribulation, not having the weapons of war that we know today. Helicopters, airplanes, armor vehicles, tanks and trucks all need diesel fuel to operate. The presence of horses strongly suggests that the army coming against Jerusalem made their way across land by using horses and possibly oxen, with wagons, etc, just like travel was done for the conquests in Napoleon's time or Alexander the Great's time.

It suggests that an extremely heavy toll was exacted on all Nations over the end times and the way people lived reverted back to manual labor and transportation with walking or likely horse and buggy or wagon. At the end time it appears that nuclear war no longer was a threat.

This also seems to fit well with the special horses of God's army lead by the 4 angels, that destroy 1/3 of mankind in the 9th plague.

Also looking at Zechariah directed to the time of Yeshua's second coming and fighting for Jerusalem, we are told the following.

Zec 14:15 And so shall be the plague of the horse, of the mule, of the camel, and of the ass, and of all the beasts that shall be in these tents, as this plague.

This reinforces that those coming against Jerusalem were using horses and wagons drawn by mules, donkey's, camels and likely oxen. All of these animals of the world army are destroyed by the plague from the LORD at this final end time.

Consider also the following from Micah that refers to the remnant of the LORD's people being saved, speaking to the end of the Tribulation at the second coming of Yeshua.

Mic 5:10 And it shall come to pass in that day, saith the LORD, that I will cut off thy horses out of the midst of thee, and I will destroy thy chariots:

The same 10th plague that comes upon the army coming against Jerusalem also comes against all beasts that the enemy nations brought with them. This again is interesting as we think in terms of modern warfare with tanks and vehicles, but it is stated in God's word that at this time man is reduced back to using horses, mules, camels and asses for transportation and warfare, as well as horses and chariots. So somewhere along the way transportation and warfare definitely changed. It could be suddenly at the beginning of Tribulation or more gradually as the plagues progressed.

7. Following the End of the Tribulation

One further possible scenario is given from the scripture below, it describes what happens at the end of the Tribulation and the start of the Millennium rule of God on earth. It is occurring at the tenth plague.

[Rev 16:20](#) And every island fled away, and the mountains were not found.

This has possible implications to the return of the remnant people of the LORD. The Euphrates River was made dry making it easy for God's people to return to Israel. Also in scripture we are told that the Egyptian rivers were made dry as well, resulting in a removal of obstacles for God's people in order to walk back to Israel.

Rev 16:20 has a possible implication that all the continents of the world are moved back together as they were at one time. This would allow God's people to walk back to Israel from every nation in the world, from wherever they were scattered. Seas and oceans would not then need to be crossed which would be a major impediment without large ships that required sails only.

We know from many scriptures that the scattered Israelites from all the Nations throughout the world are gathered and come back to Israel. It is unlikely that aircraft or fuel powered ships exist any longer at that point in time. This is at the start of the Millennium.

In addition Zechariah 14 tells us the Nations throughout the world need to come to Jerusalem for the feast of Tabernacles each year. If the continents were all back together this would make it very possible, not requiring the crossing of an ocean or sea.

8. Summary

The main purpose of this document was, to by using God's word, try and visualize possible scenarios that might fit as God's plagues come down on the world in the end time, and the result of the effects of these plagues on the world. We really will not know how it all unfolds and the effect on people and their lives throughout the world, until it actually happens.

A secondary purpose was to try to make visualizations more real in order to understand just how terrible the plagues really are in their effect on the whole world and upon mankind, and how difficult life becomes for survival.

The only way forward through what is coming for those people who pass the test of God, just before the Tribulation, is to go forward with Faith and complete Trust in the LORD.

There is a positive upside to all of this, if one is properly motivated, there is currently enough time left that one can change and walk forward correctly in God's way forward. It is a free will choice. If you do this, Yeshua will keep you from having to pass through the Tribulation period, yes this is given in scripture and it is not by a resurrection. To make this change you must let go of your preconceived ideas and then walk in the Torah, follow and obey Yeshua and grow with a loving heart. This requires one to walk in total obedience to God's word and not to compromise. Remember that the end times are like the days of Noah, all the world including the 6 mainstream Christian Churches, all are walking the wrong way.

If you decide to do this, pray, repent and start by keeping the weekly Sabbath in the manner it was originally given to us by our heavenly Father. Follow and celebrate the Holy Days of God. Learn the Torah and ask for God's Holy Spirit to guide and help you walk in His path. Do not listen to what others say, use only God's word in going forth. Be aware that the three traps of life do not make their way into your walk, the pride of life is the most subtle of the three and easily slips in unnoticed. A key Bible that will guide and help one to come to this walk is "The Complete Jewish Study Bible", it is written for Gentiles to come to understand the true **context** of reading the scriptures of the Bible, words written by Jews for Jews directed to man by the Holy Spirit.

Once the Tribulation starts, your fate is sealed. Time is becoming very short.
