The Bride of Christ

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1. Introduction

This topic is of major important in today's time. It is a topic that one needs considerable scripture to identify who the Bride is and what and when things happen to her. It is all contained in scripture and if you can think and let go of preconceived ideas and disregard what others tell you, then you can find the answers in God's word. The only Doctrine we are to follow is that of the Complete Bible itself. Understand that the Bible is God's word given directly to us, it is truth and that we are to live by every word of God. That means the Old and New Testament are one Bible. More on this truth will be given later.

2. Deception

In the New Testament, Yeshua (Jesus) and the Apostles tell us 17 times to beware of deception. The more times something is repeated in the Bible the more important it is. When something is repeated 2 or 3 times it is very important. When repeated 17 times it is extremely important. This warning was given to the Congregations in the early Churches being set up by the Apostles. They knew that deception would try and work its way into the minds of those who were following Yeshua as well as those who were leading the Congregations. Yeshua warned us that the deception will become greater in the latter days, these are today's times.

The Churches of today cannot identify the deceptions that have established themselves within their teachings. Do not accept what Church Doctrines or Church pastors tell you as they do not have it right. Each person needs to study and learn what God's word tells them personally. This is of critical importance especially today as time is running out. The test of God coming upon the whole world is fast approaching. The question is do you know how to pass this test?

3. The Churches of Today

The LORD is logical and organized, all scripture is given to us for a purpose, whether you understand it or not. The Book of Revelations is given very specifically as a main focus to those that will be alive and will be passing through the Tribulation and experiencing the events that are coming. It is the last call to Christians to change and walk properly.

The letters by Yeshua to the 7 Churches or Congregations are not just historical Churches but also current Christian Churches of today. This is not coincidental, this is not by chance, this was designed by God. Look around there are 7 groups of Christian Churches today. These groups are based upon the manner they follow Yeshua. Their method of going forward is found in the Doctrine of each of these Churches.

The seven Christian Churches of today are; Orthodox, Roman Catholic, Latter Day Saints, Jehovah Witness, Seventh Day Adventist, Protestant, and Complete Bible Followers. All except for the Complete Bible Followers have twisted and distorted God's word by adding to or taking away from it.

In the 7 letters there is only one congregation that is told they will not have to take the test that comes upon the whole world. They will not have to pass through the Tribulation. This scripture is as follows:

Rev 3:10 Because thou hast kept the word of my patience, I also will keep thee from the hour of temptation, which shall come upon all the world, to try them that dwell upon the earth.

Many or all of the 6 mainstream Churches think that this scripture is referring to them. It is not, this Congregation in Rev 3:10 has little strength, in fact it is extremely difficult to find them. The Congregation referred to is that of the Complete Bible Followers. The other Churches say the Old Testament no longer applies, that rather a brand new Covenant exits being the New Testament only. They say all of the Old Covenant was nailed to the cross. It was not, and they cannot find any scripture that supports their Doctrine. However there is lots of scripture that tells us the Entire Bible applies equally today as it did in the past.

4. Why the 6 Churches are Wrong

The six mainstream Christian Churches are wrong due to the system that they use to train pastors. They have Bible Colleges that train their pastors by teaching them in a classroom. What is taught is the Doctrine of the Church that they will lead when they finish their learning program. They are taught by man who unknowingly teaches errors that result in bad preconceived ideas that later cannot be let go of. They do not learn being taught by God's Holy Spirit. What they learn they then preach to their congregation. Preconceived ideas that are wrong do not allow a person to understand and accept what scripture says. Once preconceived ideas that are wrong are learned, it is nearly impossible for man to open their mind to scripture in order to understand what is really being said.

At the reformation when the Protestant movement questioned and broke away from the Catholic Church, they did not question everything, they did not go far enough. They retained much from the Catholic Doctrine that is followed by them even today.

The Church Colleges do not teach their pastors how to read scripture in proper context. Nor do they teach that one should always use Strong's numbers from the Old Testament whenever possible. They have removed themselves as far away as possible from what they consider as Jewish traditions and interpret the New Testament as being written specifically to them, to the Gentiles. They treat the Old Testament as just applying to the Jews.

Therefore in today's time these pastors teach errors to their congregations, which happen to be lies. They are deceived and in turn deceive their congregations.

Very occasionally the odd person in a mainstream Church congregation sees that scripture is saying something very different than what the pastors are preaching and also that the logic in what is being preached is flawed. These few when they continue to learn on their own, most often end up leaving the Church and often become Complete Bible Followers.

Recognize also that if a pastor finds Bible truth opened to them that goes against their Church Doctrine, that person faces a major dilemma. Their salary or livelihood is paid by their Church.

5. Understanding Scripture

First understand that the Bible was written by Israelites and written to Israelites or Jews. It was not written to the Gentiles, although it does apply to all who accept our Heavenly Father and Yeshua. The Bible focuses on the History and future of the Israelites. End time prophecy is built around the Israelites, Israel as a Nation, Jerusalem and the return of God's chosen people to the promised land.

Second, the traditions that are considered Jewish and were removed, these are in fact God's Statutes and Ordinances, not man's, not the Israelites, but rather God's. They are given to all that follow the LORD, both Gentiles and Israelites.

Third, God does not change, when He tells us something is forever it stays that way unless he tells us different. We have not been told different.

Fourth, in the New Testament there are over 30 scriptures that tell us of Yeshua's active role throughout the Old Testament as the mediator between man and the Father. One only needs a very few of these scriptures to understand what was a secret previously, to understand that which was hidden to those in the Old Testament. It was Yeshua who walked in the Garden of Eden and talked with Adam. It was Yeshua that gave Moses the Law or Torah as well as the 10 commandments. It was Yeshua's back that Moses saw. It was Yeshua that sent the plague at Mount Sinai that killed 14,700 before it was stopped, and many more active interactions. By logic this means there is one complete Bible, Old and New all together. Any pastor that does not know Yeshua's active role throughout the entire Old Testament does not know the Bible.

Since the Bible was written by Israelites, and the New Testament in particular was written by Jews, it means one must read the Bible through the eyes of the Israelites or Jews. Since the Strong's Numbers define the meaning of Bible words, one should always use the Old Testament Strong's Numbers wherever possible as they use Hebrew words that have a much deeper meaning than the Greek words from the Strong's Numbers used in the New Testament.

Reading scripture in proper context means at the start, one must ask and answer three questions that apply to the scripture in question. First question is who is speaking, second is who is being spoken to and third what did it mean to that society at that point in time. Then one reads scripture above and below as far as necessary to obtain further understanding.

An example of reading in proper context is given using the following scripture.

Mat 4:4 But he answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God.

It is Yeshua that is speaking, He is speaking to Satan who is trying to tempt Him and Satan knows the Bible. The scripture Yeshua uses in answering Satan comes from the Old Testament. This scripture in the Old Testament is given below.

Deu 8:3 And he humbled thee, and suffered thee to hunger, and fed thee with manna, which thou knewest not, neither did thy fathers know; that he might make thee know that man doth not live by bread only, but by every *word* that proceedeth out of the mouth of the LORD doth man live.

What does this really tell us? At the time of Yeshua, only the Old Testament existed. Yeshua is following and quoting God's word as given in the Old Testament and also following it. We are to hear, follow and obey Yeshua. That means from this scripture we are to keep the directives given in the Old Testament. Thinking and using logic, these words used by Yeshua tells us the Old Testament was never done away with. Now we have the New and Old Testament, both together. These together are now every Word of God. Now we live by every word of God from both the Old and New Testaments.

This is but one simple example, unfortunately few if any Pastors know how to read in proper context.

God is totally logical, scripture is totally logical, to understand God's word you must be able to think with logic.

6. Some Extremely Important Scripture

The word hear or hearken in Hebrew is Shema. This means to both hear and obey. This is defined by Strong's Number in the Old Testament, but not in the New. This is one example of why one needs to use the Strong's Numbers in the Old Testament whenever possible. God raised up a prophet like Moses who we are to Hear and Obey. That prophet is Yeshua.

Act 3:22 For Moses truly said unto the fathers, A prophet shall the Lord your God raise up unto you of your brethren, like unto me; him shall ye **hear** in all things whatsoever he shall say unto you.

Act 3:23 And it shall come to pass, *that* every soul, which will not hear that prophet, shall be destroyed from among the people.

There is a penalty for not hearing and obeying Yeshua. See also Deu 18:15-19. The words that Yeshua gives us are to be heard, obeyed and followed.

Next, what is sin? The act of sin is defined for us in the Bible by the following verse.

1Jn 3:4 Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth also the law: for **sin is the transgression of the law.**

The breaking or walking outside of the Law of God is sin. To understand what is being said Strong's Numbers need to be used for the word Law. From the New Testament the law is the laws of Moses, from the Old Testament the Hebrew word is Torah which includes everything in the first 5 books of the Bible. The law contains the directives of what we are to do and not to do, They are given to us from God and they are forever.

Next the word that is important is iniquity. From Strong's Number it is the transgression of the law. It is walking outside of the law or Torah. This word is extremely important as stated by Yeshua in the following verses.

Mat 7:21 Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.

Mat 7:22 Many will say to me **in that day**, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works?

Mat 7:23 And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.

These statements by Yeshua are given to those present at the Sermon on the Mount. Those present are Jews and they all know that they are to walk in the Torah. Yeshua is telling them if they do not keep the Torah or the Law, that He does not know them and they will not be accepted into the Kingdom of Heaven "in that day", resurrection day.

In today's time one of the most important scriptures given to us directly from Yeshua is the following.

Mat 5:18 For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the **law**, till all be fulfilled.

This again is from the Sermon on the Mount. It tells us that the Torah is fully in effect until a far future time. Until Heaven and Earth pass away and until all prophecy is fulfilled. These actions of prophecy being fulfilled occur on the Last Day at the end of the Millennium. Yes the Law or Torah is in full effect today and will be through the Millennium.

Going further another scripture by Yeshua reinforces the above.

Mat 24:35 Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away.

Anyone that tells others that the Law or Torah has been done away with is lying. They are not hearing and obeying Yeshua. Recognize these pastors in all the 6 mainstream Christian Churches in today's time say the Torah has been done away with. Understand also that the Torah is much more comprehensive than just the 10 commandments. The 10 commandments are a short document used as representing the legal covenant at Mount Sinai.

Again from the above of Mat 5:7-19 it is clear that the entire Old Testament is still the word of God that we are to live by and the Torah needs to be walked in.

Walk in the Torah, for if you do not then you walk in sin.

Other scriptures of utmost importance are the following.

Mat 22:36 Master, which is the great commandment in the law?

Mat 22:37 Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind.

Mat 22:38 This is the first and great commandment.

Mat 22:39 And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

Love to God is accomplished by walking in total obedience to His will. That means walking in the Torah, following, hearing and obeying Yeshua.

7. Defining the Saints

The Saints are defined in the following scripture.

Rev 14:12 Here is the patience of the saints: here *are* they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus.

There are three requirements, the first is patience or endurance without complaining for whatever the world brings down upon them. The second is they keep the commandments of God, these are the Torah. Third they accept Yeshua as their saviour and they follow and obey Him.

In the Congregations or Churches that Paul set up, in his letters he addresses these new congregations as the Saints. These are found in the following.

Rom 16:15 Salute Philologus, and Julia, Nereus, and his sister, and Olympas, and **all the saints** which are with them.

2Co 1:1 Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, and Timothy *our* brother, unto the church of God which is at Corinth, with **all the saints** which are in all Achaia:

Eph 1:1 Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, **to the saints** which are at Ephesus, and to the faithful in Christ Jesus:

Php 1:1 Paul and Timotheus, the servants of Jesus Christ, **to all the saints** in Christ Jesus which are at Philippi, with the bishops and deacons:

Col 1:2 **To the saints** and faithful brethren in Christ which are at Colosse: Grace *be* unto you, and peace, from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

These early Congregations, by the way they walked were identified by Paul as the Saints.

Those that truly follow Yeshua keep the weekly Sabbath, keep the Holy Days, grow in the heart and walk in the Torah. These are the Saints.

In addition those who are killed for their belief in Yeshua earn the right of becoming one of the Saints as a result of their unwavering commitment to the LORD, as given in the following scripture.

Psa 116:15 Precious in the sight of the LORD is the death of his saints.

In the past right after Yeshua's resurrection the Saints from Adam's time through to Christ's resurrection were also resurrected and came up out of the graves.

Mat 27:52 And the graves were opened; and many bodies of **the saints** which slept arose, Mat 27:53 And came out of the graves after his resurrection, and went into the holy city, and appeared unto many.

This occurred on the Holy Day of First Fruits of the Spring Harvest. This is the first collection of the Saints. It would include Noah, Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Moses, King David, and many others also including John the Baptist.

8. The Early Congregations

Paul and the Apostles set up the early Congregations of those that follow and accept Yeshua as the Messiah. They were directed by the Holy Spirit and followed the only Bible that was available to them, the Old Testament. The Congregations set up by Paul consisted mostly of Gentiles. Paul also calls the Congregations in Jerusalem the Saints, which were comprised of mainly Jews. These all followed Yeshua and walked in the same way.

From the following we are told of the Gentile Congregations as set up by Paul, that they were zealous for the Torah.

Act 21:19 And when he had saluted them, he declared particularly what things God had wrought among the **Gentiles by his ministry**.

Act 21:20 And when they heard *it*, they glorified the Lord, and said unto him, Thou seest, brother, how many thousands of Jews there are which believe; and they are **all zealous of the law:**

We are told that the Gentile Congregations were learning and walking in the Torah. Paul himself was a scholar of the Torah. That scripture tells us is that the early Congregations, both Jews and Gentiles followed and obeyed Yeshua and walked in the Torah.

None of the 6 mainstream Christian Churches or Congregations of today walk in the Torah, nor do they really follow and obey Yeshua. They are not walking the same as the early Congregations. Rather they say the Torah was done away with and they are very selective in what they do in following Yeshua.

The Complete Bible Followers today, walk in the same manner as the early Congregations, they follow and obey Yeshua and walk in the Torah. Today this Congregation is comprised of a very

few individuals scattered everywhere. They can be identified as those keeping the statutes (God's Holy Days) and Judgments (Right Rulings). They are in today's time the only ones meeting the requirements of being the Saints.

9. Those Destined to go through the Tribulation

The entire world including all the 6 mainstream Christian Churches are destined to go through the Tribulation. They will be required to take the test of God that is brought down on the entire world just before the start of the Tribulation. One exception are the very few Complete Bible Followers, they will not take the test nor pass through the Tribulation.

The Complete Bible Followers are not resurrected until the end of the Tribulation along with those others that passed the test and endured the Tribulation. Even though this first group is kept from the hour of temptation it is not by a resurrection. It is either being put to sleep or taken to a place of refuge before the Tribulation starts. It could be either. This is the promise to these few as given by Yeshua in Rev 3:10 as above. Moses was put to sleep and could not enter the promised land. We also know there is a place of refuge for the Woman to flee to at the midpoint of the tribulation. We will not know which of these two options occur until the start of the Tribulation, but it definitely is not by a resurrection.

There are two sets of scriptures that tell us there is no resurrection until the end of the Tribulation and occurring only at Yeshua's second coming in the clouds. The first set is as follows.

Rev 6:9 And when he had opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of them that were slain for the word of God, and for the testimony which they held:

Rev 6:10 And they cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth?

Rev 6:11 And white robes were given unto every one of them; and it was said unto them, that they should rest yet for a little season, until their fellowservants also and their brethren, that should be killed as they were, should be fulfilled.

The breaking of the fifth seal is occurring just before God announces the start of the Tribulation. These martyrs are Saints asking how long do they have to wait. They are told only a little season until their fellow servants join them. They need to wait until those others passing through the Tribulation that have God's seal are killed or martyred and join them. The resurrection for all these martyrs comes at the end of the Tribulation with Yeshua's second coming.

The second set of scriptures that need to be taken along with the above are the following.

1Th 4:15 For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive *and* remain unto the coming of the Lord **shall not prevent them which are asleep**.

1Th 4:16 For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and **the dead in Christ shall rise first:**

1Th 4:17 Then we which are alive *and* remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.

For the resurrection, we are told the dead rise first, then followed by those that are alive. Since the martyrs under the throne room need to wait, those Saints alive and not passing through the Tribulation will also need to wait to the end of the Tribulation to be resurrected.

The final collection of the remainder of the saints, those from Yeshua's going back to Heaven, up to the time of His second coming will occur as the First Fruits of the Summer Harvest. This occurs at the end of the 7 year Tribulation period in the clouds. Then Yeshua comes down to earth with All His Saints.

Zec 14:5 And ye shall flee *to* the valley of the mountains; for the valley of the mountains shall reach unto Azal: yea, ye shall flee, like as ye fled from before the earthquake in the days of Uzziah king of Judah: and the LORD my God shall come, *and* **all the saints** with thee.

The collection of the summer harvest of Saints will be of two groups. Those that were walking properly and do not pass through the Tribulation and those that pass the test of God that He brings upon the entire world and then go through the Tribulation. The first group are the Complete Bible Followers, the second group are those in the 6 mainstream Christian Churches of today and others that call themselves Christians. Those that pass the test are marked by God for protection from the remaining 7 plagues. By passing the test and enduring the Tribulation, this group earns the right of becoming one of the Saints.

After Yeshua takes control of the entire world the Saints rule with Him over the thousand years.

10. The Bride

In the Jewish tradition the groom would come for the bride at a time that was unknown. So the bride had to be ready at all times. We know that Yeshua is the Bridegroom as given to us in the following.

Mat 9:14 Then came to him the disciples of John, saying, Why do we and the Pharisees fast oft, but thy disciples fast not?

Mat 9:15 And Jesus said unto them, Can the children of the bridechamber mourn, as long as the bridegroom is with them? but the days will come, when the bridegroom shall be taken from them, and then shall they fast.

We also know in Jewish tradition that the bridegroom goes away to prepare a place where he and the bride will live. Then after this preparation he comes to collect the bride.

Yeshua goes away to prepare a place for the Bride and then He will come back and collect her.

Joh 14:2 In my Father's house are many mansions: if *it were* not *so*, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.

Joh 14:3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, *there* ye may be also.

From context the Bride is Yeshua's disciples, which initially were the 12 plus others that were closely following Him. Further Paul makes a correlation of the Saints to all that correctly follow Yeshua.

Eph 1:18 The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of **his inheritance in the saints**,

Eph 3:8 Unto me, who am less than the least of all saints, is this grace given, that I should preach among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ;

The Apostles were originally called disciples, students that learn and follow the Master. All those that follow Yeshua by hearing and obeying are His disciples, these are the Saints. It is only these that are the Bride that Yeshua returns to collect at His second coming. The collection takes place in two separate events, the one at Yeshua's resurrection and the other at His second coming. At the end of the Tribulation the Bride has been collected and the Bride resides with Yeshua in Jerusalem over the millennium. It is only the Saints that have been resurrected, the rest of the dead sleep until the Last Day at the end of the Millennium. Then they are resurrected and judged. Those whose names are in the Book of Life are given eternal life with the Father and the Son in the New Jerusalem on the New World. The others are resurrected and thrown into the lake of fire.

After the judgment before the Great White Throne, those that are given life with the Father and the Son now join the Saints and also become the Bride.

Rev 21:2 And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

Rev 21:3 And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God *is* with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, *and be* their God.

Rev 21:9 And there came unto me one of the seven angels which had the seven vials full of the seven last plagues, and talked with me, saying, Come hither, **I will shew thee the bride**, the Lamb's wife.

Rev 21:10 And he carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and shewed me that great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God,

All that now reside in the New Jerusalem and on the New Earth are the Bride.

We are told that at the Last Day Yeshua will gather all that are His. He will not lose any.

Joh 6:39 And this is the Father's will which hath sent me, that of all which he hath given me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day.

Joh 6:40 And this is the will of him that sent me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day.

These others Yeshua gathers are those whose name is in the Book of Life, these are also the Bride and will reside in the New Jerusalem and stated above.

Each of the 6 mainstream Christian Churches think that they are the Bride. They are not, but they will have the opportunity at the start of the Tribulation to pass the test and become the Bride. If they do not pass the test they lose their salvation.

Additionally there is enough time left at the moment, if others accept and walk in the Torah, truly follow, hear and obey Yeshua and grow in the heart, they will join the Complete Bible Followers and become the Saints. Then they will not be required to pass through the Tribulation. To become a Complete Bible follower takes time and there is not much time left. Currently the first two plagues of God are active and coming down on the whole world. The third plague has not started as yet. At the end of the first three plagues is the start of the Tribulation followed by the remaining 7 plagues. It is coming very close. Those that are awake and know God's word recognize that we are in the days of sorrow and experiencing the start of the 2nd Exodus.

There was an invitation given to become one of the Saints, this was made at the start of the early Congregations or Churches, Rom 1:7, 1Co 1:2. However many are called but few are chosen.

11. Summary

The Bible is clear but to understand it one must have an open mind and accept what is shown to them. Then other scripture will be opened. If you do not accept what is opened, then nothing else will ever be opened to you.

One must read scripture in proper context, you must read it through the eyes of the Jews according to their society at that time.

We are to live by every word of God, that means everything in both the Old and New Testaments.

We are to follow, hear and obey Yeshua, that means among other things walking in the Torah.

In today's time only the Complete Bible Followers are the Saints and they are the only ones that will not take the test nor pass through the Tribulation. All other people alive will be required take the test and to pass through the Tribulation.

Those that pass the test and then go through the Tribulation are given Saint status.

There is no resurrection until the end of the Tribulation when Yeshua comes in the clouds. The dead rise first then those that are alive follow after.

The Bride that is with Yeshua through the Millennium are all the Saints. The summer fruits harvest of Saints are gathered at Yeshua's second coming and join with the initial harvest of the

spring first fruits of the Saints. These then live and reign with Yeshua in Jerusalem through the Millennium.

At the Last Day, those written in the Book of Life become the remaining people making up the Bride. These are the large fall harvest of souls that are Yeshua's. These are those that Yeshua will not lose any. These now fill and reside in the New Jerusalem on the New Earth along with the Saints.

The collection of the Bride by Christ takes place at three distinct and different times. The Saints are collected first at two different times about 2000 yrs apart, the rest of the souls are collected at the end of the Millennium, a 1000 yrs later. These all are essentially those in the Congregations or Churches whose name was written in the Book of Life, but collected in a much different manner that what the 6 current day Churches think. The collections take place at specific appointed times of the Father. There is a ranking or hierarchy of souls among the Bride, this is given in scriptures. The Saints are the administrators.

Those in the 6 mainstream Churches of today are deceived and are not walking according to the Early Churches. They are not walking according to our Heavenly Fathers will. Unfortunately many of these current day Christians will fall away as the Tribulation becomes closer and most likely only a very few will pass the test of God that occurs just before the start of the Tribulation. Many will abandon their faith, others will compromise and fail the test. The test is one of placing total trust in the LORD and not in the evil world.
