# **God's Judgment of People**

#### 1. Introduction

A serious topic is how will God judge people at the final Judgment that occurs at the end of this world. Scripture tells us that on The **Last Day** all those that were not previously resurrected at Jesus (Yeshua) second coming will be judged before the Great White Throne, Rev 20:11-15. The first resurrection was only of a very few select people, the saints. The second resurrection is all the Masses of people including at least 99 % of those that call themselves Christians.

Unfortunately few people understand the criteria that God has set up to Judge all mankind in the world. This understanding is lost in the six mainstream groups of Christian Churches in the world today. This lack of understanding is set in what is called Church Doctrine, a number of statements made by a committee of men that directs a particular Church and what a pastor of that Church follows and teaches. Recognize that those that become pastors go to a Church controlled college and are taught in a classroom by others, who in turn were taught in the same manner. This means errors of understanding God's word are continually repeated and then end up being taught by the pastor to his Congregation. God never intended that this method of learning was to be followed. Rather one was to learn by self study of God's word with help from a few others who learned by direction of God's Holy Spirit. Those in a classroom are not learning by the direction of the Holy Spirit. You might question this but examine the following two scriptures;

Act 5:32 And we are his witnesses of these things; and *so is* also the Holy Ghost, whom God hath given to them that **obey him**.

1Jn 3:24 And he that *keepeth his commandments* dwelleth in him, and he in him. And hereby we know that he abideth in us, by the Spirit which he hath given us.

The Holy Spirit is only active in those that obey God and that means total obedience. Those that are not walking in total obedience have a Holy Spirit in them that is dormant. Now the question is what commands are to be totally obeyed? This is answered by Yeshua in the following;

Mat 5:17 Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil.

Mat 5:18 For verily I say unto you, *Till* heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from *the law*, *till* all be fulfilled.

Mat 5:19 Whosoever therefore shall break one of these least commandments, and shall teach men so, he shall be called the *least in the kingdom of heaven*: but whosoever shall do and teach *them*, the same shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven.

What ever Yeshua tells us is to be obeyed, it is not optional. These scriptures are of utmost importance, for all time. They must be read in proper context and with the use of logic and Strong's Numbers in order to truly understand them. The six mainstream groups of Churches read these verses out of proper context and without using logic and Strong's Numbers. They ignore the verses they do not like. In doing this they distort God's commands and justify to themselves as to how they can walk.

The correct understanding is gained by first recognizing Yeshua is speaking and He is Jew born into the tribe of Judah. Second He is speaking to a crowd of fellow Jews. Third the meaning to Jewish society at that point in time meant that they were all raised in following the Law (Torah) and if Yeshua told them it was done away with and they no longer had to walk in it, they would have left Yeshua and told the Jewish police who arrested anyone breaking the Torah. That person would be thrown in jail and then brought before the ruling Jewish authorities, the Sanhedrin, and tried. If found guilty, by testimony from two or more witnesses, that person would be punished.

Using Strong's Numbers, the word Law is G3551 and is the Law is that given to Moses. Going to the Old Testament Law is H8451, and the Hebrew word is **Torah**, it is everything in the first five books of the Bible. It is also called the Decalogue as well as the Pentateuch. Second the word **fulfil** in Mat 5:17 has two opposite meanings according to strong's Number, G4137. It can mean to do away with or to **preach fully**. The translator picked a word that was not clear in its meaning, a better translation would be to **teach completely**.

Next examining the logic in Mat 5:17, Yeshua tells those present that he did not come to **destroy** or do away with the Torah, He emphasizes this twice. The logic also follows on with the next verse, Mat 5:18, Yeshua says that not one part of the Torah will be changed or done away with **until** the Last Day. The Last Day is when all prophecy is fulfilled and when the heavens and current earth pass away. Again logic follows with the third verse, Mat 5:19, Yeshua states that anyone that teaches and breaks the least command in the Torah or says is done away with, will be least in the Kingdom of Heaven.

These three scriptures taken all together with logic shows us that Yeshua is telling us He came to show us how to better or more properly walk in the Torah and that the Torah is in effect until the end of man walking on this earth. Also it follows that most all the pastors, if they are found in the book of Life, will be at the bottom of the new society in the New Heaven and the New Jerusalem.

All of the five mainstream groups of Christian Churches of today tell their Congregations that the Torah was done away with as Yeshua completed it for us and now we are all saved by grace and do not have to do anything, no requirement. This is all a blatant lie. The Churches do not know what being saved by grace or a gift from God really entails. It means you cannot by your actions earn salvation, but rather by your actions you will be judged and **if found acceptable** then God will **extend salvation to you as a gift**. This is all there in scripture. The Seventh Day Adventists, the sixth mainstream Church, says that the Law is now the Ten Commandments, and the Torah was done away with, they also are in error. However they recognize that action and commitment to Yeshua is required in order to obtain salvation, by grace. The commitment they follow is walking in the Ten Commandments.

None of the six mainstream groups of Christian Churches keep the Torah, this means they do not walk in total obedience to God. Hence the Holy Spirit is not active within them and is not leading them.

There is much more, knowing what **repentance** requires and knowing what **loving God** requires.

The only Doctrine one is to follow is that of the Complete Bible itself. Yes both the Old and New Testaments. There is no excuse for not following the Old Testament, as in the New Testament we are told with over 30 different scriptures of the active role of Yeshua as the mediator for The Father throughout the entire Old Testament, the one interacting directly with man. **Follow only scripture**, not what man says. Understand **Everything** is tied to hearing, obeying and following Yeshua in both the Old and New Testaments.

#### 2. The Ark of the Covenant

Moses was told to make an Ark, with very specific instruction for its construction. It was to contain the two stone tablets that God made and gave him. These tables or tablets were written on two sides and contain the Ten Commandments.

Exo 32:15 And Moses turned, and went down from the mount, and *the two tables of the testimony* were in his hand: the tables *were* written on both their sides; on the one side and on the other *were* they written.

Note that these tables or tablets of stone are called the "two tables of the Testimony". Moses was instructed to place these inside the Arc.

Exo 40:20 And he took and put the *testimony into the ark*, and set the staves on the ark, and put the mercy seat above upon the ark:

These ten laws are what the Israelites agreed to keep at the time Moses brought down the second replaced set of two tables. These two tables then became a testimony or witness against the Israelites. Meaning this was the main criteria that God would use to judge His people on the Last Day. The Ten Commandments would testify either for or against God's people at the final Judgment.

These Ten Commandments are contained in the Torah, but the Torah contains many more commands that God gave to his people and wanted them to keep. These were written by Moses in a book or on a scroll and it was then placed on the outside of the Ark, meaning it could be used to refer too and was over time. This is the book of the Torah. It is in fact the complete covenant that God made with His people. The Arc is mostly referred to as the Ark of the Covenant. The Torah is also used as a testimony for God's people.

Deu 31:24 And it came to pass, when Moses had made an end of writing the words of **this law in a book**, until they were finished,

Deu 31:25 That Moses commanded the Levites, which bare the ark of the covenant of the LORD, saying, Deu 31:26 Take this book of the law, and put it *in the side of the ark* of the covenant of the LORD your God, that it may be there for a *witness against thee* 

What we are told is that there are two witnesses or testimonies, one for one group of God's people and another for a second group of God's people. The Torah is the witness applied to the Saints of God, a very few people, and the Ten Commandments are the witness applied to the Masses of people that are God's. One is contained on the side of the Ark and the other inside the Ark. It is the Saints only that are resurrected at the first resurrection, the Masses are resurrected at the second resurrection.

#### 3. The Letters of Yeshua to the Seven Churches

Recognize the **main reason** prophecy is given is as **a call**, a call specifically to those who will experience the prophecy, they need to repent or change before it is too late. The book or Revelations is primarily given to those in the **end time** that will be going through the Tribulation period. God is totally logical, one needs to use logic to understand His Holy word.

The seven Churches as they are called, were to seven specific Congregations that were established by Paul and resided in what is now present day Turkey. Each Congregation had a specific manner in which they walked forward through life. Yeshua identified the main way each of these Congregations walked and told five of the Congregations to repent and change how they walk before it is too late. Two of the Congregations are not told to repent or change, one is to hold fast and the other is told that they will be spared from taking the temptation that God brings down upon the whole world. This means six Congregations will be going through the Tribulation and only one will not. Since these letters are to Congregations that will be experiencing the wrath of God in the end time, **logic** tells us it is to real and current types of Congregations or Christian Churches in today's time. Yes there are exactly seven groups of Christian Congregations in today's time. These are the Roman Catholic Church, the Orthodox Church, the Latter Day Saints Church, the Jehovah Witness Church, the Seventh Day Adventist Church, the Protestant Church and the Complete Bible following Congregation. This last one is difficult to find, they do not have a Church building or a Governing organization or body, nor are they in the newspaper or yellow pages. Rather they are a very few individuals scattered everywhere throughout each Nation. This last Congregation is the only one that walks in the Torah according to what can be carried out in today's time. The other six Churches do not walk in the Torah, rather they all say it was done away with. Five of them say Yeshua completed it for them.

It is reasonably easy to match the seven letters of Yeshua to the seven existing groups of Christian Churches or Congregations in today's time. In this document only two matches are presented, these are the Smyrna Church, which is the Seventh Day Adventist Church, SDA. They are not told to repent, just to hold fast to how they walk, but they will be going through the Tribulation along with the other five Churches. The Complete Bible Followers are the Philadelphia Church and they will be spared in not having to go through the Tribulation. However it will not be by a resurrection ahead of the start of the Tribulation. Scripture is clear on this.

The SDA in not being corrected, it is important to understand why. They keep the seventh day of the week Sabbath and they keep the Ten Commandments. The other five groups of mainstream Christian Churches do not. The understanding of why the SDA are not corrected comes from the following verses;

Mar 10:17 And when he was gone forth into the way, there came one running, and kneeled to him, and asked him, Good Master, what shall I do that I may inherit eternal life?

Mar 10:18 And Jesus said unto him, Why callest thou me good? *there is* none good but one, *that is*, God. Mar 10:19 Thou knowest the commandments, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Defraud not, Honour thy father and mother.

A rich young man is asking Yeshua what he needs to do to obtain eternal life. Yeshua answers by quoting a few of the Ten Commandments. Yeshua is telling him that he will be judged according to his walking in the Ten Commandments. Meaning this is how Judgment will be made to the Masses on the Last Day, the second resurrection. If you read in proper context, Yeshua did not need to tell the young man to keep the Sabbath, as all the Jews were taught and forced to keep the Sabbath. Recognize that the Sabbath is contained in the Ten Commandments. The SDA Church is the only Church of the six mainstream groups of Christian Churches of today that keeps **the Testimony** contained inside the Ark of the Covenant. This is the one that is used for the Masses. The Testimony for the Saints is the Torah contained on the outside of the Arc of the Covenant, Both groups are also required to truly hear, obey and following Yeshua.

## 4. The Judgments

When the Congregations were set up by the Apostles and also by Paul, according to Yeshua's instructions after his resurrection, a call to all people too become a Saint was made according to the following;

Rom 1:7 To all that be in Rome, beloved of God, *called to be saints*: Grace to you and peace from God our Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ.

1Co 1:2 Unto the church of God which is at Corinth, to them that are sanctified in Christ Jesus, *called to be saints*, with all that in every place call upon the name of Jesus Christ our Lord, both theirs and ours:

In the early Congregations of Paul, he addresses them in his letters as the Saints;

Eph 1:1 Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, *to the saints* which are at Ephesus, and to the faithful in Christ Jesus:

Php 1:1 Paul and Timotheus, the servants of Jesus Christ, **to all the saints** in Christ Jesus which are at Philippi, with the bishops and deacons: Exo 19:5 Now therefore, if ye will obey my voice indeed, and keep my covenant, then ye shall be a peculiar treasure unto me above all people: for all the earth *is* mine:

Col 1:2 *To the saints* and faithful brethren in Christ which are at Colosse: Grace *be* unto you, and peace, from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

Paul also refers to those brothers in Jerusalem that accepted Yeshua as the Saints. What all of these have in common is given to us in the following;

Act 21:17 And when we were come to Jerusalem, the brethren received us gladly.

Act 21:18 And the day following Paul went in with us unto James; and all the elders were present.

Act 21:19 And when he had saluted them, he declared particularly what *things God had wrought among the Gentiles by his ministry*.

Act 21:20 And when they heard *it*, they glorified the Lord, and said unto him, Thou seest, brother, how many thousands of Jews there are which believe; and **they are all zealous of the law:** 

The Gentiles in the Congregations that Paul set up were **zealous** for the Torah. They were studying it from the Old Testament and learning it and walking in it and understood why God gave it to man. Those in Jerusalem walked in the same manner. The above scripture show us that the six mainstream groups of Christian Churches of today do not walk in the same manner as the early Congregations.

The early Congregations responded to the call to become the Saints. As time went forward fewer and fewer responded. There has always been a small remnant through history that walked as the Saints were required to walk and these were hunted and martyred over the centuries. Today the small remnant are the Complete Bible Followers. Today they are not martyred in the West, they are just scoffed at by those in the six mainstream Christian Churches.

2Pe 3:2 That ye may be mindful of the words which were spoken before by the holy prophets, and of the commandment of us the apostles of the Lord and Saviour:

2Pe 3:3 Knowing this first, that there shall come *in the last days scoffers*, walking after their own lusts, 2Pe 3:4 And saying, *Where is the promise of his coming*? for since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as *they were* from the beginning of the creation.

Yes in the above prophecy the six Churches of today are the scoffers. In addition we are told the same people will be walking as in the days of Noah, totally **oblivious to God's hand at work** in bringing his wrath down upon the world and **the second coming of Yeshua**.

Mat 24:37 But as the days of Noe were, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.

Mat 24:38 For as in the days that were before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark,

Mat 24:39 And knew not until the flood came, and took them all away; so shall also the **coming of the Son** of man be.

This prophecy applies to those that call themselves Christians, it takes in 99 % of those in today's time. The sequence of Yeshua's coming has already started and it is only a few years from now.

Another end time prophecy is fulfilled in today's time from the following;

2Ti 3:7 Ever learning, and never able to come to the knowledge of *the truth*.

The truth is that of the **truth of God** which is the Torah. A succinct description of the meaning of the Torah is "*Instruction designed to teach us the Truth of God*". This has a much deeper meaning than that of the word Law. It is a way forward that allows us to grow and mature as the Heavenly Father's children, to learn to value what the Father values.

In the New Testament Yeshua and the Apostles tells us **17 times** to beware of deception in the world and in the Church. In addition Yeshua tells us this will increase and become worse in the end times. Stated so many times this warning is **extremely important**, yet those that are Christians have not taken this to heart, rather they have disregarded it. They believe the lies by the media, the world leaders and the authorities in today's time and walk as gullible sheep. They have not recognized how evil the world has become and how evil all the world leaders have become, including health authorities.

The final countdown for Yeshua's second coming **is underway**, there are only a few years left, but Christians are asleep and do not look at what is currently happening in the world and recognize how it fits as God's action in today's time. It comes down to the fact that they do not know the scriptures!

The three above prophecies are being fulfilled in today's time, as at the present moment the first two of God's plagues are underway throughout the entire world and only a very very few of God's people have recognized this.

The Judgment of the current Saints is made according to how they walk in keeping the Torah and in hearing, obeying and following Yeshua as the Messiah. Those that are martyred for their faith in God are also accepted as the Saints.

Psa 116:15 Precious in the sight of the LORD is the death of his saints.

The Judgment for the Masses is the same through history including current times of today and will be continued right up to the Last Day. The Masses will be Judged according to their walking in the Ten Commandments. Included in these is the seventh day of the week Sabbath. The Sabbath is God's not man's or the Jews, it is clearly stated in Lev 23:2-3. A question each person should consider is how strict or how lenient will Yeshua be in His Judgment of the Masses as to whom He will extend the gift of salvation? Will He strictly apply keeping the seventh day Sabbath?

### **5.** Summary

The **end time** is clearly defined in the scriptures, it is not up to man to speculate what it means. It is the time where the wrath of God comes down upon the entire world and that leads to Yeshua's second coming. It is the time when Yeshua returns, that man can no longer walk in the manner that he wants. It is a time that leads into the Millennium where all people will be forced to keep the Torah, as Yeshua and the Saints rule with a rod of iron.

Everyone that takes on Yeshua is called to become a Saint, very few accept the calling. Many are called but few are chosen. The Saints are Judged by the Torah and held to a higher standard, the Masses are Judged by the Ten Commandments as a minimum standard. Each of these have a witness or testimony used against us as we are Judged. Grace is extended to those who pass the Judgment. This is clearly told to us in the following;

Rev 20:12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is *the book* of life: and the dead were **judged** out of those things which were written in the books, according to **their works**.

Rev 20:13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were **judged** every man according to **their works**.

Yes man is Judged by how he walked through life according to that of keeping God's commandments, of keeping the testimonies.

Love to God is that of walking in obedience to His Commandments. Repentance is that of returning to God by leaving your old previous sinful walk and becoming a new person and walking forward in obedience to God and no longer sinning. This is all there in the scriptures. Note that sin is defined for us in the following;

1Jn 3:4 Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth also the law: for sin is the transgression of the law.

Sin is a transgression of the Law or breaking God's Law. It is walking outside of the Torah. It is also defined as walking **in iniquity**. When a person breaks any one of God's laws it is taken as being the same as breaking all of the Laws. This means one must walk in total obedience. Consider the following from Yeshua;

Luk 13:23 Then said one unto him, Lord, are there few that be saved? And he said unto them,

Luk 13:24 Strive to enter in at the strait gate: for many, I say unto you, will seek to enter in, and shall not be able.

Luk 13:25 When once the master of the house is risen up, and hath shut to the door, and ye begin to stand without, and to knock at the door, saying, Lord, Lord, open unto us; and he shall answer and say unto you, I know you not whence ye are:

Luk 13:26 Then shall ye begin to say, We have eaten and drunk in thy presence, and thou hast taught in our streets.

Luk 13:27 But he shall say, I tell you, *I know you not* whence ye are; depart from me, all *ye workers of iniquity*.

Luk 13:28 There shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth, when ye shall see Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, and all the prophets, in the kingdom of God, and you *yourselves* thrust out.

Yeshua is addressing those that walk outside the Law or Torah, those that walk in sin, He does not know them, nor accept them. You do not want the above scripture to apply to yourself.

One needs to pray and watch always on how they are walking and hope that one is found acceptable. The manner of Judgment in order to receive Grace has been shown from scripture above in order to help others to understand the seriousness of Judgment and how it will be applied. Each person is responsible for the choices that they make, one cannot try and place blame on others. Only follow scripture, not what any man says. Do not leave Judgment to the uncertainty of how strict or how lenient Yeshua will be in Judging the masses.

Wake up, no longer walk as in the days of Noah, time remaining is becoming very short.
