

The End of the Churches

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1. Introduction

The major and minor prophets tell us that ***the wrath of God*** will be coming down upon the entire evil world in ***the end times***. The Tribulation is the main portion of God's wrath. The events that lead into and through the Tribulation are completely different than what has ever happened in the world previously. The events are designed by God and they affect every living soul prior to the start of the Tribulation and going through the Tribulation.

Likely you might not recognize that we are currently in the times of sorrows and fast approaching the start of the Tribulation, but we are. Scripture tells us most all people, Christians included, will be walking as in the days of Noah, not aware of God's wrath that has started and is coming down upon the entire evil world along with the second coming of Yeshua (Jesus). Most all people will be planning their life and thinking they have many regular years ahead of them and that things of today are just another bump in the road of history. Rather mankind is fast approaching the end of the road with tremendous turmoil over the entire world affecting all mankind along with a new reset planned by God. This is all given in the scriptures, but you will not find it by talking to the pastors in the various churches of today. They walk the same as all others, walking as in the time of Noah. They do not know or understand the real depth of God's word as a result of being taught in a classroom and following Church doctrine. The pastors are a case of the blind leading the blind.

God is bringing a "***Temptation***" or test upon the entire world, this occurs just before the start of the Tribulation. All those alive at that time will take this test and either pass or fail it. Those that pass are then marked with God's seal and are protected from the remaining plagues that he brings down during the Tribulation. However those passing the test will be persecuted by the evil world and also they are required to pass into the Tribulation period and go through it. Those that fail the test lose their salvation and also will pass through the Tribulation experiencing the wrath of God. Anyone in the various Christian Churches of today that compromise on God's commands will fail the test. To pass the test one must place all your trust in God and accept that you may be killed the following day. To pass the test one must choose the path of very possibly being a ***martyr***, being faithful to the LORD and totally trusting in Him no matter what follows. This is the way forward that one makes in completely rejecting the evil world.

The start of the Tribulation is the end of the various groups of Christian Churches of today. At the end of the Tribulation, it is the second coming of Yeshua who collects the remainder of His Saints only, comes down to earth and then rules over the Millennium with a rod of iron. In the Millennium the whole world is forced to keep all of God's commands. In the Millennium the Saints both teach and enforce the keeping of God's commands over the entire world. The whole world and its various Nations that remain becomes one society with one congregation or church ruled over by Yeshua. The Saints are well described in the scriptures, they are not any of the six mainstream

groups of Christian Churches existing today. The few that exist in these Churches that pass the temptation or test will go forward into the Tribulation and earn the right to become a Saint.

This means essentially all of those in the six mainstream groups of Christian Churches of today that are alive at the start of the Tribulation, will all take the test and will go through the Tribulation. In today's time, only those people who walk in the Torah and truly follow Yeshua will be spared from taking the Temptation and going through the Tribulation. This is an extremely minuscule number of people and they are not resurrected until the end of the Tribulation, Rev 6:9-17, 1 Th 4:15-17.

Unfortunately there are a number of false teachers who tell Christian congregations not to worry that they will be taken before the Tribulation starts. **Scripture** clearly states this will not happen.

All of the above is found in the scriptures and established using reasoning with logic.

2. Definition of End Time

The **end time** is well defined in scripture. It is **the time of the wrath of God** coming down upon the entire evil world and Yeshua's return. Warnings of this event have been given throughout the scriptures many times. The warnings are a call to people to repent and walk forward according to God's commands before it is too late.

There are a number of different terms used to describe the **end time**; these are "**time of the end**", "**the end of the world**", "**beginning of sorrows**", and "**last days**". Note that the term **last days** is not the same as "**Last Day**". The "**Last Day**" is the end of the Millennium and the second resurrection, judgment of the masses followed by the New Earth, New Jerusalem and New Heavens.

Initially an examination of New Testament scriptures that tell us of the end time.

Mat 13:36 Then Jesus sent the multitude away, and went into the house: and his disciples came unto him, saying, Declare unto us the parable of the tares of the field.

Mat 13:37 He answered and said unto them, **He that soweth the good seed is the Son of man;**

Mat 13:38 **The field is the world; the good seed are the children of the kingdom; but the tares are the children of the wicked one;**

Mat 13:39 **The enemy that sowed them is the devil; the harvest is the end of the world; and the reapers are the angels.**

Mat 13:40 **As therefore the tares are gathered and burned in the fire; so shall it be in the end of this world.**

Mat 13:41 **The Son of man shall send forth his angels, and they shall gather out of his kingdom all things that offend, and them which do iniquity;**

Mat 13:42 And shall cast them into a furnace of fire: there shall be wailing and gnashing of teeth.

Mat 13:43 Then shall the righteous shine forth as the sun in **the kingdom of their Father**. Who hath ears to hear, let him hear.

Mat 13:49 So shall it be at the **end of the world**: the angels shall come forth, and **sever the wicked from among the just**,

Mat 13:50 And shall cast them into the furnace of fire: there shall be wailing and gnashing of teeth.

Mat 24:3 And as he sat upon the mount of Olives, the disciples came unto him privately, saying, Tell us, when shall these things be? and what *shall be* **the sign of thy coming**, and of **the end of the world?**

Mat 24:4 And Jesus answered and said unto them, Take heed that no man deceive you.

Mat 24:5 For many shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ; and shall deceive many.

Mat 24:6 And ye shall hear of wars and rumours of wars: see that ye be not troubled: for all *these things* must come to pass, but the end is not yet.

Mat 24:7 For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be famines, and pestilences, and earthquakes, in divers places.

Mat 24:8 All these *are* the **beginning of sorrows**.

Mat 24:9 Then shall they deliver you up to be afflicted, and shall kill you: and ye shall be hated of all nations for my name's sake.

Mat 24:10 And then shall many be offended, and shall betray one another, and shall hate one another.

Mat 24:11 And many false prophets shall rise, and shall deceive many.

Mat 24:12 And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold.

Mat 24:13 But he that shall **endure unto the end**, the same **shall be saved**.

Mat 24:14 And **this gospel of the kingdom** shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and **then shall the end come**.

Mat 28:19 Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:

Mat 28:20 Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you alway, *even* unto **the end of the world**. Amen.

These scriptures above are from Yeshua describing His second coming in the clouds to gather His Saints only. Yeshua brings His reward with Him and it is the Saints alone that receive the reward right at the end of the Tribulation. It also tells us the world is purged of all evil people at this time. The Millennium which quickly follows consists initially of only Just people or those with a good heart, it is a new reset for the start of the 1,000 year period.

In Mat 13:39 above is a major clue that tells us that it is Satan that planted the tares. Since other scripture tells us that Satan is chained up in the bottomless pit over the Millennium, the tares

were planted from Yeshua's ascension up to his second coming. The Bible is full of clues that place the timing, you just have to look for them and recognize them based upon logic. Note also in Mat 24:3 above we are given another clue that asks when Yeshua's second coming will occur. From other scriptures we know Yeshua returns coming in the clouds.

Mat 16:27 For **the Son of man shall come in the glory of his Father with his angels; and then he shall reward every man according to his works.**

Rev 22:12 And, behold, **I come quickly; and my reward is with me**, to give every man according as his work shall be.

The above scriptures describe Yeshua's second coming in the clouds with the reward given to His Saints who are collected at that time along with the Saints collected previously at Yeshua's first coming. It is only the Saints that receive the reward.

The start of the Millennium is where man can no longer walk in the manner that he so desires. Rather everyone is forced to walk in the Torah or Law of God. This is enforced by the Saints under Yeshua's rule of the Earth through the Millennium. It is described by a common scripture given below, often spoken and repeated over and over again but not recognized as to what it really means and when it comes into effect.

Luk 11:2 And he said unto them, **When ye pray, say, Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, as in heaven, so in earth.**

Yes it is the Gospel of the Kingdom of God coming down to the world. It is the Good News of the Government of God coming to rule the entire earth over the Millennium.

Next the Old Testament is used in defining the end time.

Starting in Daniel we are given information on the **time of the end**.

Dan 12:1 And at that time shall Michael stand up, the great prince which standeth for the children of thy people: and **there shall be a time of trouble**, such as never was since there was a nation *even* to that same time: and at that time thy people shall be delivered, every one that shall be found written in the book.

Dan 12:2 And **many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake**, some to everlasting life, and some to shame *and* everlasting contempt.

Dan 12:3 And they that be wise shall shine as the brightness of the firmament; and they that turn many to righteousness as the stars for ever and ever.

Dan 12:4 But thou, O Daniel, shut up the words, and seal the book, *even to the time of the end*: many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall be increased.

Dan 12:5 Then I Daniel looked, and, behold, there stood other two, the one on this side of the bank of the river, and the other on that side of the bank of the river.

Dan 12:6 And *one* said to the man clothed in linen, which *was* upon the waters of the river, How long *shall it be to* the end of these wonders?

Dan 12:7 And I heard the man clothed in linen, which *was* upon the waters of the river, when he

held up his right hand and his left hand unto heaven, and swore by him that liveth for ever that *it shall be* **for a time, times, and an half**; and when he shall have accomplished to scatter the power of the holy people, all these *things* shall be finished.

Dan 12:8 And I heard, but I understood not: then said I, O my Lord, what *shall be* the end of these *things*?

Dan 12:9 And he said, Go thy way, Daniel: for the words *are* closed up and **sealed till the time of the end**.

The first thing we are told is in Dan 12:1 that a time of trouble is coming and is such that the world has never see previously. This is describing the Tribulation period. The next verse tells us that some that are dead are resurrected to eternal life and others to eternal damnation. Those resurrected to eternal life are the Saints only.

Further we are told that these scriptures are referring to **the time of the end**. Then in Dan 12:7 we are told that a scattering of God's Holy people occurs over a time, times, and a half. Then all will be finished. From other studies the time refers to 3 ½ years, the last and worst half of the Tribulation period.

Note in Dan 12:9 that the understanding of end time prophecy will be opened in these final days, it will be sealed **until** the time of the end.

A major warning is given in the last book of the Old Testament by the prophet Malachi. It refers to the Great Day of the LORD, or the wrath of God coming down upon the entire evil world. It refers to the end time. It starts out telling us of a purging of evil people taken out of the world and that they will be burned up, having their place in the lake of fire.

Mal 4:1 For, behold, the day cometh, **that shall burn as an oven; and all the proud, yea, and all that do wickedly, shall be stubble**: and the day that cometh shall burn them up, saith the LORD of hosts, that it shall leave them neither root nor branch.

Mal 4:2 But unto you that fear my name shall the Sun of righteousness arise with healing in his wings; and ye shall go forth, and grow up as calves of the stall.

Mal 4:3 And ye shall tread down the wicked; for they shall be ashes under the soles of your feet in the day that I shall do *this*, saith the LORD of hosts.

Mal 4:4 **Remember ye the law** of Moses my servant, which I commanded unto him in Horeb for all Israel, *with* the **statutes and judgments**.

Mal 4:5 Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet before the coming of the **great and dreadful day of the LORD**:

Mal 4:6 And he shall turn the heart of the fathers to the children, and the heart of the children to their fathers, lest I come and smite the earth with a curse.

This is a last call to repent and walk forward in total obedience to the LORD given by a prophet. Then quiet, no more prophets until the time Yeshua comes down to the earth. Malachi is a call for God's people to come back and walk forward in the Torah. It tells us that Elijah will be one of the witnesses sent to earth before the great and dreadful day of the LORD. This suggests that this will occur in the last half of the Tribulation period, but it needs other scripture that definitely establishes this.

Another scripture being from Isa 62:11 again tells us of the end of the world. Yeshua comes giving salvation to the Saints and Yeshua brings a reward with Him. This also confirms other scriptures above.

Isa 62:11 Behold, the LORD hath proclaimed unto the **end of the world**, Say ye to the daughter of Zion, Behold, thy salvation cometh; behold, his reward *is* with him, and his work before him.

The end of the world is well defined by the above scriptures and means the end of man walking on the world in a manner of going his own way. Yeshua has His work before Him ruling with a rod of iron, throughout the Millennium.

3. Theme of the End Time

The end time has a number of specific themes; consisting of the collection of the remainder of Yeshua's Saints, the punishment of the evil world with God's wrath coming down, the destruction of all the evil people and the start of the Millennium with those people in various Nations having a good heart and surviving the Tribulation. The Millennium being ruled over by Yeshua and the Saints.

The theme of the end time is not the collection of those in the mainstream groups of Christian Churches. For those that are alive at the start of the Tribulation, it is a test that they will be forced to take. Any compromise on their part results in failing the test. This leads to the loss of salvation and directly experiencing the wrath of God coming down from His Plagues throughout the Tribulation up to the time of their death.

Note that those in the six mainstream groups of Christian Churches of today, who are the masses, and do not pass the test, they will be resurrected and judged at the second resurrection. The second resurrection occurs at the end of the Millennium.

The wrath of God in the end time starts with 3 plagues that lead up to the Test or Temptation just before the start of the Tribulation. During the first 3 plagues, those that are Christians throughout the world are not protected from experiencing these plagues. It is only those Christians that pass God's test that are marked by Him and then protected from His 7 remaining Plagues in the Tribulation. Those that pass the Temptation or test and then by going through the Tribulation earn the right to become one of the Saints.

4. Time of Sorrows

The main or worst times of sorrow began at the time that the wrath of God started coming down upon the world. Each plague becomes worse as time goes forward. Note that the other 2 plagues progressively join with the first. Then all three plagues when underway will continue together right up to the start of the Tribulation period. Since each plague once started continues to become more and more severe as time goes forward the effect overall is more and more duress

coming down upon the entire world until the Temptation or test of God occurs and the Tribulation is announced as starting.

Extremely few people have recognized that God's plagues have started and are well underway. Scripture tells us nearly everyone will be walking as in the time of Noah, totally unaware of God bringing His wrath down upon the world and the imminent second coming of Yeshua. They all walk as if they have a long life ahead of them and things of today will get better.

The first plague is the breaking of the second seal in heaven by Yeshua. It is the red horse and rider, taking peace from the world. This started early in 2020 with covid-19 and most all nations responding in the same manner, with lockdowns, masks, social distancing and pushing fear on the populations. This was a world wide event that took peace from the world. It then progressed and grew with the various world governments mandate of everyone required or cajoled into taking the experimental gene therapy. This was then followed by war with the major nations, Russia-Ukraine (USA & NATO), with a real threat of nuclear war. This first plague has been occurring for over three years to date, we are into the fourth year and according to scripture it will continue to grow worse each year right up to the start of the Tribulation.

The second plague is the breaking of the third seal. It is the black horse and rider, bringing famine down upon the world. This started in 2022 joining with the first plague. Famine is increasing cost of food to the point of requiring a day's wages for food for the day. It will grow worldwide, first with continual rising cost and then with shortages. It is currently in its second year. It is caused by mainly by drought, but also by erratic weather with flooding, storms, wind and fires. The LORD controls the major world leaders and has them promoting conditions that amplify food shortages all in the name of saving the planet from the threat they see of the climate. This climate change being seen, they think is occurring as a result of man's actions and think that they can correct it. The evil world responds with farm land taken out of service, animals culled, burning down of food processing facilities, restriction on use of fertilizer and so forth. The ocean has suddenly taken a drastic increase in temperature as never seen before. The result is not due to man, it is lava and hot gas coming up suddenly from the ocean floor. The oceans play a major role in the changing and erratic weather patterns. The earth itself is groaning in the oceans and on land with more and stronger earthquakes and volcanic eruptions. The sun is experiencing more erratic solar flares which also adds to the rise in the earth's temperature. It is God's earth and He controls it. Famine is growing and this is just the second year.

The third plague is the breaking of the fourth seal. It is the speckled, pale or green horse with a rider called death and followed by hell. It is death from war, man killing man, from famine, from disease, from pestilence and from animals all taken together. It is then all three plagues acting together. It is a cumulative death growing to just before the start of the tribulation to an amount of 25% of the world population. To put this in perspective, currently deaths in the world from all conditions is about 70 million per year, while $\frac{1}{4}$ of the world population of deaths will be 2,000 million. There will be no way of missing this. This plague has not at this time started. When this plague starts the growth in deaths will rise exponentially.

Man is not given the timing of the first three plagues. But based upon what we can see for the timing of the first two plagues, the third is not far off. Then all three will act together for a period of time. This means it possibly might be 4 or 5 years to the start of the Tribulation. This is very close, 2027 or 2028 possibly. Note the World Economic Forum and the UN are working towards moving their 2030 agenda to sometime forward. It could well coincide with 2027/2028 or there about. They are working to bring God's test upon the world and do not know it. We need to watch carefully. We are to watch and pray always.

5. Start of Tribulation

The start of the Tribulation period is announced by God in the breaking of the sixth seal. This occurs right after the entire living population of the world has taken the test or Temptation of God. Failing the test is when a person takes the mark of the evil world in order to buy and sell. Passing God's test means a person will be rejected by the evil world system. The mark from the evil world allows a person to have a digital currency bank account in order to buy and sell and live in the new world society.

The announcement of the Tribulation starting will be made by God and will easily be recognized by those few people who know the Bible. Most of the world's population will think the end of the entire world is occurring. Shortly after this announcement God seals those people that passed His test, they are then protected from the remaining 7 plagues that will come down upon the world over 7 years. The first plague of the Tribulation is the 4th plague of the series of 10.

The announcement of the impending start of the Tribulation is found in Rev 6:12-17. It starts with a great earthquake, the sun becomes black and the moon red. Meteorites rain down upon earth, the heavens are hidden and then every mountain and island are moved out of their place. This is not a plague it is just an announcement.

After a short interlude, then the first Plague of the Tribulation period begins. Announced by an angel with a trumpet and then the plague poured out from a vial. Now the plagues are much worse than those of the first three and each becomes progressively more devastating.

6. The Temptation or Test

The LORD leaves no doubt as to what the test or temptation includes. It is a decision to yield to the evil world and take their mark so that one can buy and sell or alternately to refuse and find yourself outside of the new society, Rev 13:17. If you do not take the mark you will have no rights, if left alone you will need to barter to live. The decision is one of very likely becoming a martyr for your belief. There is no compromise, the test is a pass or fail. Once a decision has been made it cannot be changed. Failing the test is either worship the beast and/or take the mark of the evil world, Rev 14:9-11.

The result of passing God's test is first to receive His mark giving one protection from the remaining Plagues that He brings down upon the entire world. It does not protect one from the evil world. Passing means also that by enduring the Tribulation one earns the reward of Saint and is resurrected at the end of the Tribulation with Yeshua coming in the clouds. Some that pass the test will die during the Tribulation and some will live to the end of the Tribulation. Note the importance of the following scripture;

[Psa 116:15](#) Precious in the sight of the LORD *is* the death of his saints.

The result of failing the test is that of losing one's salvation. That person will also experience or suffer through the plagues of the Tribulation and possibly die before or at least by the end of the Tribulation. In addition failing the test means at the second resurrection, that person will be judged and thrown into the lake of fire, remaining there forever, Rev 14:9-11 and Rev 20:15.

There is a great reward offered by God for those that pass the test, but in balance there is a terrible punishment for those that fail the test. These are a special end time event with its consequences.

7. The First Resurrection

The Bible lists two and only two resurrections. The first is for the Saints only, as it is only the Saints at the end of the Tribulation that rise up to be with Yeshua in the clouds at His second coming, Mat 24:30, 1Th 4:15-17. This is a continuation of gathering of the Saints, the first gathering occurred after Yeshua's resurrection, Mat 27:52-53. The second gathering occurs at Yeshua's second coming. Once all the Saints have been gathered, Yeshua comes back down to earth with all His Saints, Zec 14:5. The Saints are the first fruits of people judged to a higher standard than the large population of people or the masses. In order to understand this one must know the Holy Days of the LORD in great depth along with the two separate Testimonies attached to the Arc of the Covenant. The Saints are defined in Rev 14:12, they keep patience or endurance without complaining, they keep the Torah or all the Laws as best as can be done in today's time and they keep the faith of Yeshua. Note the masses in the 6 groups of Christian Churches of today all say in error that the Torah is done away with.

The second resurrection is that of the masses and it occurs at the Last Day, at the end of the Millennium and the destruction of the current world and heavens. It is Judgment day before the Great White Throne.

The resurrected Saints are with Yeshua on earth during the Millennium. They are administrators under Yeshua, they enforce keeping of the Torah throughout the earth, Rev 2:26-27, 1Co 6:2. The Millennium is where God's Government comes down to earth, it is the good news of the Kingdom on earth where God's Will is done, Mar 1:14, Mat 6:10.

The end time with the wrath of God coming down upon the entire evil world has a theme of destroying all evil people and collection or resurrection of the remainder of the LORD's Saints. It is a reset for the Millennium where man can no longer go his own way but rather must keep the Torah, a time where Satan is locked up, a time where Yeshua and the Saints rule the world with a rod of iron, ensuring that all people keep the Torah. The end time is an end of the Churches.

Note the end time does not have the same theme as the Exodus. It is not a time of resurrection of the masses who are God's people. However, there are some direct correlations between Exodus and the end time.

8. Yeshua's Letters to the 7 Churches

The major theme of Revelations is a final call to the Churches or Christians of today to change before it is too late. It indicates what is coming in the end times and beyond. It was written primarily for those people that will be living in the end times, today's times, and to those people that will be required to go through the Tribulation.

There are 7 letters to 7 Gentile Churches, each letter addressing their strengths and then how to go forward. In John's time when he was writing down the letters in the Book of Revelations, there were 7 original Churches with the names used in the letters. There are also 7 mainstream Christian groups of Christian Churches in today's time. This is not a coincidence. Look around and you will easily see 6 mainstream groups of Christian Churches in the world today. The 7th is well hidden and difficult to find, but it also exists. It is the one with little strength, it is a few scattered individuals spread everywhere throughout the world.

The seventh Church or better described as a Congregation is the only one that Follows the Torah and truly follows Yeshua. In today's time it is the one meeting the description of the Philadelphia Congregation, the only ones that walk in the manner required to meet the requirements of being the Saints of Yeshua, Rev 14:12. This is the only congregation that will not have to take the test or temptation, meaning they will not pass through the Tribulation. However it will not be as a result of a resurrection, scripture is clear on this. Philadelphia is one of two Churches that are not told to change and correct themselves, the other is Smyrna. All the other 5 groups of Churches will be required to pass through the Tribulation and take the test along with the 6th Church, Smyrna, even though it is not told to correct itself.

Lets identify the 7 groups of types of Christian Churches that exist today. The six mainstream are easy to find. These are the Orthodox Church, the Roman Catholic Church, the Latter day Saints or Mormon Church, The Jehovah Witness Church, the Seventh Day Adventist Church and the Protestant Churches that came out of the reformation. The seventh being well hidden is the Messianic's or Complete Bible followers. You can reasonably easily fit the letters of Yeshua to these different groups.

The only other church that is not told to correct themselves, or to repent and change, rather to only to hold fast is the Smyrna Church. This is the Seventh Day Adventist Church. It tells them they will be persecuted 10 days, likely being 10 years, three years ahead if the Tribulation and seven years through the Tribulation. The reason is because this Church keeps the Saturday Sabbath and the 10 commandments. These commandments are on the stone tablets and are the Testimony that is placed inside the Arc of the Covenant and used as a witness against the masses in the Day of final Judgment. Recognize the importance of the Smyrna Church, that it does not need to correct itself, but yet must pass through the Tribulation, which means all of the other 5 Churches will definitely be required to pass through the Tribulation and take the test.

The other 5 mainstream groups of Christian Churches are told to repent and correct themselves before it is too late. Understand all 6 groups of these mainstream Churches will be require to take the Test of God and pass through the Tribulation.

Understand also that all of those in the 6 mainstream Churches that are alive at the start of the Tribulation will be destined to take the test of God. This means they should be preparing and getting ready to pass the test now. Time is running out, the test is fast approaching.

9. Summary

The end times are actively underway coming down upon the world at the present time. The wrath of God has started and the initial two plagues are currently underway. These are the major events occurring in the times of sorrow that quickly lead up to the start of the Tribulation. Scripture tells us that nearly everyone will be totally unaware of what is occurring according to God's plan. Rather nearly everyone, Heathen and Christian will be walking as in the days of Noah. Walking as if they have a regular long life ahead of them and what is occurring in the world is just natural history that will work its way out. The time duration of the first 3 plagues of God in the end time is not given in scripture. One needs to watch what occurs and gain an understanding of a relative timing remaining to the start of the Tribulation. The start of the Tribulation period is the critical milestone as everyone's fate is sealed at that moment.

The theme of the end time entails a number of activities. The first is the wrath of God coming upon the evil world and evil people. This is followed by Yeshua's second coming in the clouds where He gathers the remainder of His saints. Then all evil people are killed and the Millennium rule is set up with Yeshua and the Saints ruling the world with a rod of iron. Jerusalem becomes the center of the world and the Israelites fulfill their intended place. God's Government come down to earth and all people are forced to follow the Torah. The Law goes forth to the Nations of the world out of Jerusalem, Isa 2:3, Mic 4:2. Nations will come to Jerusalem to worship the LORD and keep the Feast of Tabernacles, Sukkot, Zec 14:16-21 .

The test or temptation that God brings down upon all those alive throughout the entire world is one of a pass or fail. It sets every persons fate just before the tribulation begins. Those that pass the test earn the right to become a Saint by choosing to put all their trust and faith in God and go forward through the Tribulation outside of the world system, marked with God's seal. Those that fail the test, have the evil worlds seal and lose their salvation and they will go through the Tribulation experiencing the Tribulation Plagues of God up to the time of their death.

Those in the 6 mainstream groups of Christian Churches of today who are alive at the start of the Tribulation will take the test. Likely very few will pass the test. This test is the end of the Churches. All in the Churches need to prepare in order to pass the test.

There is very little time remaining to the start of the Tribulation and Gods test, repent and walk forward in all of God's commands while there is still time.

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
