Why do the Churches think they will not endure the Tribulation

1. Introduction

At the moment, nearly all people, Heathen and Christian, think that either there will be no Bible Tribulation or that Yesuha's (Jesus) second coming is far in the future. They think that they have a regular full life ahead of them and go about living and enjoying life as best they can. For our time today which is **the end time**, these people are described in the Bible as all walking as in the times of Noah. They are totally unaware of God's hand at work today and the closeness of the start of the Tribulation and Yesuha's return.

There are a very few Christians that have studied prophecy from God's word, some of these are recognizing that we are approaching the Tribulation and that it appears to be getting a little closer each year. They think that Yeshua is coming to collect those in the Churches and that they do not have anything to be concerned about. In general it comes down to the belief that the six mainstream groups of Christian Churches of today think that they will be taken by a rapture or resurrection before the Tribulation starts. Therefore it really does not matter to them if the Tribulation is far in the future or close at hand. There is a growing number of people on the web promoting what they deem as the coming rapture.

This false belief is based first upon thinking that the 7 letters of Yeshua to the 7 Churches were to each specific individual Church existing at one specific time over history and that today only the Philadelphia Church now exists and they are that Church. So when Yeshua comes, they think that He will be collecting them. This is based upon taking a number of scriptures out of proper context and not knowing the overall picture painted by end time prophecy from the many other scattered scriptures that need to be collected and all taken together.

Those that preach the safety of the Churches being taken or protected are earnest in their belief but it is wrong and gives large numbers of Christians false hope as a result of this deception. This means as God's plagues become worse, many Christians will recognize they were lied to and fall away.

This document will examine the scriptures that are used by the Churches and are taken out of proper context, to supposedly give support to their belief. It will in turn show what the scriptures truly say about the end time and the Tribulation.

2. The End Time

Scriptures in both the Old and New Testament clearly define the "end time" using a number of similar terms. These terms are given as follows, starting in Daniel;

Dan 8:11 Yea, he magnified *himself* even to the prince of the host, and by him the daily *sacrifice* was taken away, and the place of his sanctuary was cast down.

Dan 8:12 And an host was given *him* against the daily *sacrifice* by reason of transgression, and it cast down the truth to the ground; and it practised, and prospered.

Dan 8:13 Then I heard one saint speaking, and another saint said unto that certain *saint* which spake, How long *shall be* the vision *concerning* the daily *sacrifice*, and the transgression of desolation, to give both the sanctuary and the host to be trodden under foot?

Dan 8:17 So he came near where I stood: and when he came, I was afraid, and fell upon my face: but he said unto me, Understand, O son of man: for at the *time of the end* shall be the vision.

The above are a vision of the Tribulation that was given to Daniel. It describes the antichrist at the midpoint of the Tribulation. The vision is in the **end time** or **time of the end**.

Dan 12:4 But thou, O Daniel, shut up the words, and **seal the book**, *even to the time of the end*: many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall be increased.

Dan 12:9 And he said, Go thy way, Daniel: for the words *are* closed up and **sealed till** the **time of the end.**

Two further important prophecies are given to Daniel of the time of the end. These *are* describing the Tribulation and some activities what will take place. Note that the Tribulation is where 7 plagues of God come down upon the evil world and at the last plague Yeshua returns.

Malachi Chapter 4 describes the *Great and Dreadful Day of the LORD*, the day that God sends **His wrath** down upon the evil world. This is another description of the end time.

Mal 4:3 And ye shall tread down the wicked; for they shall be ashes under the soles of your feet in the day that I shall do *this*, saith the LORD of hosts.

Mal 4:4 *Remember ye the law of Moses* my servant, which I commanded unto him in Horeb for all Israel, *with the statutes and judgments*.

Mal 4:5 Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet before the coming of the *great and dreadful day of the LORD:*

Note above especially those living at this end time are told to *remember the Torah* (Law of Moses) and also the *Statutes (Feasts of the LORD)* as *well as the Judgments (right rulings)*. Take special note of this, it states that the Torah including the Holy Days and the Blessings and Curses are to be followed in today's time. Note this command and warning is made to those who are destined to go through the Tribulation, the great and dreadful day of the LORD. You will see this if you have a good sense of logic. None of the six mainstream Churches of today follow this way forward. This is of key importance and will be expanded upon further in this document.

There are many other Prophets that describe the Wrath of God at the end time. A few are given as follows;

Isa 62:11 Behold, the LORD hath proclaimed unto the *end of the world*, Say ye to the daughter of Zion, Behold, thy salvation cometh; behold, his reward *is* with him, and his work before him.

Gen 49:1 And Jacob called unto his sons, and said, Gather yourselves together, that I may tell you *that* which shall befall you in the *last days*.

Isa 2:2 And it shall come to pass in the *last days*, *that* the mountain of the LORD'S house shall be established in the top of the mountains, and shall be exalted above the hills; and all nations shall flow unto it.

Mic 4:1 But in the *last days* it shall come to pass, *that* the mountain of the house of the LORD shall be established in the top of the mountains, and it shall be exalted above the hills; and people shall flow unto it.

These use other phrases being **the end of the world** and **the last days**. This again defines the end time. This is supported in the New Testament as well. Recognize that the plural **"last days"** is totally different from the term "**last day**".

Moving into the New Testament the following define the end time;

Mat 24:3 And as he sat upon the mount of Olives, the disciples came unto him privately, saying, Tell us, when shall these things be? and what *shall be* the sign of **thy coming**, and of **the end of the world?**

Mat 13:37 He answered and said unto them, He that soweth the good seed is the Son of man; Mat 13:38 The field is the world; the good seed are the children of the kingdom; but the tares are the children of the wicked *one*;

Mat 13:39 The enemy that sowed them is the devil; *the harvest is the end of the world*; and the reapers are the angels.

Mat 13:40 As therefore the tares are gathered and burned in the fire; so shall it be in *the end of this world.*

Mat 13:41 The Son of man shall send forth his angels, and they shall gather **out of his kingdom** all things that offend, and them which do iniquity;

Mat 13:42 And shall cast them into a furnace of fire: there shall be wailing and gnashing of teeth.

Mat 13:43 Then shall the righteous shine forth as the sun in *the kingdom of their Father*. Who hath ears to hear, let him hear.

Mat 13:49 So shall it be at the **end of the world**: the angels shall come forth, and sever the wicked from among the just,

Mat 24:14 And this gospel of the *kingdom* shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the *end come*.

The above scriptures by Yeshua tell of the **end of the world** and **His second coming** along with the **Kingdom of God** coming down to earth, being the Millennium. Contained in amongst other scriptures in that section are many signs given to us in order to be able to recognize the end time.

Note the harvest and the tares verses the good seed. The tares were sown by the devil. Since Satan is locked up during the Millennium, that means "the end of the world" is the end time, today's time. The Bible is full of clues that set the timing. One needs to look for them using thinking with logic.

Another term is given in the following:

Mat 24:7 For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be famines, and pestilences, and earthquakes, in divers places.

Mat 24:8 All these are the **beginning of sorrows**.

Mar 13:7 And when ye shall hear of wars and rumours of wars, be ye not troubled: for *such things* must needs be; but the end *shall* not *be* yet.

Mar 13:8 For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be earthquakes in divers places, and there shall be famines and troubles: these *are* the *beginnings of sorrows*.

Now added to the other terms is beginning of sorrows.

At the end of the Millennium, Yeshua delivers up the Kingdom to God, then comes **the Last Day or the end**, Judgment and the second resurrection. The **kingdom** that is referred to is the Millennium where God's will is done on earth as it is in heaven. Note the following starts with a statement of the **first fruits**, the first being **Chris**t and then the **Saints** that are raptured or resurrected in a set order.

1Co 15:23 But **every man in his own order**: Christ the firstfruits; afterward they that are Christ's at his coming.

1Co 15:24 *Then cometh the end*, when he shall have *delivered up the kingdom to God*, even the Father; *when he shall have put down* all rule and all authority and power.

1Co 15:25 For he must reign, till he hath put all enemies under his feet.

1Co 15:26 *The last enemy* that shall be destroyed is death.

1Co 15:27 For he hath put all things under his feet. But when he saith all things are put under him, it is manifest that he is excepted, which did put all things under him.

1Co 15:28 And when all things shall be subdued unto him, then shall the Son also himself be subject unto him that put all things under him, that *God may be all in all*.

Further scripture focuses on the *last days* and *later times* is as follows;

Act 2:17 And it shall come to pass in the *last days*, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams:

1Ti 4:1 Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the *latter times* some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils;

2Ti 3:1 This know also, that in the *last days* perilous times shall come.

Jas 5:3 Your gold and silver is cankered; and the rust of them shall be a witness against you, and shall eat your flesh as it were fire. Ye have heaped treasure together for the *last days*.

2Pe 3:3 Knowing this first, that there shall come in the *last days* scoffers, walking after their own lusts,

For all of the various terms that describe **the end time**, there is a constant theme, it is the **wrath of God** coming down upon an evil world and **Yeshua's second coming** to **collect His saints**. This is followed by the strict governing of the earth by Yeshua and the Saints. It is the Millennium. The ruling is made with a rod of iron, meaning that everyone is forced to follow the Torah. **Man can no longer go his own way and do what he likes,** hence the term end of the world or end time. At the beginning of the Millennium the world is purged of evil and Satan is locked up. It is the time of **"thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven"**. This is all there in the Bible, **read the scriptures carefully**.

The Bible clearly defines the end time and gives us many conditions and actions that occur in the world. It is up to us to recognize these conditions and actions in order to identify when it starts and the time when we are living in it.

3. The Saints

There were a number of various *Congregations* that Paul set up in different locations, these are called Churches in their being translated. Today most Christians look on their Church as a specific worldwide organization and a building they attend. They look at themselves as a congregation walking the same as the original first congregations that were set up under Yeshua's directions. They do this without careful study of scripture and without comparing how the early Congregations walked and how they walk. They think, although wrongfully, that they are the Saints in today's time.

First a **definition of the Saints**, are those that have **patience** or endurance without complaining. Second they **obey** all the **Torah** (laws) given to man by God. Third they **hear**, **obey and follow Yeshua**.

Rev 14:12 Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus.

Paul in his letters to the various Congregations addressed them as the Saints.

- Eph 1:1 Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, *to the saints* which are at Ephesus, and to the faithful in Christ Jesus:
- Col 1:2 *To the saints* and faithful brethren in Christ which are at Colosse: Grace *be* unto you, and peace, from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
- Php 1:1 Paul and Timotheus, the servants of Jesus Christ, **to all the saints** in Christ Jesus which are at Philippi, with the bishops and deacons:

In fact all the early Christians were *called to become Saints*. At that time nearly all of them responded to the calling, but as time went forward fewer and fewer responded. Yes many are called but few are chosen.

Rom 1:7 To all that be in Rome, beloved of God, *called to be saints*: Grace to you and peace from God our Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ.

1Co 1:2 Unto the church of God which is at Corinth, to them that are sanctified in Christ Jesus, *called to be saints*, with all that in every place call upon the name of Jesus Christ our Lord, both theirs and ours:

Even the Congregations in Jerusalem as set up by Peter were referred to as the Saints.

Rom 15:25 But now I go unto Jerusalem to minister unto the *saints*.

Rom 15:26 For it hath pleased them of Macedonia and Achaia to make a certain contribution for *the poor saints which are at Jerusalem*.

The congregations set up by Paul are mainly Gentiles, while those in Jerusalem are Jews. A question that needs answering is what do these two different groups have in common.

The answer is found in the following scriptures;

Act 21:17 And when we were come to Jerusalem, the brethren received us gladly.

Act 21:18 And the *day* following Paul went in with us unto James; and all the elders were present.

Act 21:19 And when he had saluted them, he declared particularly what things God had wrought among *the Gentiles by his ministry*.

Act 21:20 And when they heard *it*, they glorified the Lord, and said unto him, Thou seest, brother, how many thousands of Jews there are which believe; and *they are all zealous of the law:*

Recognize at the time of the establishment of the first Congregations, only the Old Testament was in existence. So to learn the Torah the new Gentile Christians needed to read and study the Old Testament. They were learning, walking in and keeping the Torah. They were **zealous** of the Torah. The Christian Gentiles walked the same as the Christian Jews, keeping the Torah and following Yeshua. None of the six mainstream groups of Christian Churches of today walk in this manner. This means none of them meet the qualifications of being a Saint.

4. The Commands given by Yeshua

Christians are to hear and obey Yeshua, Act 3:22-23 & Deu 18:15-19. The first command given to us by Yeshua is that *man shall not live by bread alone but by every word of God*,

Mat 4:3 And when the tempter came to him, he said, If thou be the Son of God, command that these stones be made bread.

Mat 4:4 But he answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but **by** every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God.

Note first that these scriptures come by quoting Deu 8:3, second is that at the time of Yeshua walking the earth only the Old Testament was in existence. If you can think clearly with logic this tells us that the Old Testament applies equally today, the same as it did in the past. It is Yeshua that is telling us this, ignore it if you will at your own peril. Today we have both the Old Testament and a *Renewed Testament*. All together it is every word of God. Approximately 1/3 of the Bible covers Prophecy. If you live by every word of God then you study Prophecy.

If you truly know scripture, then you know that it was Yeshua that walked and talked in the Garden of Eden, it was the back of Yeshua that Moses saw, it was Yeshua that killed 14,700 with a plague at Mount Sinai. There are over 30 scriptures that inform us of Yeshua being the active mediator dealing with man for the Father throughout the Old Testament. What follows from these scriptures is that it was Yeshua that gave the Torah to Moses.

Recognizing the active role Yeshua had with man results in the following verse given by Yeshua as having a much deeper meaning than that taken by most all pastors and congregations.

Joh 14:15 If ye love me, keep my commandments.

The above verse refers to everything given in the Torah as it was all given by Yeshua.

Further in the New Testament, Christians do not know how to read scripture in proper context. To do this one must ask and answer 3 questions first, who is speaking, who is being spoken to and what did it mean to that society at that point in time. As an example, read the following scripture in proper context.

Mat 12:10 And, behold, there was a man which had *his* hand withered. And they asked him, saying, Is it lawful to heal on the sabbath days? that they might accuse him.

Mat 12:11 And he said unto them, What man shall there be among you, that shall have one sheep, and if it fall into a pit on the sabbath day, will he not lay hold on it, and lift *it* out?

Mat 12:12 How much then is a man better than a sheep? Wherefore it is lawful to do well on the sabbath days.

Mat 12:13 Then saith he to the man, Stretch forth thine hand. And he stretched *it* forth; and it was restored whole, like as the other.

In the above it is Yeshua that is speaking and he is a Jew. It is the Pharisees that are being spoken to and they also are Jews. At the time the ruling Jews had an oral law that was more restrictive than the Torah and anyone found breaking any part was arrested and thrown in Jail, tried and punished if found guilty. One could not work on the Sabbath and the oral law interpreted practicing medicine or healing as working on the Sabbath. Yeshua was telling them they distorted the intent of the Torah by applying their oral law. Now understand that these scriptures were written by Jews and written to Jews. They were not written to Gentiles although the do apply to all that follow Yeshua. So Gentiles need to read scripture through the eyes of the Jews. Note that Yeshua was keeping the Sabbath and was telling the Jews how they were to keep it in the manner it was intended. The seventh day weekly Sabbath was never done away with. In the above scripture Yeshua reinforces keeping the Sabbath. If you can read in proper context with logic you will understand this. The Sabbath is still in effect, it was never transferred to a different day or changed in the manner it was to be followed and obeyed.

Going further the following scriptures given by Yeshua are totally misconstrued by the six mainstream groups of Christian Churches of today. If you read them in proper context, using logic and Strong's Numbers then the proper understanding will be obtained.

Mat 5:17 Think not that I am come to **destroy the law**, or the prophets: I am not come to **destroy**, but to **fulfil**.

Mat 5:18 For verily I say unto you, *Till heaven and earth pass*, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the *law*, *till all be fulfilled*.

Mat 5:19 Whosoever therefore shall break one of these *least commandments*, and shall teach men so, he shall be called the *least in the kingdom of heaven*: but whosoever shall do and teach *them*, the same shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven.

Reading in context, it is Yeshua that is speaking, He is speaking to fellow Jews that were following Him. All the Jews at the time were raised in following the oral laws based upon the Torah, it was a deep foundation within them and it governed all of their life.

Mat 5:17 tells us *twice* that Yeshua did not come to *destroy* the Torah. This emphasis is important, meaning he did not come to change in any way or do away with the commandment of keeping the Torah. The word *fulfil* can mean one of two things, either to complete the Torah so that you do not need to keep it or to teach one how to correctly walk in it. Using Strong's Number which defines the meaning of Bible words, it can also mean to *preach fully*. This other wording for meaning is better suited and clearer as to what Yeshua is saying. If Yeshua was saying that you do not need to keep the Torah, those Jews listening would have been shocked and would leave Him and report Him to the authorities. In order to make it clear Yeshua states twice that He did not come to change the Torah in any manner. Unfortunately Christian Church Doctrine as set by a committee of men says the Torah is done away with as Yeshua completed it for us and the Pastors follow Church Doctrine in preference to following scripture. This shows that they do not know how to read in proper context and also that they do not know how to read with logic, nor properly use Strong's Numbers.

Next Mat 5:18 tells us that not one little bit of the Torah is done away with *until* heaven and earth pass away and *until* all prophecy is fulfilled. This means the Torah is in effect up to the second resurrection and Judgment day. It means it is in full effect in Yeshua's time, in our time today and in effect during the Millennium. This is totally clear and the logic continues with this scripture from that of the verse before it. The 6 mainstream groups of Christian Churches ignore this second verse and the one that follows. They do this after selecting a misinterpretation of the first verse.

Mat 5:19 tells us of a penalty for not teaching and keeping the least command of the Torah. It tells us there is a structured or hierarchical society in the New Earth and that those that do not teach all of the Torah will be least in that society. Again the three scriptures all go together, they have the same theme, keep the Torah. If one does not think with logic they do not understand what these scriptures say.

These three scriptures as given to us from Yeshua are clear when read in proper context with logic and using Strong's Numbers. These are some of the most important verses in the New Testament for those living today.

Further the 6 mainstream Churches say that the Feasts or Holy Days are done away with. Consider the following scriptures;

Lev 23:1 And the LORD spake unto Moses, saving,

Lev 23:2 Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, *Concerning the feasts of the LORD*, which ye shall proclaim to be **holy convocations**, even **these are my feasts**.

The Holy Days are the LORD's, not man's, not the Jews, they are the LORD's. These are contained in the Torah. Note also that the first Holy Day is the weekly Sabbath, Lev 23:3.

The most important commandment is also stated by Yeshua;

Mar 12:28 And one of the scribes came, and having heard them reasoning together, and perceiving that he had answered them well, asked him, Which is the first commandment of all? Mar 12:29 And Jesus answered him, The first of all the commandments *is*, Hear, O Israel; The Lord our God is one Lord:

Mar 12:30 And thou **shalt love the Lord thy God** with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this *is* the first commandment

Yeshua is quoting Deu 6:5, and provided you hear and obey Yeshua we are to keep this command. So how do you Love the LORD thy God? Scripture is clear, we do this by action of walking in *total obedience* to His Commands. This means the LORD intends that you walk in the Torah and follow Yeshua. Again by logic this reinforces that the Old Testament is in full effect today.

Scripture tells us to obey and follow Yeshua. Yeshua kept the seventh day Sabbath, He kept the Holy Days, He tells us to keep the Torah, He tells us the Whole Bible is to be followed. If you truly follow Yeshua then you keep all these as well.

5. The First Resurrection

The first resurrection occurs in two parts. The first part is when Yeshua was the first to permanently rise from the dead. This was followed right after His resurrection by the early Saints being resurrected as well.

Mat 27:52 And the graves were opened; and many bodies of the *saints* which slept arose, Mat 27:53 And came out of the graves *after his resurrection*, and went into the holy city, and appeared unto many.

This occurred on the Holy Day of First Fruits of the spring harvest. This is when Yeshua collected the first portion of His Saints. The second portion of the Saints are going to be collected at Yeshua's second coming, around 2,000 + years later. These will be the First Fruits of the summer harvest. In order to understand this one must know the Holy Days of the LORD in great depth. The Saints only, rise up and join Yeshua when he comes in the clouds in power and glory at the end of the Tribulation.

1Th 4:15 For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive *and* remain unto the coming of the Lord *shall not prevent them which are asleep*.

1Th 4:16 For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the

archangel, and with the trump of God: and *the dead in Christ shall rise first*:

1Th 4:17 *Then we which are alive and remain* shall be caught up together with them *in the clouds*, to *meet the Lord in the air*: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.

First understand the context of these verses. It is Paul speaking to those in the Thessalonian Congregation who are considered as the Saints. He is not talking to the Masses but rather to the Saints. Note that today those in the 6 mainstream groups of Christian Churches are the Masses, not the Saints. This resurrection is occurring at the end of the Tribulation. We are told that the dead rise first, then followed by those that are alive and remain. This resurrection is only of the Saints.

1Co 15:22 For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive.

1Co 15:23 *But every man in his own order*: Christ the *firstfruit*s; afterward they that are Christ's at his coming.

Every one that is dead and sleeps in Christ will rise and be resurrected in their own order. It is only the First Fruits or the Saints that Yeshua collects at His first and second coming. The Masses are resurrected at the second and last resurrection.

These are important scriptures needed in order to understand that the resurrection at the Tribulation takes place only at the end with Yeshua's coming in the clouds. It does not occur before the Tribulation starts. Those that are alive cannot prevent the dead from rising first. These scriptures above join for further understanding coming from the following scriptures.

Rev 6:9 And when he had opened the *fifth seal*, I saw under the altar the **souls of them that were slain for the word of God**, and for the testimony which they held:

Rev 6:10 And they cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth?

Rev 6:11 And white robes were given unto every one of them; and it was said unto them, that they should rest yet for a little season, until their fellowservants also and their brethren, that should be killed as they were, should be fulfilled.

This breaking of the fifth seal is just before the LORD announces the start of the Tribulation. These martyrs are asking how long they need to wait. The LORD tells them to rest for a little season, that means until the end of the Tribulation as others that are martyred through the Tribulation will be joining them. These scriptures with the few above tell us that there is no resurrection until the end of the Tribulation at the time Yeshua returns. Then the dead Saints rise first, each in his own order, then followed by the Saints that remain alive. Those that preach a resurrection ahead of the start of the Tribulation are wrong.

The following is one verse that tells us that the Saints that are in the Philadelphia Church will not be required to take the Temptation that comes down upon the entire world.

Rev 3:10 Because thou hast kept the word of my patience, *I also will keep thee from the hour of temptation*, which shall come upon all the world, to try them that dwell upon the earth.

This applies only to the Saints, those that walk in the Torah and follow Yeshua. This does not apply to the Masses. These are very very few individuals that are scattered throughout the world

who keep the requirements for the Saints, these are those in today's time that responded to the call to become a Saint.

By logic these few will not take the test or Temptation and hence will not pass through the Tribulation. They will not experience a resurrection until the end of the Tribulation as given by scripture above. So what will happen to them ? One of two conditions, either they will be collected and taken to a special place of refuge and protection, living there until the end of the Tribulation or they will be put to sleep as Moses was, and sleep in Christ until the end of the Tribulation. In either case they will then be called for their resurrection when Yeshua comes at the end of the Tribulation. Either or both methods are possible.

Once collected, All the Saints come down to the Mount of Olives with Yeshua.

Zec 14:2 For I will gather all nations against Jerusalem to battle; and the city shall be taken, and the houses rifled, and the women ravished; and half of the city shall go forth into captivity, and the residue of the people shall not be cut off from the city.

Zec 14:3 Then shall the LORD go forth, and fight against those nations, as when he fought in the day of battle.

Zec 14:4 And *his feet* shall stand in that day upon the *mount of Olives*, which *is* before Jerusalem on the east, and the mount of Olives shall cleave in the midst thereof toward the east and toward the west, *and there shall be* a very great valley; and half of the mountain shall remove toward the north, and half of it toward the south.

Zec 14:5 And ye shall flee *to* the valley of the mountains; for the valley of the mountains shall reach unto Azal: yea, ye shall flee, like as ye fled from before the earthquake in the days of Uzziah king of Judah: and *the LORD my God shall come*, *and all the saints with thee*.

The end time theme of Yeshua's second coming is collecting the remainder of His Saints and setting up the Millennium Kingdom on earth where the earth is purged of evil people and those that remain must obey and walk in the Torah. Yeshua and the Saints will reside and rule out of Jerusalem, they will rule with a rod of iron.

The Masses will be resurrected and judged at the second resurrection, it occurs at the end of the Millennium. Some will receive eternal life, others eternal damnation. All are resurrected both the evil and the righteous, all are then judged. After Judgment based upon how one walked through life, if found acceptable they will then be extended salvation as a gift, by grace,

6.End Time Prophecy Scriptures

The main theme or reason the book of revelations is given is specifically for those that are alive and will be going through the Tribulation. It is a last call for them to repent and walk properly in God's commands.

The seven letters by Yeshua to the seven Churches are logically to seven groups of Christian Churches in today's time. Look around, five of the Christian Churches of today have added to or changed the Bible. All the Protestant Churches use the Bible without alteration or addition, they may place emphasis on different items but they are basically all the same. The Churches are first, the six mainstream groups of Christian Churches; Roman Catholic, Orthodox, Latter Day Saints,

Jehovah Witness, Seventh Day Adventist and Protestant. The seventh Church or Congregation is hard to find, it is composed of very few individuals, scattered throughout the world. It is the Complete Bible Followers also known as Messianic Christians. This seventh Church walks the same as the Saints described in the Bible, they keep the Torah as best as can be kept in today's time and they truly hear, obey and follow Yeshua. All the other six groups of Churches say the Torah was done away with and they say they obey and follow Yeshua but they really do not, they are the Masses and not the Saints.

You can easily match up the names of the original Gentile Christian Churches that Paul set up to those Churches of today. Five are told to correct themselves. The Smyrna and Philadelphia are not told to correct themselves. The Smyrna is told to hold fast, but only the Philadelphia is told they will not take the Temptation or Test and hence not pass through the Tribulation. That means the six mainstream Churches, will all pass through the Tribulation and take the test. The Smyrna Church is the Seventh Day Adventist, they keep the Testimony or Witness inside the Ark of the Covenant, the Witness used for or against the Masses at judgment day; The Ten Commandments. The Testimony or Witness on the outside of the Ark is the Torah and used to Judge the Saints.

The Temptation or test that God brings down upon the entire world just before the start of the Tribulation is a pass or fail only. It is one of choosing to place all ones trust and faith in the LORD or to alternately take side with the evil world. If one takes the mark of the Beast, then one fails the test and also loses their salvation. If one takes the mark, then you can buy and sell and live in the new world and its society, but you will have lost your salvation and you will personally experience the Plagues of the Tribulation up to the time of your death.

Rev 13:17 And that no *man might buy or sell*, save he that *had the mark*, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name.

Rev 14:9 And the third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, If any man worship the beast and his image, and **receive his mark** in his forehead, or in his hand,

Rev 14:10 The same shall drink of the wine of the **wrath of God**, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation; and he **shall be tormented with fire and brimstone** in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb:

Rev 14:11 And the smoke of their torment ascendeth up for ever and ever: and they have no rest day nor night, who worship the beast and his image, **and whosoever receiveth the mark** of his name.

If you do not take the mark, you then have no rights as a human being to live in the new world order. Those in the large cities will either be killed or place in slave work camps. Those in remote areas, will need to go forth by barter and likely many will survive. Those that pass the test will be marked by God and not experience the 7 remaining plagues that He brings upon the world. Those that pass the test whether being killed or surviving to their end or the end of the Tribulation will become Saints and be resurrected at Yeshua's coming.

Rev 7:3 Saying, Hurt not the earth, neither the sea, nor the trees, till we *have sealed* the servants of our God in their foreheads.

Rev 9:3 And there came out of the smoke *locusts* upon the earth: and unto them was given power, as the scorpions of the earth have power.

Rev 9:4 And it was commanded them that they should not hurt the grass of the earth, neither any green thing, neither any tree; but *only those men which have not the seal of God* in their foreheads.

All of the six mainstream Churches in error, think that the second coming of Yeshua is to collect them. It is not, Yeshua will only collect the Saints, those found walking totally properly as well as those *earning* the right to become a Saint by passing the test and going through the Tribulation.

Further knowledge of the end time comes from the following two scriptures;

Rev 15:1 And I saw another sign in heaven, great and marvellous, seven angels having the **seven last plagues**; for in them is filled up the wrath of God.

Rev 21:9 And there came unto me one of the seven angels which had the seven vials full of the **seven last plagues**, and talked with me, saying, Come hither, I will shew thee the bride, the Lamb's wife.

If one can read with logic, the above two scriptures tell us that there are more than seven plagues in the wrath God brings down upon the evil world. It does not tell us how many more, but there are some that occur before the Tribulation starts. One needs to go looking for them. In fact there are three, making a total of ten plagues. It correlates to the Exodus plagues but the theme is totally different.

The first plague of God started early in 2020, being peace taken from the world. First with Covid-19 and fear being pushed, followed by the experimental mRNA gene therapy being coerced on people. Then major war occurred and continues to grow and this plague will continue to grow and become worse right up to the start of the Tribulation. We are now in the fourth year of this Plague. The second plague started in 2022 which is famine, and is growing considerably in this its second year. The third plague has not yet started, it is tremendous death, it will likely start next year, 2024. There are very few years remaining until the start of the Tribulation, very likely around 4. It is left up to you to find the scriptures, with the three plagues, for yourself.

There are many scriptures that tell us how to recognize the end time. Study your Bible.

Prophecy scriptures are scattered throughout the entire Bible and are well hidden. They need to be individually found and collected in order to understand the overall picture and how it unfolds. End time prophecy is extremely complex and flows in a totally logical manner, but one that is not easily seen by man. There are a number of obstacles or blocks to understanding end time prophecy that have purposely been placed in the scriptures and need to be overcome. They require direction from the Father's Spirit to overcome them.

The Father's Spirit is given to those that obey. Those in the six mainstream Churches of today do not totally obey. Therefore the spirit is dormant within them.

Act 5:32 And we are his witnesses of these things; and *so is* also the *Holy Ghost*, whom God hath given to them *that obey him*.

1Jn 3:24 And he that **keepeth his commandments** dwelleth in him, and he in him. And hereby we know that **he abideth in us, by the Spirit** which he hath given us.

It is only those that totally obey God that will be able to understand end time Prophecy.

7.A Change in Judgment

In the end time there is a *change in Judgment for salvation*. Unfortunately this is not recognized by the Churches, the pastors or the congregations. The change is that God is offering a onetime great reward of becoming a Saint even though people were not walking in the manner that is required to become a Saint. To obtain this one must pass the Temptation or test that God brings down upon the whole world. To pass the test one must place all their trust in God, this means one must be prepared to die as a martyr, rather than yield to the evil world authorities.

Reflect on the following verse.

Psa 116:15 *Precious* in the sight of the LORD is the *death of his saints*.

In order to keep the scales of Justice in balance, there is a terrible punishment for those that fail the test. They lose the salvation that they normally would have obtained in been Judged by the Testimony inside the Ark of the Covenant that would be used, if they died before the Tribulation began.

Therefore the critical time of most importance is the start of the Tribulation, not the Midpoint.

Few people recognize this important change in Judgment, the pastors in the Churches do not. Rather today it is a case of the blind leading the blind.

Yeshua and the Disciples warn us 17 times to beware of deception in the world and in the Church. Yeshua tells us that deception will increase in the end time. Unfortunately, none of the Churches, the pastors or the congregations has taken this seriously. Yes throughout the world, deception is rampant in today's time, deception and lies from world leaders, from health authorities, from those of authority and from the media.

Scripture tells us in the end time nearly everyone will be walking as in the time of Noah, not seeing or understanding what is occurring. They walk as if asleep. It also tells us they will scoff when told what is taking place. They see but do not see, they hear but do not hear.

There are other scriptures that the six mainstream Churches take out of context. They think the following applies to them.

1Th 5:9 For God hath not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ,

This is given as occurring in the Day of the LORD, the Tribulation, read the scriptures above this one especially 1Th 5:2. 1Th5:9 applies only to those whom Yeshua is coming to collect. It applies only to the Saints. It does not apply to the Masses.

The following is a set of scriptures that apply to the *Masses*, those who *fail the test* at the start of the Tribulation, they are ones that compromised and were not ready for Yeshua's return.

Luk 13:24 Strive to enter in at the strait gate: for many, I say unto you, will seek to enter in, and shall not be able.

Luk 13:25 When once the master of the house is risen up, and hath shut to the door, and ye begin to stand without, and to knock at the door, saying, Lord, Lord, open unto us; and he shall answer and say unto you, *I* know you not whence ye are:

Luk 13:26 Then shall ye begin to say, We have eaten and drunk in thy presence, and thou hast taught in our streets.

Luk 13:27 But he shall say, I tell you, I know you not whence ye are; depart from me, **all ye** workers of iniquity.

Luk 13:28 There shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth, when ye shall see Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, and all the prophets, in the kingdom of God, and **you yourselves thrust out.**

These Masses walk outside the Torah, they walk in sin, they walk in *iniquity*, they walk outside of the criteria used to Judge the Saints.

The scriptures that tells us one is taken and one is left applies only to those in the Mainstream Churches that pass the test and are alive at the end of the Tribulation, having earned the right to be a Saint.

8. Summary

If you understand the above, then you are awake, if not you have a stiff neck, preconceived ideas, are unable to read in proper context, do not truly hear, obey and follow Yeshua and finally do not want to submit to the will of God. Rather you like walking as in the time of Noah.

Currently in today's time, 2023, there is enough time remaining in order to change and learn how to walk in the Torah and to truly follow Yeshua. If you learn to walk as the Saints are required and if found acceptable by Yeshua, then you will not have to pass through the Tribulation as promised by Yeshua. It takes a considerable period of time to learn how to walk in the Torah and to truly follow Yeshua.

The only Doctrine one is to follow is that of the Complete Bible itself, not a Church Doctrine that is put together by a committee of men. All scripture is given for a purpose, all scripture is truth.

The coming of the start of the Tribulation is fast approaching. A very narrow door and path exists for those who are resurrected at the completion of the first resurrection.
