1. A Final Call to Repent before its too late

The title of this document is Rev 18:4. This is a last call by an angel to the LORD's people that are His, to come out of the city of symbolic Babylon before it is destroyed. This is a call to both repent and walk in the way of God and not in the way of the World. Symbolic Babylon is about to be totally destroyed. Read the Document *Babylon Stud*y as it defines the criteria that describes symbolic Babylon, the seat of evil in the world. The criteria defines Rome and the Vatican as Symbolic Babylon. Why does The LORD make this call? It is because He is righteous,

The verse Rev 14:9 is an angel warning those that are the LORD's that reside in Rome to not take the mark of the Beast or worship the Beast. This verse tells us that the event of the destruction of Symbolic Babylon is occurring just before the start of the Tribulation, where all people that are alive will take the Temptation or Test that the LORD brings down upon the whole world.

Prophecy tells us that symbolic Babylon is destroyed in a very short period of time, one hour. Right after the Start of the Tribulation, God's people that pass the Test are marked by God, which protects them from the coming 7 plagues that the LORD brings down upon the world. The call for The LORD's people to come out of Babylon is so they are not destroyed along with Babylon and therefore can take the Test and when passing the Test, they will be marked and protected from the 7 remaining plagues. If they do not come out from Rome, they will die and not be given the opportunity to become one of the Saints. So this call by an angel to them is a rare opportunity extended to them, so they will be given the same opportunity as all others that are the LORD's that do not reside in Babylon.

Now, information given in scripture that is clear when read in proper context is presented. This information that follows is what is given to man that the LORD requires man to obey, follow and walk through life in. It is a call to repentance.

2. Important key Information in God's Word

Everything in this document is **based solely on scripture** with logical thought and reasoning. The Bible is many times more logical than what nearly all people are able to see and therefore must be read with the application of logic. This document is not based upon speculation or what others say.

If you read the books of Samual's and King's, you should be able to identify a constant repeating theme of what makes God angry. Why is there one Law for both foreigners (Gentiles) or

sojourners that attach themselves to Israel and the same Law for Israel? why was King David and King Solomon told to keep all the Mitzvot's ? Then following on all the various Kings of both Israel and Judah were told the same thing. Why were they punished by God when they did not obey? Does God Change? When God tells man to keep the mitzvot's forever it means forever. What is the Mitzvot? It is the Torah, all the commands of God, everything in the first five books of the Bible. It is the LAW as given to Moses and it includes the 10 commandments, the blessings and the curses, the statutes or Feast of the LORD, the Judgments or right rulings, the food laws, and the ordinances, it defines the abominations and much more. A study using Lexicons resulted in the following succinct definition of the Hebrew word Torah; Instruction designed to teach us the Truth of God. It means much more than the word Law as used for the English translation. Has God ever told man that he no longer needs to keep the Torah? No he as not! There is no scripture that tells man to change and walk forward in a different manner, rather man is told over and over again to keep the Torah and no to longer walk in sin!. So why do the Pastors and the Churches of today tell their congregations that they do not need to keep the Mitzvot? They do not know the Scriptures nor how to think and read God's word in proper context. They alter God's commands in order to walk in a manner they so choose, and then have the nerve to say what they do pleases God. By this, what they are really saying is that they know more than God. Yeshua tells us that not little bit of the Torah is removed or changed and the Torah applies in full up until heaven and earth pass away and until all prophecy is fulfilled, Mat 5:17-19, this occurs on the Last Day, the second resurrection and Judgment before the Great white throne. Note also the Torah includes the seventh day weekly Sabbath. It does not tell man to change and keep Sunday. Man always wants to walk in the way of the world and not in the way of God. The two are totally opposite. It is no different today than what it was in the time of the kings of Israel. Man still rebels against God and His commands.

Sin is clearly defined for us by God. Sin is walking by breaking the Law or Torah.

1Jn 3:4 Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth also the law: for **sin is the transgression of the law.**

Why do the pastors tell their congregations that the Torah no longer applies? How can one walk forward and not sin if they don't walk in the Torah – they can't! Also you can't walk in repentance unless you walk in the Torah. Repentance is walking forward as a new person no longer sinning right up to the time of your death, in order to obtain Salvation, it is made as a gift or by grace after judgment of man by his works or how he walked in obedience to God, Rev 20:12-15. Salvation is a conditional promise, it is not once saved always saved, read Eze 18:25-32, it is totally clear. Grace is a gift of salvation given from God after Judgment, based upon on how one walked through life. Note also above Mat 5:17-19 Yeshua directly tells us the Torah applies completely up to the Last Day, hear and obey. The pastors and their Church Doctrines have it so wrong, they place your salvation in jeopardy. The Feasts of the LORD are a good portion of the Statutes and are part of the Torah, we are to follow them. The pastors in error say these were done away and no longer apply, but cannot show any scripture to justify this. Read the words in the following scripture very carefully.

Lev 23:2 Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, *Concerning* the feasts of the LORD, which ye shall proclaim to be holy convocations, even these are my feasts.

The Feasts are not the Jews, nor the Israelites, nor man's. They are the LORD's feasts. They are an integral part of the Torah and have never been done away. The first of these feasts is the

weekly 7th day Sabbath., Lev 23:3. The next feast is Passover and the two other feasts that are contained within it, Lev 23:4-14, it is not Easter.

The pastors are assigned the responsibility to lead and guide the Congregations according to God's commands. So why are they not doing this? The pastors in fact commit the **Great sin** in being **presumptuous** in thinking they are right and anyone that questions them with using scripture is wrong. They did not learn God's word under the direction of the Holy Spirit, nor are they led by the Holy Spirit, read the following scripture carefully, Act 5:32. The Holy Spirit is only active in those that **obey God.** The pastors do not know how to read scripture in proper context! They ignore and alter or twist scripture that does not agree with their Church Doctrine and what they were taught.

Have the pastors told you what Act 3:22-23 really means? It is not hear or a sound coming to the ear, it is much more. To truly understand one must go to the Old Testament, Deu 8:15-19 and use Strong's Number which is the Hebrew word Shema, it means to both hear and obey Yeshua. It is not optional! Now it is logical and makes sense as why if you do not hear or hearken Yeshua, that the Heavenly Father will personally extract a punishment upon you. What ever Yeshua says we are to hear and obey and scripture also tells us to follow or emulate how Yeshua showed us to walk. None of the pastors or Churches hear, obey and follow Yeshua, for if they truly did they would keep the Torah, the Feasts of the LORD and the 7th day Sabbath. Rather they keep the "holi- days" of the world rather than the "holy-days" of the LORD. They keep Easter rather than Passover, combined with days of Unleavened bread, and day of the Spring First Fruits. They keep Christmas, and Jan 1 as New Years day, God never told us to keep Christmas or celebrate Christs birth and God told us that the first day of the new year is in March or April, Exo 12:2-28, it is the day of the New Moon closest to the Spring equinox, it is Nisan 1. It is an important reset for counting the days of he Feasts of the LORD also called the Holy Days of God. There is much more in the errors of man following the ways of the world and not the ways of God. Examine yourself do you keep the Feasts of the LORD or do you walk in the way of the world?

Have Pastors told you that Yeshua was the mediator actively acting between man and the Heavenly Father, all through the Old Testament ? There **are over 30 scriptures** in the New Testament that tell us this! I will give you only one that is clear, you can search for the others on your own.

1Co 10:4 And did all **drink** the same **spiritual drink**: for they drank of that **spiritual Rock** that **followed** them: and **that Rock was Christ**.

This relates to Exo 17:6 as the rock in the wilderness that followed the Israelites and gave them water to drink. It was actually Yeshua that led the Israelites out of Egypt and through the wilderness for 40 years.

When you put together the **30 scriptures** on this theme, it tells one that Yeshua was the one in the garden of Eden that walked and talked with Adam, Yeshua was the one that Moses saw the back of and the one that gave Moses the Torah and the **10** commandments and talked directly with Moses. So first why have the **pastors not told you this**? Second why have **you not found this** on your own, as we are to live by every word of God. Probably it is because neither you nor the Pastors know how to finely divide the word of God.

Have the Pastors told you that the complete Bible, Old and New Testaments apply today as originally given? Examine Mat 4:4 what does it tell one? It is Yeshua telling us that we are to **live** by every word of God. So what does this really mean? Recognize first, it is Yeshua answering Satan

in the wilderness after being there for 40 days with out food. Second, Yeshua was quoting Deu 8:3 and third, understand that the New Testament did not come into written form until many years after Yeshua ascended back into heaven. So at the time of Yeshua and later for many years following only the Old Testament existed. If you are able to think with reason this will tell you that the Old Testament applies equally today as when it was first given, as in Yeshua's time when walking on earth only the Old Testament was in existence. In these scriptures, Yeshua is directly telling us that the Old Testament still apples as originally given. Hear and Obey Yeshua. When dealing with man God does not change. So today the word of God is the complete Bible, Old and New Testaments together. We are to live by every word that God gave to us. The New Testament was written by Jews to Jews, it was not written to the Gentiles. It does apply to all that accept Yeshua. To understand the New Testament, one must read it through the eyes of the Jews and their society at that time.

Do you walk through life in the same manner as the original Churches as set up by the Apostles? The 6 mainstream types or groups of Christian Churches of today all say, in error, that they and their congregations do.

There is a call to all Christians who accept Yeshua to walk as the Saints are required.

Rom 1:7 To all that be in Rome, beloved of God, **called** *to be* **saints**: Grace to you and peace from God our Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ.

1Co **1**:2 Unto the church of God which is at Corinth, to them that are sanctified in Christ Jesus, **called** *to be* **saints**, with all that in every place call upon the name of Jesus Christ our Lord, both theirs and ours:

The requirements to walk as the Saints requires three actions;

Rev 14:12 Here is the **patience** of the **saints**: here *are* they that **keep the commandments of God**, and **the faith of Jesus.**

First, one must walk with patience, or endurance, accepting life's trials and not complaining, rather being thankful, by keeping a focus on their future life with Yeshua and our Heavenly Father. Second, one keeps the commandments of God, these are the Torah all the commands that God gave man, they walk in total obedience to Yah. Third, one keeps the faith of Yeshua, they truly hear, obey and follow Yeshua. Today only a very small remnant walk in keeping these three requirements, around 0.01 % or less, of those that call themselves Christians,

Paul calls those in the early Churches or congregations that he set up as the Saints, 2Co 1:1, Eph 1:1, Php 1:1, Col 1:2. Nearly all in the early Churches responded to the call. As time went forth fewer and fewer responded, until only a very small revenant existed through history and it was pursued and persecuted over the ages. Paul also calls those Jews in Jerusalem that follow Yeshua as the Saints, Rom 15:25-26.

How do we know those in Paul's Congregations walked as the Saints? It is from the following scriptures.

Act 21:18 And the *day* following Paul went in with us unto James; and all the elders were present.

Act 21:19 And when he had saluted them, **he declared** particularly what things God had

wrought among the Gentiles by his ministry.

Act 21:20 And when they heard *it*, they glorified the Lord, and said unto him, Thou seest, brother, how many **thousands of Jews** there are which believe; and they are **all zealous** of **the law**:

In order to understand this one must first recognize that the word **Law** is the **Torah**. Next these were mainly Gentiles in Paul's congregations. Third these Gentiles were **zealous** for the Law, that meant they embraced it and were learning it from the Old Testament and walking in it. Fourth they walked in the same as the Jews, keeping the Torah and following Yeshua, so the Jews now called these Gentiles the same as being Jews. They both walked in the same manner.

There is even more to the above in Paul's letters in calling those Gentiles in his congregations Saints. This means the statements that Paul makes in his letters are to the **Saints only**, they are not to the **Masses** of today or the mainstream Christian Churches of today, since these do not keep the Torah! Reflect on that and consider the following verse.

Rom 5:9 Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him.

This verse is from Paul speaking to the congregation of the Romans who walk as the Saints. It is given only to those that walk as the Saints. It is not given to those that walk as the Masses. It is not given to the 6 types of mainstream Christian Churches of today who all walk as the Masses.

Note, all scripture is given for a reason, you cannot disregard it or alter it in any fashion, rather we are to live by every **word** as it is Truth given to us from God. Even if you do not understand some scripture, it is still important. Just pray and ask the LORD to open it to you. Consider the following scripture, now that you know what the word hear or hearing means.

Pro 28:9 He that turneth away his ear from **hearing** the **law**, even **his prayer** *shall be* abomination.

That scripture applies to nearly all of those that call themselves Christians in todays time.

Follow only scripture, scripture is Truth given to us from God, always for a reason. Do not follow what man says, the only Doctrine to follow is the complete Bible itself.

Everything is there in scripture, the words are important and being able to read in proper context with reason or logic means one is able to finely divide the word of God in order to gain the correct understanding. One can only do this by having an open mind, accepting what is written, paying careful attention to the meaning of the words, submitting to obeying God and **truly living by every word of God**. Ask yourself why the pastors have not seen or accepted these truths given above and do not walk doing this or understanding it? Rather they act like they are the authority on God's word which they are not. Why have **you** not seen the understanding of these scriptures yourself? Do you not live by every word of God?

The scriptures are full of knowledge given to us by our heavenly Father, it is up to us to read them carefully in order to gain the correct understanding. The only way is to truly live by every word of God. God gave man the ability to think and reason and expects man to use this ability. There is absolutely no excuse for man not to live by every word of God, especially in today's time. You were

given life and the prime reason was to walk forward living and growing as a child of God, studying and accepting every **WOrd** of God. The words given to us in the Bible were carefully chosen in their meaning, use Strong's Numbers to better understand the words and also use dictionaries.

Yeshua told us what the first and most important commandment is, Mat 12:30, but again it is really Yeshua quoting Deu 6:5. We are to love the LORD our God with all our heart, all our strength and all our mind. There are many scriptures that tell us how we are to Love God, it is by walking in total obedience to His commands. That means you need to walk in keeping the Torah.

The Bible is extremely clear on how we are to walk, it is repeated over and over again throughout the entire Bible, the following two scriptures is but two that succinctly sums it up.

Deu 11:1 Therefore thou shalt love the LORD thy God, and keep his charge, and his statutes, and his judgments, and his commandments, alway.

Rev 22:14 Blessed *are* they that **do his commandments**, that they may **have right** to the **tree of life**, and **may enter in through the gates into the city**.

3. Judgment and Salvation

Why is it so difficult for man to understand the criteria that God will use for Judgment of man? A Covenant or an eternal lasting agreement is made between God and Man as the two parties. It is a legal contract of salvation promised to man provided man obeys and walks in the requirements of the legal agreed upon contract. The written details of the contract are the Testimonies or Witnesses used at Judgment either for or against how man walked or his works through life.

Rev 20:11 And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them.

Rev 20:12 And I saw **the dead**, small and great, stand before God; and the **books were opened**: and another book was opened, which is *the* **book of life**: and the **dead** were **judged** out of those things which were **written in the books**, **according to their works**.

Rev 20:13 And the sea gave up the **dead** which were in it; and **death and hell delivered up** the **dead** which were in them: and they were **judged every man** according to **their works**.

At the second resurrection all the Masses are Judged. Both the righteous and unrighteous. Judgment is base upon how man walked through life in obeying the Covenant that man made with God at Mount Sinai. Man cannot earn salvation, salvation is given by Yeshua as a gift after Judgment. This gift of salvation is known as Grace. Unfortunately grace is poorly understood by Pastors and their congregations.

There are **two** different Testimonies or Witnesses used for Judgment. The higher level of Judgment is for the **Saints** and is the Torah written by Moses on a scroll or book attached to the outside of the Ark of the Covenant. A minimum level of Judgment is for the **Masses**, the 10 commandments, written on the stone tables by Yeshua and contained inside the Ark of the Covenant.

Judgment is not some **nebulous criteria**, rather it is extremely clearly defined and repeated over and over again throughout the entire Bible. It is one of two written Witnesses attached to the Ark of the Covenant.

Why have the Pastors and Church Doctrine not recognized this clear method of Judgment? It is repeated over and over again throughout the entire Bible. Understand Grace is given as a gift to those that walked through life keeping God's Commands attached to the Covenant. It is not given to the Unrighteous or rebellious people.

Salvation is a conditional promise, requiring repentance and walking in the Torah as a new person, no longer walking in sin. The LORD called all that repent and follow Yeshua, to walk as the Saints are required. Knowing few would accept the call as time progressed, the LORD set a minimum requirement for the Masses, being the 10 commandments. Note, both require keeping the 7th day of the week Sabbath.

Yeshua Judges all people equally within the two different groups. He does not judge one person more leniently than another. If you study Judgment in God's word you will have learned this. There are two distinct ethnic groups of people, Israelites or Gentiles. All nations that are not Israelites are Gentiles. Examine the following scriptures.

Exo 12:48 And when a stranger shall sojourn with thee, and will keep the passover to the LORD, let all his males be circumcised, and then let him come near and keep it; and he shall be as one that is born in the land: for no uncircumcised person shall eat thereof.

Exo 12:49 One law shall be to him that is homeborn, and unto the stranger that sojourneth among you.

Lev 24:22 Ye shall have **one manner of law, as well for the stranger**, **as for one of your own country**: for I *am* the LORD your God.

Num 15:15 One ordinance *shall be both* for you of the congregation, and also for the **stranger that sojourneth** *with you*, an ordinance for ever in your generations: as ye *are*, so shall the stranger be before the LORD.

Num 15:16 One law and one manner shall be for you, and for the stranger that sojourneth with you.

Num 15:29 Ye shall have **one law** for him that sinneth through ignorance, *both for* him that is **born among the children of Israel**, and **for the stranger that sojourneth** among them.

Gal 3:26 For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus.

Gal 3:27 For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ.

Gal 3:28 There is **neither Jew nor Greek**, there is neither **bond nor free**, there is neither **male nor female**: for ye are **all one in Christ Jesus**.

Col 3:10 And have put on the **new** *man*, which is renewed in knowledge after the image of him that created him:

Col 3:11 Where there is **neither Greek nor Jew**, circumcision nor uncircumcision, Barbarian, Scythian, bond *nor* free: but Christ *is* all, and in all.

Once any person has put on Yeshua they are all the same in Yehsua's eyes. There is one Law for all, the same law applies to all. All are Judged by the same law.

Why does man think that Gentiles will be judged differently than the Israelites? How arrogant and self centered are the Gentiles, they have stiff necks the same as the Israelites and want to walk in the way of the world and not in the way of God. They do not want to obey or have any obligation to Yeshua even after knowing Yeshua laid down His life for them as well as all others.

Everything is **clearly given in Scripture** and since one is to **live by every world of God**, one has no excuse, you cannot blame pastors for leading you astray, no! Each person is responsible for how they walk. You were given life in order to learn God's word and walk in obedience, to grow and mature as one of God's adopted sons or daughters. Being lazy is not an excuse that is accepted by Yeshua.

Sin is clearly defined by the LORD as breaking the Law. Consider the following scriptures. This is why in repentance one needs to walk in the entire Law or Torah.

Jas 2:10 For whosoever shall **keep the whole law**, and **yet offend in one** *point*, he is **guilty of all**.

Jas 2:11 For he that said, Do not commit adultery, said also, Do not kill. Now if thou commit no adultery, yet if thou kill, thou art become **a transgressor of the law**.

If you gather scripture together, all having the same specific key words, God's Will becomes crystal clear. It will overwhelm one. Use words such as; obey, Law, statutes, Judgments, commandments.

We are told many times, to walk on the straight narrow path and not to deviate either to the left or the right. The path to salvation is very narrow, but well defined by scripture. Either one truly lives by every word of God or in disobedience one does not.

4. End Time Prophecy

Salvation is straight forward but very poorly understood by the Pastors or the Mainstream Churches of today. If you do not get Salvation totally correct in understanding and in walking forward in the Torah, then prophecy will never be opened to one.

Prophecy is not only extremely complex and well hidden but there are specific purposely designed in obstacles that one needs the Holy Spirit to open them into one's mind.

The following is based upon living by every word of God and studying Prophecy consistently for many years. It has been opened slowly and piece by piece. A minimum of scripture will be presented in this section as to most others it will not mean much specifically to those that it has not been opened to.

Not only must one think and reason but also be able to identify the clues given and then analyze unknow information and make correlations between information, and when becoming stuck one needs God's Spirit to open the way forward to you.

Use scripture to identify the following terms, end of the world, end times, time of the end, Last Day, harvests.

First, one needs to recognize that Yeshua is coming to collect **only His Saints**, for the completion of the **first resurrection**, check Mat 27:52-53, read the words carefully and see what it tells you. **The Masses** are Judged and those passing Judgment are collected by Yeshua at **the second resurrection**, at which time He will not lose any that are His, Jn 6:39.

The end times are the wrath of God coming down on the entire evil world, and consists of the times of sorrow and the Tribulation both together, with Yeshua's second coming at the end of the Tribulation. It is followed with the destruction of those coming against Israel as well as destruction of All the remaining unrighteous and then the start of the Millennium.

The following two verses tell us something important about the Wrath of God coming down upon the evil world in the end time. Consider them and read them very carefully;

Rev 15:1 And I saw another sign in heaven, great and marvellous, seven angels having the seven last plagues; for in them is filled up the wrath of God.

Rev 21:9 And there came unto me one of the seven angels which had the seven vials full of the seven last plagues, and talked with me, saying, Come hither, I will shew thee the bride, the Lamb's wife.

So what do they tell you? If you live by every word of God then you know that the Tribulation has seven plagues from God. This means these two different scriptures tell one that there are more than 7 end time plagues, how many more we do not know. Rather one needs to go and look for them. The wording also tells on that the other plagues occur before the Tribulation starts. This means what we are told precedes the start of the Tribulation, these other plagues occur in the **beginning of sorrows**.

Yeshua tells us what events that we will be able to recognize in the end time.

Mat 24:3 And as he sat upon the mount of Olives, the disciples came unto him privately, saying, Tell us, when shall these things be? and what *shall be* the **sign of thy coming**, and of **the end of the world?**

Mat 24:6 And ye shall hear of **wars and rumours of wars**: see that ye be not troubled: for all *these things* must come to pass, but the end is not yet.

Mat 24:7 For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be famines, and pestilences, and earthquakes, in divers places.

Mat 24:8 All these *are* the **beginning of sorrows**

The above verses are Yeshua's disciples asking as what signs will occur at the end of the world and at Yeshua's second coming. First Yeshua tells them of the signs in the beginning of sorrows that precedes the start of the Tribulation. There are three things that are usually plagues that God brought down on the Israelites at various times throughout the Old Testament. These are wars or destruction by the sword, famine and disease also known as pestilence.

Scripture that precedes the start of the Tribulation is the breaking of seals on the scroll by Yeshua in heaven. Consider the first 4 seals. Start with the fourth seal and work backwards to the first.

The **fourth seal** is a **pale horse** of **death and hell**, the wrath or plague resulting in tremendous death that occurs from the combination of the second, third and fourth plagues all acting together right up to the start of the Tribulation. Over this seal as well as the third and second seals **no one is protected**, and the fourth seal results in a cumulative **death of 25%** of the world population dying, just before the Start of the Tribulation. That is roughly 2 billion people, Rev 6: 7-8.

The **third seal** is a **black horse** and is the wrath or plague of **famine**. A days wages for food for the day. The Oiives and the grapes are drought resistance, Rev 6:5-6.

The **second seal** is a **red horse** that has a rider with a **sword**, going forth and **killing and taking peace from the earth**, Rev 6: 3-4.

Now we come to the **first seal**. The world in error, has identified this as the antichrist and are watching for it to occur before the other seals are opened. It is a rider on **white horse** with a **crown** and a **bow**, and it goes forth **conquering**, **Rev** 6:1-2. **Words are extremely important**, use scripture to understand them. A rider with a crown is a Nation or a King. Given a bow means it has power to go forth and conquer. Now we come to the most important word – **White** – this word is **always** used in scripture to describe **righteousness**, no exceptions. So, this breaking of the first seal is **not a plague**, rather it is a righteous Nation going forward keeping the war monger Nations at bay. Satan or the antichrist are never described as white. Satan is described as a bright light, but never as white. So if you look around the USA has been busy for many years keeping the war mongers at bay; North Korea, Russian, Vietnam, Iraq, Afghanistan, China and Iran, keeping all of them in check. Then Biden's withdrawal from Afghanistan caused the white horse to go back to the stable.

So, there are three plagues in the beginning of sorrows, **Peace being taken from the world,** famine and death by disease, famine and war. The same as indicated by Yeshua and often used by God to punish the Israelites through history.

The first plague started either in 2020 or 2021 with Covid-19 and the common response of the entire world or alternately with the experimental gene therapy shot forced on everyone. Famine got underway in 2022. Currently we are waiting for the 3rd plague to start. From what has been opened or suggested to me the first 3 plagues occur over 7 years, followed by 7 years of the Tribulation, 2 - 7's back to back. If this occurs then the Tribulation will start in the summer of 2027 or 2028. At most this could be off by one year more. The Tribulation startingt is very close!

Note, the breaking of the 6^{th} seal is God announcing the soon coming start of the Tribulation. Rev 6:12-17.

In addition a definite correlation exists between the Exodus of the Israelites from Egypt and the end time wrath of God and Yeshua's second coming. Both have 10 plagues and there are a number of other correlations. Make yourself two columns and find the others. In the Bible there are a number of other correlations.

Also, the breaking of the fifth seal, Rev6:9-11 combined with 1Th4:13-18 tells us that there is **no secret or special resurrection ahead of the completion of Yeshua's second coming** at the end of the Tribulation. Anyone that tells one not to worry, that you will be raptured before the tribulation starts, does not know the end time scriptures. Rather prepare and strengthen your faith as **all** the 6 mainstream types of Christian Churches of today that are alive will be destined to go through the Tribulation. This is clearly given in the Scripture's.

5. One Time Change in Judgment

The **start** of the Tribulation is the key or critical time. It is not the Midpoint of the Tribulation, since once you have made your choice of either passing or failing the test or Temptation that God brings down upon the whole world at the start of the Tribulation, your fate is sealed. Once you have chosen that choice cannot be changed. The reward is a one-time great reward and to keep a balance of Justice, there is an accompanying one-time great punishment. Passing the Temptation and going through the Tribulation means one earns Saint status even though one was not previously walking as required to be granted Saint status. Failing the Temptation means that one loses salvation that they might normally have received if dying before the start of the Tribulation. They will then at final Judgement be thrown into the lake of fire and brimstone for eternity.

Passing the Temptation means siding with the LORD, failing the Temptation means siding with the evil world. Siding with the LORD will likely mean being killed as a martyr in short order. Siding with the evil world will be either worshipping the beast or taking the world mark in order to buy and sell and being able to live as a citizen in the evil world. Either of these two actions are taken as failing the test. This is clearly explained in scripture, there is no compromise. The following scripture is pertinent to passing the Temptation.

Psa 116:15 **Precious** in the sight of the LORD *is* the **death** of **his saints**.

Those living in the large cities will likely be martyred, while some of those living in more remote locations will likely be protected by the LORD, but they will go through the Tribulation with God's seal and will not experience the 7 plagues.

Therefore, you have been warned, you had better work on strengthening your Faith and be prepared to become a Martyr. Time is becoming short.

Scripture tells is in the end time, most all will be **walking as in the days of Noah**, thinking they have a long regular life ahead of them and Yeshua's second coming is a long way off, not recognizing how close the end is.

Alao, we are also told that there will be scoffers when told of what the Bible really says.

In addition, we are told many will be **studying** the word and **never able to come to an understanding of the Truth**. The Truth is the Truth of God, it is the Torah.

Today most all walk as woke Christians. This is your call to wake up. The **theme** of **the Book of Revelation's of Yeshua to John** is a last call to repent and change in walking forward in the manner God demands before His wrath comes down upon the entire evil world.

One last comment, in the New Testament, Yeshua and his Apostles, tell us 17 times to beware of deception in the world and in the Church and that it will become worse as the end time approaches. Being warned only 3 times makes the warning extremely important, for being warned 17 times there is no excuse for not taking it to heart. Yet those 6 Mainstream Pastors and their congregations have ignored this warning. Note, we are to **Hear and Obey Yeshua**, it is not optional.

Live by every word of God. That means by one complete Bible.

6. Summary

After being shown above, what the key or important scriptures clearly say, providing one can read in proper context with Logic and using only scripture and reading with an open mind, are you now able to clearly understand in being able to finely divide the Word of God? Or do you still have a stiff neck, a closed mind and still walk as a woke Christian?

Each person is given life and free will choice, therefore each one is responsible for their works or walk through life. You cannot try and place blame on pastors or others. No, you yourself are responsible for your choices and actions.

Time is fast running out and a one time change in Judgment is coming, prepare while you still have time, for failing the Temptation results in your spending eternity in the lake of fire and brimstone, where your worm dieth not.

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
