One Unresolved Discrepancy

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1. Introduction

Over may years in intense study of the Bible and I mean cover to cover study over and over again, there is only one set of verses that I cannot resolve using only scripture. All others that initially seemed to have conflict have dissolved away either by prayer or continued study, being placed together in understanding with other scripture. This one set of two separate scriptures can be reconciled only with a probable logic requiring some speculation. but not using scripture alone.

The Bible resources used are 18 electronic versions of various Bibles, including Strong's Numbers, the Complete Jewish Study Bible, the Scriptures Bible and Young's Literal Translation as the most key ones. In addition hard copy references and Bibles used are the following, Aramaic linear Bible, English -Greek Reverse Interlinear New Testament Bible, English-Greek Interlinear Bible, Interlinear Greek/English Vol IV, Jewish Annotated New Testament, Hebrew-Greek Key Word Study Bible, New International, Greek Testament Commentary of the Book of Revelation.

All of the above reference Bibles confirm exactly the same understanding of words in the two groups of scripture.

The two sets of scriptures address the second trumpet plague, first, and followed, second, by the vial poured out upon the world. These following scriptures are taken from the **Scriptures Bible**, as are others in this document;

Trumpets

Rev 8:8 And the second messenger sounded, and what looked like a great mountain burning with fire was thrown into the sea, and a third of the sea became blood,

Rev 8:9 and a third of the living creatures in the sea died, and a third of the ships were destroyed.

Vials

Rev 16:3 And the second messenger poured out his bowl on the sea, and it became blood, as of a dead one, and every living creature in the sea died.

2. Dissection

There is no question, the meaning of the two sets of scriptures between Trumpet plagues and vial plagues they are clear. There is a major Bible discrepancy. The Trumpets tell us 1/3 of the living creatures in the sea died. The Vials tell us every living creature in the sea died. The other 6 tumpets and 6 vials all correlate together. The implications of this second Tribulation plague not correlating directly are tied to the following verses;

Rev 15:1 And I saw another sign in the heaven, great and marvellous: seven messengers having the seven last plagues,^a for the wrath of Elohim was ended in them. Footnote: ^aSee Rev_21:9.

Rev 21:9 And one of the seven messengers who held the seven bowls filled with the seven last plagues came to me and spoke with me, saying, "Come, I shall show you the bride, the Lamb's wife."

Thus, using the verses above, a question arises, were there 10 end time plagues or 14?

Many Christians believe that the vials are additional plagues and the plagues then total 14. I believe this is an error and will examine scripture that tells us that there are only 10 end time plagues.

3. Correlations

Starting with exodus, there were 10 plagues. The Bible tells us just over 100 times that the LORD took Israel out of Egypt with his strong arm and hand. Anything given 3 times or more is extremely important. So, 100 times is the LORD telling us something very special.

Egypt was evil towards the Hebrews and their being God's people, were taken out of evil. At that time, they formed the Nation of Israel. The LORD used Moses and Aron to announce and bring down the 10 plagues upon Egypt

As a result of the LORD stressing over and over again, the Exodus, a careful examination of the Exodus scriptures was studied again, critically looking to see if something was missed. Nothing was missed. This then leading to a leap of the mind, was The LORD going to repeat in some fashion the Exodus again in the End time Plagues coming down upon the whole evil world? Then a comparative study of the plagues of Egypt to the End time plagues was made.

First, the Bible is not simple, rather it is complex, with scripture scattered, hidden and carefully designed and integrated together. The LORD's ways are higher than man's ways. If you take a simple minded approach you will never understand scripture. All scripture is **logical**, far beyond what most all are able to recognize and understand.

Few, have the ability to recognize the **clues** in scripture, and even fewer are able to **correlate** themes together. This means nearly all those in the 6 mainstream types of Christian Churches of today, miss the correct understanding that is clearly given by scripture in God's word.

The first major concept is to recognize there are **two separate groups of Christians**, and **two separate resurrections**, You will not find a scripture stating this concept of two separate groups, in clear words. Rather one needs to put different, often seemingly unrelated scripture together in order understand. This will only occur if you truly live by every word of God accepted as truth.

There are two and only two separate groups of Christians, these are the **Saints** and the **Masses**. If you study in depth, **Judgment or Resurrections or Harvests**, they will lead you to this understanding.

Rather the following verses gives us the main understanding of the two separated groups.

The Purpose of the Parables

Mar 4:10 And when He was alone, those about Him, with the twelve, asked Him about the parable.

Mar 4:11 And He said to them, "To you it has been given to know the secret of the reign of Elohim, but to those who are outside, all are done in parables,

Mar 4:12 so that 'seeing they see but do not perceive, and hearing they hear but do not understand, lest they should turn and their sins be forgiven them.' "b Isa 6:9-10." Footnote: bSee Mat 13:15.

These verses by Yeshua identify the **masses**, Consider also Yeshua explaining the meaning of the Parables to his disciples. They were different, they needed to have the understanding opened to them. Why? They were going to set up the Congregations or Churches according to Yeshua's instructions. They were going to teach the correct way forward, they were the **Saints**, trained by Yeshua.

The Saints are defined by three qualifications by the following scripture.

Rev 14:12 Here is the **endurance** of the **set-apart ones**,^C here are those guarding the **commands of Elohim** and the **belief of יהושע.** Footnote: ^CSee also Rev 12:17.

Endurance is accepting, being thankful and not complaining of what life deals one, rather being grateful and focused on a future life with the Father and the Son. The commandments of Elohim are the Torah or Law. Belief in Yeshua is hearing, obeying, following Yeshua as the Messiah.

The Disciples were instructed by Yeshua, to set up the original Christian Congregations or Churches **for the Saints.** We know this ,first, since there are two scriptures as follows, calling all in the new Christian Churches to walk as the Saints.

Rom 1:7 To all who are in Rome, beloved of Elohim, **Called**, set-apart ones: Favour to you and peace from Elohim our Father and the Master יהושע Messiah.

וב to the assembly of Elohim which is at Corinth, to those who are set-apart in Messiah יהושע, called set-apart ones, with all those calling on the Name of יהושע Messiah our Master in every place, theirs and ours:

Further from the greetings of Paul to the various mainly Gentile congregations, he address them as the Saints.

Eph 1:1 Sha'ul, an emissary of יהושע Messiah by the desire of Elohim, to the set-apart ones who are in Ephesos, and true to Messiah יהושע:

The Saints are the set apart ones. You can, find the other scriptures by Paul to some of the Gentile Churches addressed in the same manner. Paul also stated that those Jews in Jerusalem were also the Saints. These were now the Jews that were early Christians.

We learn in the following Scriptures how the early Christian Churches walked. They were ardent or zealous for the Torah. They walked the same as those in Jerusalem, following Yeshua and keeping the Torah.

- Act 21:17 And when we had arrived in Yerushalayim, the brothers received us gladly.
- Act 21:18 And on the following day Sha'ul went in with us to Ya'aqob, and all the elders came.
- Act 21:19 And having greeted them, he was relating one by one what Elohim had done **among the** nations through his service.

Act 21:20 And when they heard it, they praised the Master. And they said to him, "You see, brother, how many thousands of Yehudim there are who have believed, and all are ardent for the Torah,

Note, above, the Nations were the Gentiles. We learn in the early Gentile Congregations nearly all walked in the Torah. Very different to the six mainstream Churches of today, as they walk in error, they all say the Torah was done away with, without verification from any scripture. So the six mainstream Churches of today are the Masses, they are not the Saints.

What you should now see is that the six mainstream churches of today think in error that Yeshua is coming to collect them. No, Yeshua in his second coming is going to collect only the remainer of the Saints, as He previously collected the first group of Saints, Mat 27:52-53, He is not coming to collect the masses. The masses are collected and judged at the last day, at the second resurrection.

In order to understand better read the following documents, "Why do Christians not understand what is happening today". "6. Events Sequence in the Tribulation", "Correlation of Exodus in Egypt with todays Time", "God's Wrath in the End Times"

The correlations between the Trumpet announcement of the 7 plagues and the 7 vials being pored out is strong, they all tell the same story, except for the second plague, the one being addressed in this document.

The correlation of a second type of Exodus in the End time is so strong that there is no question of it not being true. There are 10 and only 10 end time plagues.

4. Most Probable Speculation.

Speculation based upon scripture and logic is acceptable, but speculation not based upon scripture with logic is not acceptable. Scripture cannot be ignored, altered, or changed, it always means what it says and is always given for a reason. If you live by every word of God, you need to accept this manner of reading God's word. If you don't then you have little faith and walk on the wrong path. All scripture is truth given to us directly from God

Let us first examine the following scripture and see what it truly says.

Lev 23:2 "Speak to the children of Yisra'ěl, and say to them, 'The appointed times of יהוה, which you are to proclaim as set-apart gatherings, My appointed times, are these:

These appointed times are also known as the Feasts of the LORD as well as Statutes and times of holy convocation. If you read them carefully, they tell us they are not the Israelites, nor the Jews, nor mans. Rather they are the LORD's. Yet the 6 mainstream Churches in today's time all without any scriptural support, say they were done away with and no longer apply. How arrogant and ignorant are the pastors, and their Church doctrine. These appointed times are prophetic as well as being totally clear and unless one knows what they mean to the LORD as well as what they mean to man, then one will never be able to understand prophecy.

The first appointed time is the weekly Sabbath. It is followed by Passover and then Days of unleavened bread, then Day of first fruits of the spring harvest. It contains 2 annual Sabbaths and 2 weekly Sabbaths. These are ignored and the 6 mainstream Churches in today's time. Rather they follow counterfeit days as set by the Catholic Church. They follow the way of the world and not the way of God, the two are opposite. Note also, Yeshua kept these feasts. Deeply reflect on this.

Second, the 6 mainstream Churches of today all say in error that the Torah was done away with and no longer applies. They twist Mat 5:17 then ignore Mat 5:18 and 5:19. They truly have no idea what GRACE is and how it applies. They have no idea of how Judgment is made, they think in error the Old Testament no longer applies. If they really knew how to understand what scripture says, they would know Yeshua told us in Mat 4:4 (which is really Deu 8:3), that the Old Testament is still in full effect today. Read the document "Revelations given to us from Yeshua". Note also. Mat 5:18 is clear, the Torah is in full effect until heaven and earth pass away and until all is

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Third, examine what one needs to do in order to repent, that is accepted by the LORD. One needs to change and become a new person and no longer walk in sin. Note the following describes sin.

1Jn 3:4 Everyone doing sin also does lawlessness, and sin is lawlessness.

Walking outside the Law or Torah is walking in lawlessness, it is walking in sin. One cannot walk in proper repentance unless they walk in the Torah. This is major in understanding and obeying.

Fourth, consider the meaning of the word hear or heareth, it is the Hebrew word Shema and it means to **both** hear and obey. Knowing both the words Hear and Torah, reflect on the following verse.

Pro 28:9 He who turns away his ear from hearing the Torah, Even his prayer is an abomination.^a Footnote: ^aSee also Job 15:29, Isa 59:1-2, Jhn 9:31, 1Jn 3:22.

The above verse applies to 99+ % of those in the 6 mainstream Churches of today .Let that sink in.

Examine the following scriptures now you know what lawlessness is. These are given by Yeshua and apply to those Christians in the 6 mainstream Churches of today. It is directed to those living and having to go through the Tribulation and take the test of Yeshua being brought down upon the evil world.

The Narrow Door

Luk 13:22 And He was going through the cities and villages, teaching, and journeying toward Yerushalayim,

Luk 13:23 and someone said to Him, "Master, are there few who are being saved?" And He said to them,

Luk 13:24 "Strive to enter through the narrow gate, because many, I say to you, shall seek to enter in and shall not be able.

Luk 13:25 "When once the Master of the house has risen up and shut the door, and you begin to stand outside and knock at the door, saying, 'Master, Master, open for us,' and He shall answer and say to you, 'I do not know you, where you are from,'

Luk 13:26 then you shall begin to say, 'We ate and drank in Your presence, and You taught in our streets.'

Luk 13:27 "But He shall say, 'I say to you I do not know you, where you are from. Depart from Me, all you workers of unrighteousness.' Psa 6:8.

Luk 13:28 "There shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth, when you see Abraham and Yitshaq and Ya'aqoba and all the prophets in the reign of Elohim, and yourselves thrown outside. Footnote: a Mat 16:28-17:3.

This applies to many in the 6 mainstream Churches of today, many that think they are secure in gaining salvation, but Yeshua does not know them. Seriously reflect on that.

Now, examining the main discrepancy in scripture, one tells us **1/3** of the living beings in the sea die, the other tells us **ALL** the living being in the sea die, from the mountain that is thrown into the sea and poison's it.

Knowing the mathematical relationships describing diffusion, it takes time for the bitter poison to spread or travel throughout the entire seas. Therefore based upon logic, other scripture correlations and engineering knowledge, I would attribute the description of the trumpet as what happened-initially and the vial as to what happened much later. The sea could be both the Atlantic and the Pacific and other attached oceans, such as the Mediterranean, the Artic and Antartic. These being poisoned completely over time requires a long or finite period of time due to the total volume of water.

The effect is that the food source of the entire sea is no longer available. It is indeed a serious second Tribulation plague and has a direct effect on world Famine.

Be very careful how you walk. Do not commit the great sin, do not be presumptuous.

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
