

1. Introduction

The leaves on the fig tree are out in full bloom, look around. We are the generation that will not pass away until Yeshua returns. We live in the atomic age starting roughly in 1960. The entire world is groaning, Earthquakes and volcanic activity increasing, drought and flooding, various storms, erratic weather. In the heavens erratic activity of the sun, unusual alignments and space rocks and planets. Even the oceans are acting differently. The Arctic and Antarctic are changing. The LORD is in charge.

The Bible is full of clues, one needs to be able to identify them and this is accomplished by thinking with logic , using a proper methodology and solid in depth understanding of the entire Bible based upon the clues.

Consider the following verses.

Mat 24:21 For then shall be **great tribulation**, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be.

Mat 24:22 And except **those days should be shortened**, there should **no flesh be saved**: but for the **elect's sake** those days shall be shortened.

These are exactly fulfilled prophecy from Daniel 12:9, that tells us in the end time, some scriptures will be opened for understanding.

Dan 12:9 And he said, "Go, Dani'el, for the **words** are **hidden** and **sealed** **till the time of the end**.^b

Footnote: ^bSee [Dan 12:4](#). (The Scriptures Bible,TSB)

The end time is well described in scripture and we are now living in it: Sealed until the end time.

Does the Bible tell us to study prophecy ? Roughly one third of the Bible directly or indirectly covers prophecy, both fulfilled and unfulfilled. The following scripture is given as a commandment to us by Yeshua. What does it mean it you ? Take time to evaluate it.

Mat 4:4 But He answering, said, "It has been written, '**Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of נָתָן**'. [\(TSB\)](#) .

This is Yeshua answering Satan after 40 days in the wilderness without food. Satan was trying to tempt Yeshua into turning a rock into food. In order not to be a woke Christian you must first know that the New Testament did not start to come into written form until roughly 30 years after Yeshua was resurrected and not completed until 60 years with John on the Island of Patmos. At the time this scripture was given, only the Old Testament was in existence. In addition Yeshua was quoting The Old Testament, Deu 8:3 . If you know how to think, this means that **the Old Testament is in full effect at this point in time**. Furthermore, Yeshua was using the Greek Septuagint and had accepted this scripture as accurate, as the word of God, as Truth. Living by every word of God means you must study prophecy.

The woke pastors in the 6 types of Christian Churches of today, think in major error, that Yeshua is telling them that only the New Testament applies in today's time due to not understanding the true context of Mat 4:4. They are not able to rightly divide the word of God, nor able to read with discernment. They are so ignorant. They do not know that today there is one complete Bible that applies as the Truth from God. The complete Bible is both the Old and New Testaments together. It contains all the commandments God gave to man in order to obey. It is

the Torah. The way they think tells one that they do not walk in obedience to the LORD, nor are able to read in proper context. What a tragedy !

2. End time

This time is clearly defined by Yeshua. Read the following.

Mat 24:3 And as He sat on the Mount of Olives, **the taught ones** came to Him separately, saying, “Say to us, **when shall this be**, and what is the **sign of Your coming**, and of the **end of the age?**”(TSB)

The above tells us Yeshua is answering a question from His Disciples regarding His second coming and the end time. So, what follows describes this future time period.

Mat 24:4 And Jesus answered and said unto them, **Take heed that no man deceive you.**

Mat 24:5 For many shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ; and **shall deceive many.**

Mat 24:6 And ye shall hear **of wars and rumours of wars**: see that ye be not troubled: for all *these things* must come to pass, but the end is not yet.

Mat 24:7 For **nation shall rise against nation**, and **kingdom against kingdom**: and there shall be **famines, and pestilences, and earthquakes**, in divers places.

Mat 24:8 All these *are* the **beginning of sorrows**. (YLT, Young's Literal Translation)

Yeshua tells us of false prophets, Earthquakes and the first three end time plagues. **Wars and rumors of wars, famine and pestilences or disease.** These are the **beginning of sorrows** and are reinforced in other scriptures, studied in a future lesson. These are the birth pains or the 3 initial plagues out of a total of 10, same as the number as in Egypt. The end time plagues occur in three distinct groups. First, 3 in the **beginning of sorrows**, then 4 plagues increasing in intensity in the **first part of the Tribulation**, then the last 3 in the last portion of the Tribulation, in what is labelled as the **Great Tribulation**. You can search for the scripture yourself. In a later study the scriptures on this will be covered in more detail.

Now we jump down to Mat 24:15-22

Mat 24:15 When ye therefore shall see **the abomination of desolation**, spoken of by **Daniel** the prophet, stand in the **holy place**, (whoso readeth, let him understand:)

Mat 24:16 Then let them which be in Judaea **flee into the mountains**:

Mat 24:17 Let him which is on the housetop not come down to take any thing out of his house:

Mat 24:18 Neither let him which is in the field return back to take his clothes.

Mat 24:19 And **woe** unto them that are **with child**, and to them that give **suck** in those days!

Mat 24:20 But **pray** ye that **your flight** be not in the **winter**, neither on the **sabbath day**:

Mat 24:21 For then shall be **great tribulation**, such as was **not since the beginning of the world to this time**, no, **nor ever shall be**.

Mat 24:22 And except those days should be shortened, there should no flesh be saved: but for the elect's sake those days shall be shortened.

In these scriptures we are given many clues, these are the last 3 plagues, poured out undiluted, labelled by Yeshua as the Great Tribulation. First, we are told of the abomination of desolation, which is the antichrist who desecrates a Jewish temple. Then we are told that those in Judaea are to flee. Woe to those with babies. We are told to pray that this event does not occur on the weekly Sabbath or in winter. This time becomes the start of the Great Tribulation. Further we are told no flesh would be saved unless the LORD intervenes. We are also told that it is only for the sake of the elect, that the LORD intervenes. He does not intervene for the Churches or for mankind.

First, this means a new Jewish temple must exist at this prophecy time. Second the following scriptures define the elect.

Mat 24:31 And he shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.

Mar 13:27 And then shall he send his angels, and shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from the uttermost part of the earth to the uttermost part of heaven.

His elect are Yeshua's favorite, the chosen ones, the Israelites living and scattered though out the world in various nations. If you know how to think with logic, you will understand this, which is supported by many other scriptures. The Israelites need to complete their designated responsibility by living in Judaea and Jerusalem, being the center of the world through the millennium being an example for the rest of the world, of being blessed.

3. Revelations of ha Yeshua

Ask yourself what is the real or main purpose of the book of Revelations of ha Yeshua and who is it primarily given to ? Look into the initial scriptures of this book, identify the clues. And think with Logic using only the scriptures.

Rev 1:1 Revelation of יְהוָה Messiah, which Elohim gave Him to show His servants what has to take place with speed. And He signified it by sending His messenger to His servant Yohanan,

Rev 1:2 who bore witness to the **Word of Elohim**, and the **witness** of יְהוָה Messiah – to all he saw.

Rev 1:3 **Blessed** is he who reads and those who **hear** the words of this **prophecy**, and **guard** what is written in it, for the **time is near**. (TSB)[the word Hear is the Hebrew word Shema and means to hear and obey]

Understand this was written roughly 60 years after Yeshua had ascended back into heaven. At this time everything given by Yeshua in the New Testament was being followed by the early congregations. The word revelation means prophecy was being revealed or opened. The servants are those that follow, hear and obey Yeshua. These prophecies are going to occur in a short time, according to the LORD's perspective of time. It also means that the end time has officially started and is well under way at this point in time. John is the witness chosen, to present these prophecies to everyone. Those that **hear and obey** and **Keep** these prophecies are

blessed. Then it emphasises again that the time is near. Using **logic** with these verses means that these revelations are mainly for those people who will be living and will experience these prophecies. That also means we are to be watching for them and recognizing when they occur. You can not understand the purpose of God's word, unless you are truly able to think using the scriptures, with Logic. God's ways are much higher than man's ways, this means to understand scripture, you cannot be simple minded. Thinking with reason and Logic can never be stressed enough. The scriptures must always be accepted as words of truth coming to us from God himself. They are always given for a reason, they can never be ignored, altered or changed.

Proceeding further, evaluate what the following scriptures tell you.

Rev 1:4 Yohanan, to the **seven assemblies** that are **in Asia**: Favour to you and peace **from Him who is** and **who was** and **who is coming**, and from the **seven Spirits** that are before **His throne**,

Rev 1:5 and from **ישׁוּעָה** Messiah, the trustworthy witness, the first-born from the dead, and the **ruler of the sovereigns of the earth**. To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood,

Rev 1:6 and has **made us sovereigns and priests to His Elohim and Father**, to Him be esteem and rule forever and ever. Amén.

Rev 1:7 See, He is coming with the clouds, [Dan 7:13](#) and every eye shall see Him, even they who pierced Him. And all the tribes of the earth shall mourn because of Him. [Zec 12:10](#) Yes, Amén.

Rev 1:8 "I am the 'Aleph' and the 'Taw', Beginning and End," says **הָנָה** "who is and who was and **who is to come**, the Almighty."

Rev 1:4 tells us of the Father, who is, who was and who is coming, the clue for this is **His Throne**. Yes the Father comes as well as Yeshua's coming. Then we are told of Yeshua ruling the kings of the earth. The Saints will will be made sovereigns and priests when Yeshua comes. The verse with the deepest meaning is Rev 1:7 . It is tied to a number of other supporting scriptures . It occurs at the second coming of Yeshua near the end of the Great Tribulation. We normally expect that only the remainder of the Saints are resurrected and see Yeshua. But the above tells us that those that Judged Him, rejected Him and caused His death will see Him coming in glory and power with His angels. See, [Dan 12:2](#), [Mat:62-65](#). There is a limited Judgment at this time, see also [Rev 19:20](#).

Continuing in Revelations.

Rev 1:9 I, Yohanan, both your brother and co-sharer in pressure, and in the reign and endurance of **יעשׁוּא** Messiah, came to be on the island that is called Patmos for the Word of Elohim and for the witness of **יעשׁוּא** Messiah.

Rev 1:10 I came to be in the **Spirit** on the **Day of הָנָה**,^a and I heard behind me a loud voice, as of a trumpet, Footnote: ^aSee also [Isa 13:6](#), [Isa 13:9](#), [Ezk 13:5](#), [Jol 1:15](#), [Jol 2:1](#), [Jol 2:11](#), [Jol 2:31](#), [Jol 3:14](#), [Amo 5:16-20](#), [Oba 1:15](#), [Zep 1:7](#), [Zep 1:14](#), [Mal 4:5](#), [Act 2:20](#), [1Th 5:2](#), [2Th 2:2](#), [2Pe 3:10](#).

Rev 1:11 saying, "I am the 'Aleph' and the 'Taw', the First and the Last," and, **Write in a book what you see and send it to the seven assemblies of Asia** – to Ephesos, and to Smurna, and to Pergamos, and to Thyatira, and to Sardis, and to Philadelphia, and to Laodikeia."

Rev 1:12 And I turned to see the voice which spoke with me. And having turned, I saw **seven golden lampstands**, [Zec 4:2](#).

Rev 1:13 and in the midst of the seven lampstands **One like the Son of Adám**, [Dan 7:13](#) dressed in a robe down to the feet and **girded about the chest with a golden band**. [Dan 10:5](#).

Rev 1:14 And His head and hair were white as white wool, as snow, and **His eyes as a flame of fire**,

Rev 1:15 and **His feet like burnished brass**, [Dan 10:6](#) as if refined in a furnace, and **His voice as the**

sound of many waters. [Ezk 1:24](#), [Ezk 43:2](#).

Rev 1:16 And in His right hand He **held seven stars**, and out of His mouth went a sharp **two-edged sword**,^b and His face was as the sun shining in its strength. **Footnote:** ^bSee [Rev 2:16](#), [Isa 49:2](#), [Heb 4:12](#).

Rev 1:17 And when I saw Him, I fell at His feet as dead, and He placed His right hand on me, saying, “Do not be afraid, **I am the First and the Last**, [Isa 44:6](#), [Isa 48:12](#).

Rev 1:18 and the living One. And I became dead, and see, I am living forever and ever. Amén. And I possess the **keys of She'ol^c** and of **Death**. **Footnote:** ^cSee Explanatory Notes - She'ol.

Rev 1:19 “Write therefore what you have seen, **both** what is **now** and what **shall take place after these**:

Rev 1:20 “The secret of **the seven stars** which you saw in My right hand, and the **seven golden lampstands**: **The seven stars are messengers of the seven assemblies**, and **the seven lampstands which you saw are seven assemblies**.

We are given a lot of information in the above. John is in **the Spirit on the Day of YHWH**. Note the vast number of references to the **Day of the LORD** being, **the wrath of God coming down upon the entire evil world**. So, consider, why do so many Christian Churches think it is Sunday, even William Tyndale ?. The 7 stars and the 7 assemblies are defined for us. Seven angles over seven Churches. Think about that, do you think the 7 angels only have a limited time of responsibility for the 7 existing mainly Gentile Churches in Turkey at the time these were given to John ?

Note, Rev 1:19 John is shown **both** what will happen **now** and also **later**. It is not limited to the original 7 Churches, but definitely applies to end time 7 Churches, 7 types of Christian Churches in today,

Now we go to the letters of Yeshua to the seven Congregations. First, understand these are to 7 existing congregations of today that are approaching and going through the Tribulation. This is based upon the 7 angels residing over the 7 congregations with logic of the intent of the Revelations of Yeshua. The most important letter is the one to the Philadelphia Congregation as follows.

Rev 3:7 “And to the **messenger of the assembly in Philadelphia** write, ‘He who is set-apart, He who is true, He who has the **key of Dawid**, He who opens and no one shuts, and shuts and no one opens, [Isa 22:22](#) says this:

Rev 3:8 “I know **your works** – see, I have set before you an open door, and no one is able to shut it – **that you have little power**, yet **have guarded My Word**, and have **not denied My Name**.

Rev 3:9 “See, **I am giving up those** of the **congregation of Satan**, who **say they are Yehudim** and are not, **but lie**. See, I am making them come and worship before your feet, and to know that **I have loved you**.

Rev 3:10 “**Because you have guarded My Word of endurance, I also shall guard you from the hour of trial which shall come upon all the world, to try those who dwell on the earth.**

Rev 3:11 “See, **I am coming speedily! Hold what you have** that no one take your crown.

Rev 3:12 “**He who overcomes**, I shall make him a supporting post in the Dwelling Place of My Elohim, and he shall by no means go out. And I shall write on him the Name of My Elohim and the name of the city of My Elohim, the renewed Yerushalayim, which comes down out of the heaven from My Elohim, and My renewed Name.

Rev 3:13 “He who has an ear, let him hear what the **Spirit says to the assemblies**.

Rev 3:10 is the most important verse of all the 7 letters of Yeshua. The Philadelphia Church is the only one of the 7 Churches that Yeshua is pleased with. They guarded Yeshua's word with endurance and have not denied His name. They hear, obey and followed Yeshua. These are then the only ones that are the Saints, or set apart ones. Those in this congregation keep the Torah. Yeshua tell them they are the only ones that will not take the Temptation at the start of the Tribulation. In turn, this means they will not pass through the Tribulation. This verse also tell us that a test or Temptation that comes down upon all that are alive in the other 6 types of Christian Churches and that they will take the Test and go through the Tribulation. To understand this one must think with Logic using the 7 letters of Yeshua.

Now explore more clues in the above verses. This letter is to both those in this church and also to the angel watching over this Church. This Philadelphia congregation has little power, meaning it is not like the other 6 churches that have international presence. Rather, it is comprised of a few individuals scattered through out the various nations of the world. It does not have an organization with international presence, nor does it have church buildings, nor can it be found in the newspaper or yellow pages. It is very difficult to find even the small scattered groups in this Church.

Within this original church, a separate breakout group was established. It is comprised of members of the original complete Bible followers, or original messianic Christians, or Saints. This breakout group bought into British Israelism, thinking with out ancestry justification, that they were the lost 12 tribes, so they think of themselves as being Jews. They let the pride of life slip in unnoticed. They say they are Jews and are not, they lie. This is by far the worst type of replacement theology and it makes Yeshua extremely mad. Since they raided and deceived many in the original messianic group. Yeshua calls them the **Synagogue of Satan**. Yeshua rejects them. They ignore Paul's letters. They are a much larger group than the complete Bible followers and they are known as **two house messianic**. They think in major error that what they believe is no different to that of regular replacement theology, when in fact it is many times worse. They are in serious trouble and cannot recognize it.

Replacement theology grew in most Christian Churches before 1948 since there was no nation of Israel for roughly 1878 years. So before 1948 there was some small logical reason to their thinking. But after 1948 when the nation of Israel came into existence on one day, the reason no longer exists. Especially now only scripture is to be followed.

The SDA church has a number within it that thinks they are **spiritual Israel**, since they looked around at the other 5 mainstream types of Chirstian Churches and think only they walk and understand the Bible properly. They cannot see or accept the Complete Bible followers. The SDA's think they are the Saints, but are really the Masses. This will be covered later. Yeshua is mad at this group as well, as they lie and have seriously distorted scripture. This other group also exists in the SDA Church, in a different manner. These are also called the **Synagogue of Satan**. They are also in serious trouble. They will take the test and will pass though the Tribulation.

The 7 assemblies are the 7 early Churches in Turkey, set up by the disciples according to Yeshua's instructions. These new Christians were all called to walk as the Saints.

Rom 1:7 To all who are in Rome, beloved of Elohim, **called, set-apart ones**: Favour to you and peace from Elohim our Father and the Master יְהוָה Messiah.

1Co 1:2 to the assembly of Elohim which is at Corinth, to those who are **set-apart in Messiah יְהוָה**, **called set-apart ones**, with all those calling on the Name of יְהוָה Messiah our Master in every place, theirs and ours:

If you read scripture by Paul carefully, you will find most all in the new congregations responded too the call to walk as Saints. The new Congregations were mainly Gentile congregations and were addressed by Paul as the Saints. They walked very different to the 6 mainstream types of Christian Churches of today. They walked the same as the early Jewish Christian congregations. They kept the Torah and accepted Yeshua as the messiah. This is all Clearly given in scripture. Search for it and find it for yourself, in the book of Acts.

As time went forward fewer and fewer responded to the call, but there has always been a remnant and still is in today's time. Many are called few are chosen.

One last reminder, based upon Rev 3:10. Watch and pray always. Watch yourselves, that you are walking properly and watch and recognize the LORD's prophecy being fulfilled as we are witnesses. Be careful of the Great Transgression or Great sin, that it does not slip in to your mind. When it comes to belief in your salvation, never become presumptuous. Always hope you will be found acceptable to be taken when Yeshua returns.

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
