

# Mature Christian Motivation

## 1. Introduction

Reflect and consider, what is your focus as a Christian ? Your answer will establish how mature you have become on your walk. If you continually live by every word of God, then you read your Bible through cover to cover continually, over and over again. This action used with proper context, logical thought and reflection leads to proper growth and maturity as a son or daughter of the LORD.

If you are lazy and only follow what pastors tell you, then you are in fact a woke, clueless person, that tell themselves that they are a Christian.

If you are a mature Christian, you follow the Torah. Why do you follow the Torah, what is the reason ? There is only one reason, it is because it is a command given both by the Father and by Yeshua. It is not because of the way 2 house people think. They think in error, they are Jews or ones from the 12 tribes and therefore they think they are drawn to the Torah as a result of their false belief. These that bought into British Israelism, are called the synagogue of Satan by Yeshua, because they lie. Yeshua rejects them. These are also woke clueless people that tell themselves that they are a Christian. If one does not get all the important things, correct, it does not matter how many incidental things they get correct.

What you are passionate about as a Christian classifies the level of one's maturity, What is the main thing you are passionate about ?

## 2. Mature Christian Focus

The complete Bible is the word of God, it is the Truth of God. All scripture is Truth given to us by the LORD, given to us for a reason. The first command Yeshua gave us is Mat 4:4. Are you able to truly understand this scripture, reading with discernment ? One can only do this if they can identify that Yeshua is quoting Deu 8:3 and that the New Testament did not come into existence in written form until roughly 30 years after Yeshua's resurrection.

How important is keeping the Torah ? We are told in many scriptures to keep the Torah. Told by the Father and told by Yeshua.

Sin is defined for us by the following scriptures;

[1Jn 3:4](#) Everyone doing **sin** also does lawlessness, and **sin is lawlessness**

What does the word Lawlessness mean ? It is Strong's Number G458, and means a violation of the Law, wickedness, a transgression. Note, the word Law in English is Torah in Hebrew. It is walking in unrighteousness. It is walking in sin. This is extremely serious !

Repent is an active way of walking through life up to the time you die. It means returning to the LORD and walking in obedience to all His commands. This means for real repentance one must walk in the Torah as a new person, or else they walk in sin. Let that sink in.!

In order to receive salvation, one must be identified by the LORD as righteous. Salvation is given by Yeshua as a gift or by grace after Judgment, only to those who are judged righteous. The unrighteous are thrown into the lake of fire and experience the second death, where their worm dieth not.

Consider the following scripture as given to us from Paul;

**Rom 1:5** through whom **we have received favour** and office of the emissary for **belief-obedience** among all the nations on behalf of His Name,

Man is found righteous through **two actions, belief that Yeshua is the messiah** and by **obedience to the LORD's commands**. One must **walk forward with both actions** in order to receive **favor**, which is Salvation.

If we examine the orthodox Jews, they walk forward in obedience to the Torah. They do not believe Yeshua is the messiah. This means they do not keep the two required actions to receive Salvation. Thus they will die in their sins.

If we examine the mainstream Churches and those that say they are Christians. Most all believe that Yeshua is the messiah, but they do not keep the Torah. They do not keep both requirements. They are in major danger of Judgment.

Do you know the criteria used by Yeshua for Judgment ? There are two different sets of well defined criteria that are given to us. One set is for the Saints and one set is for the masses. One set for the first resurrection and one set for the second resurrection. You would know this if you studied Judgment according to living by every word of God.

If you did not know the major or key scriptures and their understanding as given above, then you are definitely a woke Christian and it is time for you to wake up. We are living in the end times and the Tribulation is fast approaching.

There are two Hebrew words that are of utmost importance. The first is Torah and the second is Shema. From above you should now know what Torah means. The second word is **Shema**, it means **hear and obey**. It is not optional, the word hear or heareth means to both hear and obey. .

All scripture is truth and is given for a reason. You cannot alter or ignore it. You are required to accept it and obey it. Consider what the following scripture tells us;

**Pro 28:9** **He who** turns away his ear from **hearing the Torah**, Even **his prayer** is an **abomination**.<sup>a</sup> Footnote: <sup>a</sup>See also [Job 15:29](#), [Isa 59:1-2](#), [Jhn 9:31](#), [1Jn 3:22](#).

That scripture applies to 99+ % of those that call themselves Christians. Let that sink in ! Does it apply to you ?

In addition Yeshua told us that few find the narrow path and the small door. Yeshua also told us he does not know those that are workers of iniquity.

Also consider the following;

**Act 5:32** “And we are His witnesses to these matters, and so also is **the Set-apart Spirit whom Elohim has given to those who obey Him.**”<sup>c</sup> Footnote: <sup>c</sup>See also [1Jn 3:24](#).

The Holy Spirit is only given to those that walk in total obedience to the LORD. It is dormant in those that do not walk in the Torah. Reflect on that.

If you truly live by every word of God, you should know the important scriptures covered above. If you are one that knew these, then you are a mature Christian and your focus is walking in obedience to the LORD and wanting to grow and please Him..

### 3. Reading with Methodology

In order to rightly divide the word of God or read with discernment one must use a correct methodology of reading and understanding scripture. The main basis of this is to ask and answer 3 questions initially. First, who is speaking, second, who is being spoken to, third, what did it mean to that society at that point in time. Then read scripture above and below the main ones of interest to understand the context further. Read as far as needed. Now examine Strong's Numbers to understand the meaning of the words. When ever possible use the Hebrew words from the Old Testament as they give better understanding than the Greek from the New Testament. Now add thinking with logic based upon the clues in the verses. Do not use speculation, only use scriptures with logic. If it is still not clear, gather other scriptures from throughout the Bible, those addressing the same theme. If still not clear, pray and continue to live by every word of God. If you obey and walk forward in proper attitude and in obedience, the Holy spirit will at some point open the scriptures directly and instantaneously into your mind. This will occur when you are immersed in reading and studying the word. When these moments occur, you must accept them as truth and walk forward in them.

The above might seem simple, it is not, it requires practice and knowledge of God's word.

The following scripture is examined as an example of using the methodology process.

**Mat 24:15** “So when you see the **'abomination that lays waste,'**<sup>b</sup> [Dan 11:31](#) spoken of by Dani'el the prophet, set up in the **set-apart place**” – he who reads, let him understand – Footnote: <sup>b</sup>See also [Dan 9:27](#) and *Abomination that lays waste* in Explanatory Notes.

**Mat 24:16** “then let those who are **in Yehudah flee** to the mountains.

Mat 24:17 “Let him who is on the house-top **not come down** to take whatever out of his house.

Mat 24:18 “And let him who is in the field **not turn back** to get his garments.

Mat 24:19 “**And woe to those** who are **pregnant** and to those who are **nursing** children in those days!

Mat 24:20 “And **pray** that **your flight** does **not take place** in **winter** or on the **Sabbath**.

Mat 24:21 “For then there shall be **great distress**,<sup>c</sup> such as has **not been** since the beginning of the world until this time, **no, nor ever shall be**. Footnote: <sup>c</sup>Or *great pressure, or great affliction*.

Mat 24:22 “And if **those days** were **not shortened**, **no flesh** would **be saved**, but for the **sake of the chosen ones** those **days shall be shortened**.

The clues are highlighted and there are many clues. First, understand who is speaking,,then who is being spoken to, for this, read up to the following verses as given below.

**Mat 24:3** And as **He sat** on the Mount of Olives, the **taught ones** came to Him separately, saying, “Say to us, when shall this be, and what is **the sign of Your coming**, and of the **end of the age?**”

Mat 24:4 And יהושע answering, said to them, “Take heed that no one leads you astray.

It is Yeshua who is speaking and it is His taught ones who are being spoken to. Yeshua is answering by telling them of the signs that will take place at the end of the age and at His second coming.

Now returning down to Mat 24:15, it speaks of the abomination of desolation, which is the antichrist. He is occupying the holy place in a Jewish temple. Then **woe** to those with child, suggests atomic war. Pray that it does not take place in winter or on the weekly Sabbath. A great distress occurs the worst in all history.

Now we get to the most critical clue. It refers to atomic war, so bad no flesh would survive, unless the LORD interacts. The Lord will shorten those days for the sake of the chosen ones. Other scripture identifies the chosen ones as Yeshua’s elect.. This is scripture being opened in the end time as stated in Daniel. Only those living in the atomic age can understand this. People living before roughly 1960 could not understand that all flesh could be destroyed on this earth

In dealing with others in the Churches, they will not let go of earlier belief, that this occurred in 70 AD, even when informed from the analysis above. They say it was in their far past and does not apply today. They did not make the prediction, so what they say means nothing. It was in Yeshua’s future. Also, they did not read up to Mat 24:3 in order to understand it occurs at Yeshua’s second coming.

Note also, Mat 24:22 refers to the elect, not to the Churches or to mankind. It refers to the scattered Israelites because they need to complete their purpose of carrying out the LORD’s will, becoming the center of the world during the Millennium and showing the remaining Nations how God’s blessing comes on those that obey. Yes all scripture is given for a reason.

## 4. Summary

At this point you will know if you are truly a mature Christian or a woke Christian. You should also be able to recognize that the pastors and the mainstream types of Christian Churches of today do not know scripture. In fact, they are the blind leading the blind.

We live in the end times and the wrath of God has already started coming down upon the evil world. If you were awake you would have recognized peace being taken from the world in 2020 with the action of the whole world to that of covid-19.

Taking the experimental Mrna shot was an initial test by the LORD. Either place your Trust and Faith in the LORD or place your trust in the evil world. The main test comes at the start of the Tribulation.

There is no special resurrection ahead of the Tribulation, scripture is clear on this. All those alive ahead of the start of the Tribulation will take a test and go through the Tribulation. Once a choice has been made it cannot be changed. Those passing the test will receive a reward of Salvation and more. Those siding with the evil world will lose their salvation and end up in the lake of fire, forever. This is all clearly given in scripture.

One final test, a mature Christian is one that hears, obeys and follows or emulates Yeshua. Do you keep the feasts of the LORD, His Holy-Days ? or do you keep the holi-days of man ?, In error, many think they are Christians, but in reality, they are not. One cannot go forward properly, unless they are all in.

The choice is yours on how you walk. Either in living by every word of God or going in the way of the evil world. Work on building faith and trust in the LORD, as the time to the start of the Tribulation is becoming very short.
