

In the previous lesson, the remaining 7 Gentile Congregations were examined. The only one not taking the test or Temptation and not going through the Tribulation is the Philadelphia Church, or The Complete Bible Followers. Now we continue with the next scriptures in Revelations.

Rev 4:1 After this I looked and saw a door having been opened in the heaven. And the first voice which I heard was like a trumpet speaking with me, saying, “Come up here and **I shall show you what has to take place after this.**”

Rev 4:2 And immediately I came to be in the Spirit and saw **a throne set in the heaven, and One sat on the throne.**

Rev 4:3 And **He who sat** there was like a **jasper** and a **ruby** stone in appearance. And there was a **rainbow around the throne**, like an emerald in appearance.

Rev 4:4 And **around** the throne were **twenty-four thrones**, and on the thrones I saw **twenty-four elders** sitting, dressed in **white robes**. And they had **crowns** of gold on their heads.

Rev 4:5 And out of the throne came lightnings, and thunders, and voices. And **seven lamps of fire** were burning before the throne, which are the **seven Spirits of Elohim.**

Rev 4:6 And **before the throne** there was a **sea of glass**, like crystal. And in the **midst** of the throne, and **around the throne**, were **four living creatures**, covered with **eyes in front and in back.**

Rev 4:7 And **the first** living creature was like a **lion**, and the **second** living creature like a **calf**, and the **third** living creature had a face like a **man**, and the **fourth** living creature was like a flying **eagle.** [Ezk 1:10.](#)

Rev 4:8 And the four living creatures, **each having six wings**, [Isa 6:2](#) were covered **with eyes around and within.** And they do not cease, day or night, saying, “**Set-apart, set-apart, set-apart, יהוה Ėl Shaddai, Isa 6:3 who was, and who is, and who is coming!**”

Rev 4:9 And when the living creatures **give esteem** and **respect** and thanks to Him who sits on the **throne**, who lives forever and ever,

Rev 4:10 the twenty-four **elders fall down** before Him who sits on the throne and **bow before Him** who lives forever and ever, and **they cast their crowns** before the throne, saying,

Rev 4:11 “You are worthy, **O יהוה**, to receive **esteem and respect and power**, [1Ch 29:11](#) for You have **created all**, and because of **Your desire** they are, and **were created.**”

First John is being shown the future, as to what will take place with the 7 end time Churches. John was in the spirit and saw the throne in heaven, and YHWH sitting on the throne. Those around the throne have colors of various jem stones. These are likely representing the priests breast plate and the various Israel tribes. Then he sees 24 other thrones and others sitting on these. They are elders and have white robes and crowns. This is 2 sets of 12. Most likely the 12 disciples and 12 others. We don't definitively know who these others are. Possibly, Abraham, Noah, Isaac and, Jacob, Enoch, King David, Elijah, Isaiah, Ezekiel, Moses, Paul and 1 other, or something else entirely ??

There are 7 lamps of fire before the throne, these are the 7 spirits of YHWH. Before the throne is a sea of glass. In the midst and around the throne were 4 living creatures. They have eyes front and back. The first is like a lion, the second is like a calf, the third is like a man and the fourth is like an eagle. They each have 6 wings

covered with eyes. They were worshipping YHWH, singing praises non stop. These are 4 Cherubs as also describe in Isaiah. Then the elders, worship YHWH. The Cherubs are special powerful angles.

Now we come to the scroll and the seven seals. YHWH holds the scroll and initially no one is found able to open the scroll and break the seals. Then the lion of Judah, the root of David is found able to break the seals. He is the lamb that was slain.

Rev 5:1 And I saw in the **right hand of Him** who **sat on the throne a scroll written inside and on the back**, [Ezk 2:10](#) having been sealed **with seven seals**.

Rev 5:2 And I saw a **strong messenger** proclaiming with a **loud voice**, “**Who is worthy to open the scroll and to loosen its seals?**”

Rev 5:3 **And no one in the heaven or on the earth or under the earth** was able to open the scroll, or to **look at it**.

Rev 5:4 And **I wept much**, because no one was found worthy to open and read the scroll, or to look at it.

Rev 5:5 And one of the elders said to me, “Do not weep. See, the **Lion of the tribe of Yehudah**,^a the **Root of Dawid**,^b **overcame to open the scroll** and to **loosen its seven seals**.” Footnotes: ^a [Gen 49:9-10](#), [Heb 7:14](#). ^b [Isa 11:1](#) and [Isa 11:10](#).

Rev 5:6 And I looked and saw in the midst of the throne and of the four living creatures, and in the midst of the elders a **Lamb standing, as having been slain**, having **seven horns and seven eyes**, which are the **seven Spirits of Elohim sent out into all the earth**.

Rev 5:7 And He came and took the scroll out of the **right hand of Him sitting on the throne**.

Rev 5:8 And when He took the scroll, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb, each holding a harp, and **golden bowls filled with incense**, which are **the prayers of the set-apart ones**.

Rev 5:9 And they sang a renewed song, saying, “**You are worthy to take the scroll, and to open its seals**, because **You were slain**, and have **redeemed us to Elohim** by **Your blood** out of **every tribe and tongue and people and nation**,^c Footnote: ^cThis fact is given in 6 other texts in the Book of Revelation.

Rev 5:10 and **made us sovereigns and priests to our Elohim**, and **we shall reign upon the earth**.”^d Footnote: ^d [Dan 7:18-27](#).

Rev 5:11 And I looked, and I heard the voice of many messengers around the throne, and the living creatures, and the elders. And the number of them was myriads of myriads, and **thousands of thousands**,

Rev 5:12 saying with a loud voice, “**Worthy is the Lamb having been slain to receive power and riches and wisdom, and strength and respect and esteem and blessing!**”

Rev 5:13 And **every creature** which is in the **heaven** and on **the earth** and **under the earth** and such as are **in the sea**, and all that are in them, I heard saying, “**To Him sitting on the throne, and to the Lamb**, be the **blessing and the respect and the esteem and the might, forever and ever!**”

Rev 5:14 And the four living creatures said, “Amě!” And the twenty-four elders fell down and bowed before Him who lives forever and ever.

Yeshua made the Saints sovereigns and priests to YHWH, and these shall reign on earth.

There are likely 24 bowls that are filled with the prayers of the Saints. It is not with the prayers of the masses, see Prov 28:9.

The Lamb is worthy, as he was slain and shed His blood for every Nation

Now, the opening of the 7 seals starts. Each opening of the first 4 seals is announced by one specific Cherub after another, in order. The first seal is a white horse and the person sitting on him is given a crown and a bow. The first clue is understanding that white is always righteous, never any exceptions used throughout the entire Bible. The second clue is that it is given a crown or authority likely a Nation, not a person. The third clue is a bow is given, indicating power or might over other Nations. Next we are told this righteous Nation goes out overcoming other Nations. A problem with those in the world trying to understand this is they cannot follow the meaning of the words that are clues. They speculate rather than paying proper attention to words and using only scripture. Most think, in error, this person on this horse is either Satan or the antichrist. Satan is never referred to as white. So generally, in error, people think that these seals are still waiting to be opened. They cannot rightly divide the word of Truth. If they could read with discernment they would recognize that the first seal is not a plague, rather it is the LORD providing a righteous nation with power to help keep evil nations in check. This is the USA keeping war monger nations in check, likely starting at the Korean war. Evil nations following on would be Russia, China, Vietnam, Iraq, Afghanistan, and Iran. This horse went back to the stable when Trump was cheated out of a second term.

Rev 6:1 And I saw when the Lamb opened one of the seals, and I heard one of the four living creatures saying, like a sound of thunder, “Come and see.”

Rev 6:2 And I looked and saw a **white horse^a**, and he who sat on it holding a bow. And a crown was given to him, and he went out overcoming and to overcome. Footnote: ^a [Zec 6:3](#).

Rev 6:3 And when He opened the second seal, I heard the second living creature saying, “Come and see.”

The initial plagues of the LORD in the times of sorrow start at the breaking of second seal. We will now divert and examine something that defines the End Time wrath of God. If you truly live by every word of God and are aware of what scripture says it would lead you back to examine the Exodus. If you can think and analyze with logic using only scripture, it will give you the understanding that the End Time wrath of God follows the pattern of Exodus. There are 10 plagues total in both and there is considerable correlation, well beyond any doubt. This means we need to look and find 10 plagues in the End Time. What scripture gives us is never coincidental, all of it is purposely given, even the repeating scriptures. This is why discernment using Logic and scripture, only, is so important. Pastors and others, in error, ignore the repeating scriptures, why ?

Going to what Yeshua told us about the times of sorrow, we find three plagues. The following scriptures give us this information.

Mat 24:3 And as He sat on the Mount of Olives, the taught ones came to Him separately, saying, “Say to us, when shall this be, and what is the sign of Your coming, and of the end of the age?”

Mat 24:4 And יהושע answering, said to them, “Take heed that no one leads you astray.

Mat 24:5 “For many shall come in My Name, saying, ‘I am the Messiah,’ and they shall lead many astray.

Mat 24:6 “And you shall begin to hear of fightings and reports of fightings. See that you are not troubled, for these have to take place, but the end is not yet.

Mat 24:7 “For nation shall rise against nation, and reign against reign. And there shall be scarcities of food, and deadly diseases, and earthquakes in places.

Mat 24:8 “And all these are the beginning of birth pains.

The above are clearly given to us by Yeshua. They are the End of the Age and his second coming. We are first warned of deception. Then of violence, nation against nation, reign against reign and then three plagues, the first will be death from wars or peace being taken from the world, second famine, third disease. Note, all three promote death. We are also told of earthquakes. These are described as the beginning of birth pains or also as the times of sorrows. These match exactly with the breaking of the second, third and fourth seals. These three take place in the times of sorrows, before the Tribulation starts. These seals are given to us by the Cherubs. They are much worse than the first three plagues in Egypt, but all people experience them and no one is specifically protected by the LORD. All suffer just as the Israelites suffered over the first three plagues in Egypt. You will only be able to recognize this if you can use logic and scripture together and recognize correlations. This is what reading with discernment means.

Now we go back to the breaking of the seals, two through four. The breaking of the second seal results in a red horse, often red means blood or war.

Rev 6:4 And **another horse, fiery red,**^b went out. And it **was given to the one who sat on it to take peace from the earth,** and that they should **slay one another.** And a **great sword was given to him.**
Footnote: ^b [Zec 1:8](#), [Zec 6:2](#).

The one that sits on this horse takes peace from the world and people slay one another. This is the evil world action, then followed further by wars. The breaking of this seal occurred in 2020 with Covid 19 and the unified reaction of all important or major nations. Followed quickly by the experimental mRNA shot. This was the first warm up test given by the LORD, either put your trust in the LORD or alternately put your trust in the evil world. Many that call themselves Christians failed. If you knew scripture, you would quickly recognize in 2022 that food processing plants were burned, fertilizer was being restricted, culling of animals was occurring, crops were turned under, all in the name of saving the planet. The promotion of famine, continually rising food costs. This was the second plague starting, the breaking of the third seal.

The third seal is a black horse. The one sitting on this horse had a pair of scales, and indicates that all of a days wages were needed for buying the food for a day. Then tells us about the grape and olive trees are not to be hurt. These trees are drought resistant. This third seal is famine.

Rev 6:5 And when He opened **the third seal,** I heard **the third living creature say,** “Come and see.” And I looked and **saw a black horse,**^c and he who sat on it **holding a pair of scales in his hand.**^d Footnotes: ^c [Zec 6:2](#), ^d [Ezk 4:16](#).

Rev 6:6 And I heard a **voice in the midst** of the four living creatures saying, “**A measure of wheat for a denarius,**^e and **three measures of barley for a denarius.**^e **And do not harm the oil and the wine.**” Footnote: ^e **Roman monetary unit - a day’s wage.**

Rev 6:7 And when He opened the **fourth seal,** I heard the voice of **the fourth living creature saying,** “Come and see.”

The breaking of the fourth seal is a green or pale horse. This is death and hell following. It results in 25% of the world population dying from the first three plagues working together. This plague has not started as yet, but could start at any moment. If you can visualize, the start of this plague will result in serious lockdowns and the loss of people with knowledge in keeping essential services operating. We wait and watch for this third Plague to start.

Rev 6:8 And I looked and saw a **green horse**.^f And he who sat on it had the **name Death**,^g and **She'ol** followed with him. And **authority** was given to them **over a fourth of the earth**, to **kill with sword**, and **with hunger**, and **with death**, and by the **beasts of the earth**.^h Footnotes: ^fTraditionally rendered as pale; Gk. Chloros. Zec 6:3. ^gHos 13:14. ^hEzk 5:12, Ezk 5:17, Ezk 14:13-19.

What Yeshua told us about the 3 end time plagues in the times of sorrow is verified by the breaking of the seals 2,3, and 4.

Again we are going to divert to what Yeshua also tells us about the end time. Examine the following carefully. It is a continuation of the above times of sorrow given to us going into the Tribulation Plagues.

Now we are told of the abomination of desolation from Daniel. This is the antichrist sitting in the holy place in a Jewish temple. When one sees this, those around Jerusalem are told to flee to the mountains, without looking back. Woe to those that are pregnant and are nursing. Pray your flight does not occur in the winter or on the Sabbath. Then it describes a great distress, worse than ever occurring, This timing is the mid point of the Tribulation. Note the future command to keep the Sabbath, the Sunday churches do not accept or understand the timing of these scriptures.

Mat 24:15 “So when you see the **'abomination that lays waste**,^b Dan 11:31 spoken of by Dani'el the prophet, set up in the **set-apart place**” – he who reads, **let him understand** – Footnote: ^bSee also Dan 9:27 and *Abomination that lays waste* in Explanatory Notes.

Mat 24:16 “then let **those who are in Yehudah flee to the mountains**.

Mat 24:17 “Let him who is on the **house-top** not come down to **take whatever** out of his house.

Mat 24:18 “And let him who is **in the field not turn back** to get his garments.

Mat 24:19 “And **woe** to those **who are pregnant** and to those who are nursing children in those days!

Mat 24:20 “And **pray** that **your flight** does **not take place in winter or on the Sabbath**.

Mat 24:21 “For then there **shall be great distress**,^c such as **has not been since the beginning of the world** until this time, **no, nor ever shall be**. Footnote: ^cOr *great pressure, or great affliction*.

Mat 24:22 “And if **those days were not shortened, no flesh would be saved**, but for the **sake of the chosen ones those days shall be shortened**.

Mat 24:23 “If anyone then says to you, ‘Look, here is the Messiah!’ or ‘There!’ do not believe.

Mat 24:24 “**For false messiahs and false prophets shall arise**, and they shall show great signs and wonders, so as to lead astray, if possible, even the chosen ones.

Mat 24:25 “See, **I have forewarned you**.

Unless the LORD shortens those days all flesh will die. One needs to live in the atomic age to understand this. But the LORD will control those days for the sake of the chosen ones. Other scripture tells is these are the scattered Israelites spread throughout the world. Note, it is not for the sake of the Churches or for the sake of man. It is only because the Israelites need to fulfill their role as being the center of the world during the Millennium. These verses are given as a warning.

Now we examine the following two verses.

Rev 15:1 And I saw another sign in the heaven, great and marvellous: **seven messengers** having the **seven last plagues**,^a for the **wrath of Elohim** was ended in them. Footnote: ^aSee [Rev 21:9](#).

Rev 21:9 And one of the **seven messengers** who held the **seven bowls filled with the seven last plagues** came to me and spoke with me, saying, "Come, I shall show you the bride, the Lamb's wife."

Reading the above two scriptures carefully, we are told twice there are 7 last plagues or a total of 7 plagues in the Tribulation. The plagues are the bowels being poured out. Combining this with 3 plagues in the times of sorrow, we have 10 plagues total, the same number as in Egypt. Later in these studies we find there are 7 trumpets, each one announcing a plague, occurring in the Tribulation, Rev 8:6. Later we find 4 plagues in the first portion of the Tribulation, occurring up to the midpoint, then 3 plagues in the last portion of the Tribulation, which happens to be in the Great Tribulation. This means we have 3 milestones or markers for the 10 Plagues. The first 3 in the times of sorrow, the next 4 in the first half of the Tribulation, the last 3 in the Great tribulation. Other scripture tells us the Tribulation is 7 years long. Note also, the trumpets announces the plague, but the plague is poured out from the bowel. The events and time lines are laid out for us. It comes together when we place scriptures together and read scriptures carefully. Yeshua returns at the seventh or last trumpet at the end of the Tribulation.

Now we return to the opening of the other seals. The fifth seal is special information being given to us. It is not a plague. Rather it is the martyred saints under the throne room in heaven, asking how long do they have to wait until they are avenged.

Rev 6:9 And when He opened the **fifth seal**, I saw under the **slaughter-place the beings** of those having **been slain for the Word of Elohim** and for the **witness which they held**,

Rev 6:10 and **they cried** with a loud voice, saying, "**How long, O Master**, set-apart and true, **until You judge and avenge our blood on those who dwell on the earth?**"

Rev 6:11 And there was **given to each one a white robe**, and they were told that they should rest a **little while longer, until both the number of their fellow servants and their brothers, who would be killed as they were, was completed**.

First they are given white robes, since they are righteous. They are told to wait a little longer until others were martyred and join them, In order to understand this one needs to know that the sixth seal follows this scripture and what the breaking of the sixth seal means. The sixth seal is not a plague, it is YHWH announcing the start of the Tribulation. In order to gain full understanding we must combine the 5th seal with the following.

1Th 4:13 Now, brothers, we do not wish you to be ignorant concerning those **who have fallen asleep**, lest you be sad as others who have no expectation.

1Th 4:14 For if we believe that יהושע died and rose again, so also **Elohim shall bring with Him those who sleep^a in יהושע**. Footnote: ^aA euphemism for death.

1Th 4:15 For this we say to you by the word of the Master, that we, **the living who are left over at the coming of the Master** shall in **no way go before those who are asleep**.

1Th 4:16 Because **the Master Himself shall come down** from heaven **with a shout**, with the voice of a chief messenger, **and with the trumpet of Elohim**, and **the dead in Messiah shall rise first**.

1Th 4:17 **Then we**, the **living who are left over**, shall be **caught away together** with them **in the clouds** to meet the Master in the air – and so **we shall always be with the Master**.

The verses directly above tell us that the dead must rise first before any that are alive. This happens at

Yeshua's return, at the end of the Tribulation. These two sets of scriptures, taken together are clear and tell us there is one resurrection at the end time, only taking place at Yeshua's second coming. Thus those that say, do not worry to others, in that they will be taken before the Tribulation starts, do not know the scriptures.

Now we move to examining the breaking of the sixth seal. First, is a great earthquake and activity in the heavens. The sun and moon change, stars fall to earth. Most important is that we are told every mountain and island are moved out of their place. Visualize that, it is extreme world wide movement. For those living in the mountains they will likely be isolated with no means of transportation in or out, other than by horse or walking. Roads, trains, airports, dams and bridges, will be destroyed. Likely, gas, power lines and sewer lines will be broken. When this occurs, the first three plagues of the times of sorrow are still taking place.

Rev 6:12 And I looked when He opened **the sixth seal** and saw **a great earthquake** came to be. And the **sun became black** as sackcloth of hair, and the **moon became as blood**.

Rev 6:13 And the **stars of the heaven fell to the earth**, as a fig tree drops its unripe figs, being shaken by a strong wind.

Rev 6:14 And **heaven departed like a scroll** being rolled up, and **every mountain and island was moved out of its place**.

Rev 6:15 And the **sovereigns of the earth**, and the **great ones**, and the **rich ones**, and the **commanders**, and the **mighty**, and every **slave and every free one**, **hid themselves in the caves and in the rocks of the mountains**,

Rev 6:16 and **said to the mountains and rocks**, "**Fall on us and hide us [Hos 10:8](#) from the face of Him sitting on the throne** and from **the wrath of the Lamb**,

Rev 6:17 because **the great day of His wrath has come**, and **who is able to stand?**"

Every one will fear for their life, and know that man has no control. Most will think the end of this earth has come. Extremely few, will know from scripture what is happening. At this point the seventh seal has not yet been opened. Shortly you will learn that the seventh seal is the start of the Tribulation plagues, **Rev 8:1**.

We continue with what occurs after the sixth seal is opened. We find 4 angels holding the winds of earth from blowing. Dead calm over the entire earth. No harm will come to the earth until after the servants of the LORD have received the LORD's seal of protection. This takes place just before the first plague of the Tribulation starts. Now all people are sealed, most with Satan's seal, a very few with the LORD's seal. Angels are waiting to further destroy the earth by releasing the plagues. They need to wait until the only the LORD's sealing of the Saints has been achieved. The masses do not get sealed unless they pass the test or temptation of the LORD, as then they become Saints.

Rev 7:1 And after this I saw four messengers standing at the four corners of the earth, **holding the four winds of the earth**, that the **wind should not blow on the earth**, nor on the **sea**, nor on **any tree**.

Rev 7:2 And I saw another messenger coming up from the rising of the sun, holding the seal of the living Elohim. And he cried with a loud voice to the four messengers to whom it was given to harm the earth and the sea,

Rev 7:3 saying, "**Do not harm the earth**, nor the sea, nor the trees **until we have sealed the servants of our Elohim upon their foreheads**." ^aFootnote: ^aSee [Rev 9:4](#), [Rev 14:1](#), [Rev 22:4](#).

Rev 7:4 And I heard **the number of those who were sealed, one hundred and forty-four thousand, sealed out of all the tribes of the children of Yisra'el**:

Rev 7:5 of the **tribe of Yehudah** twelve thousand were sealed, of **the tribe of Re'ubēn** twelve thousand were sealed, of the **tribe of Gad** twelve thousand were sealed,

Rev 7:6 of the **tribe of Asher** twelve thousand were sealed, of **the tribe of Naphtali** twelve thousand were

sealed, of **the tribe of Menashsheh** twelve thousand were sealed,

Rev 7:7 of the **tribe of Shim'on** twelve thousand were sealed, of **the tribe of Lěwi** twelve thousand were sealed, of **the tribe of Yissasķar** twelve thousand were sealed,

Rev 7:8 of **the tribe of Zebulun** twelve thousand were sealed, of the **tribe of Yosěph** twelve thousand were sealed, of the **tribe of Binyamin** twelve thousand were sealed.

Rev 7:9 After this I looked and saw a **great crowd** which no one was able to count, out of **all nations** and tribes and peoples and tongues, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, dressed in **white robes**, and palm branches in their hands,

Rev 7:10 and crying out with a loud voice, saying, "Deliverance belongs to our Elohim who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!"

Rev 7:11 And all the messengers stood around the throne and the elders and the four living creatures, and fell on their faces before the throne and worshipped Elohim,

Rev 7:12 saying, "Aměn! The blessing, and the esteem, and the wisdom, and the thanksgiving, and the respect, and the power, and the might, to our Elohim forever and ever. Aměn."

Rev 7:13 And one of the elders responded, saying to me, "**Who are these dressed in white robes**, and where did they come from?"

Rev 7:14 And I said to him, "Master, you know." And he said to me, "**These are those coming out of the great distress, having washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.**

Rev 7:15 "Because of this they are before the throne of Elohim, and serve Him day and night in His Dwelling Place. And He who sits on the throne shall spread *His* Tent over them.

Rev 7:16 "**They shall hunger no more, neither thirst any more, neither shall the sun strike them, nor any heat,** [Isa 49:10](#)."

Rev 7:17 because the Lamb who is in the midst of the throne **shall shepherd them** [Ezk 34:23](#) and lead them to **fountains of waters of life.** [Jer 2:13](#), [Jer 17:13](#) And Elohim **shall wipe away every tear from their eyes.**" [Isa 25:8](#).

We learn a great number of people throughout the world from various nations have been sealed, with the LORD's seal. All these are given white robes.

The breaking of the 7th seal occurs right after the Saints are marked by YHWH and it then becomes the start of the 7 Tribulation plagues.

Rev 8:1 And when He opened the **seventh seal**, there came to be **silence** in the heaven for **about half an hour**.

Rev 8:2 And I saw the **seven messengers** who stand before Elohim, and to them were **given seven trumpets**.

Rev 8:3 And another messenger came and stood at the slaughter-place, holding a golden censer, and much incense was given to him, that he should offer it with the **prayers of all the set-apart ones** upon the golden slaughter-place which was before the throne.

Rev 8:4 And the smoke of the **incense**, with the **prayers of the set-apart ones**, went up before Elohim from the hand of the messenger.

Rev 8:5 And the **messenger** took the **censer**, and **filled it with fire** from the slaughter-place, and **threw it to the earth**. And there were **noises, and thunders, and lightnings**, and an **earthquake**.

Rev 8:7 And **the first messenger sounded**, and there came to be **hail and fire** mixed **with blood**, and they were **thrown to the earth**. And a third of the trees were **burned up**, and **all green grass** was **burned up**.

Note the prayers of the Saints.

The first plague of the Tribulation is hail of fire and blood raining down on the entire earth from the heavens,

These continue in the next study.. The first Tribulation plague resulting in a third of the trees and all the grass being burned up.

We have now arrived at the start of the Tribulation plagues.
